CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good morning. I'm going to start. We have a quorum. We have a couple of Members that will be out shortly.

I would like to welcome you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the District of Columbia's Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Today is January 14, 2015.

My name is Ruthanne Miller. I'm the Chair. Joining me today to my far right is Mr. Nick Alberti and next to me on the right is Mr. Hector Rodriguez. And to my immediate left is Mike Silverstein. And joining us also is Mr. James Short. So we have five this morning in attendance for business and three constitutes a quorum.

Copies of today's hearing calendar and agenda are available at the receptionist desk. Please be aware that these proceedings are being recorded by a court reporter. Accordingly, we

1 must ask you to refrain from any disruptive  
2 noises or actions in the hearing room.

3 If you have any electronic devices,

6 the proceedings.

7 When I call your case, please, come  
8 forward and take a seat at a table here in the  
9 front. You will notice that there is a piece of  
10 paper on each table for you to sign-in. This is  
11 to ensure the correct spelling of your name for  
12 the record.

13 The Open Meetings Act requires that  
14 the public hearing on each case be open to the  
15 public. The Board may, consistent with Section  
16 405(b) of the Open Meetings Act, enter a closed  
17 meeting during or after the public hearing on a  
18 case to consult with an attorney to obtain legal  
19 advice, discuss settlement agreements or  
20 deliberate upon a decision in an adjudication  
21 proceeding.

3 No. 14-PRO-00090, Pizza Parts & Service located

7 MR. KLINE: And that the SA will be  
8 filed.
