3 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Okay. The next case  
4 on our show cause hearing calendar today is case  
5 number 15-CMP-00414, Noble Lounge, license number  
6 85258. Will the parties please -- okay.  
7 Identify yourself for the record, please.

8 MS. GEPHARDT: Oh, Chrissy Gephardt, here  
9 on behalf of the Office of the Attorney General.

10 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: I see that the  
11 Licensee is not here.

12 MS. GEPHARDT: This is -- let me see  
13 here. This is --

14 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: It was scheduled for  
15 10:00 a.m., and it's 10:25.

16 MS. GEPHARDT: 10:00 a.m.

17 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: It's 10:25. Do you  
18 want us to pass and call this case?

19 MS. GEPHARDT: Yeah. Let me call this  
20 individual, because I know that I was talking to  
21 her yesterday. So let me find out what's going  
22 on. Yeah.

1 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Okay.

2 MS. GEPHARDT: I don't know.

3 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Well, I'll pass on  
4 this case. We're going to be in recess, and you  
5 can let us know. We'll be in recess, and so  
6 you'll let me know. There are no other cases on  
7 our morning calendar.

12 interested in resolving this case via NOIC  
13 [phonetic], and so we would ask that the case be  
14 moved till next Wednesday.

17 Government's motion to continue this case for one  
18 week.

19 MR. SHORT: Second.

20 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Mr. Short has second
