3 AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of Po Boy Jim, please, come forward?
5 The parties in the matter of Po Boy Jim. This is
6 Case No. 15-PRO-00003, Rebecca Antoine t/a Po Boy
7 Jim, 709 H Street, N.E., License No. ABRA 087903.
8 This is a Retailer Class CR, substantial change
9 for an entertainment endorsement to allow karaoke
10 and a DJ. The protest issues are adverse impact
11 on peace, order and quiet.

12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher and I'm
13 conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's
14 Agent pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2.

15 Is the applicant present?

16 AGENT FLETCHER: Present on behalf of
17 ANC-6C?

18 MR. COURTNEY: Yes. My name is Drew
19 Courtney. I'm the Chairman of the Alcoholic
20 Beverage Licensing Committee for 6C and the
21 designated representative.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.

1 Courtney. And would you spell your name for the
2 record, please?

3 MR. COURTNEY: Yes. First name Drew,
4 D-R-E-W, last name Courtney, C-O-U-R-T-N-E-Y.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: And, Mr. Courtney,
6 have you been -- has the ANC been in
7 communication with Po Boy Jim?

8 MR. COURTNEY: We have been to some
9 extent, yes.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: But there is not a
11 settlement agreement, at this point?

12 MR. COURTNEY: We have proposed a
13 settlement agreement, but I haven't gotten any
14 response.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: The application filed
16 by Po Boy Jim is dismissed because the applicant
17 has failed to appear. The Board will issue an
18 order dismissing the application and ANC-6C will
19 receive a copy of the order.

20 The owner of Po Boy Jim will have 10
21 days to seek reinstatement of the application.
22 And the ANC will be kept informed with respect to

1 whether or not the Board reinstates the
2 application or not, but as of today, the
3 application for substantial change is dismissed.

4 Any questions about that, Mr.
5 Courtney?

6 MR. COURTNEY: Will I be notified
7 directly if I put my name on this list here?

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, because you are
9 the designated representative. I see that in the
10 letter from Karen Wirt. So you would be the
11 person to receive the Board Order dismissing --

12 MR. COURTNEY: Thank you.

13 AGENT FLETCHER: -- the application.
14 You're welcome.

15 And the applicant will have 10 days
16 upon receipt of the order to seek reinstatement.
17 Okay. Well, then that's all. Thank you, Mr.
18 Courtney, for coming.
