CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good morning, everyone. I would like to welcome you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Today is February 4, 2015.

My name is Ruthanne Miller. I'm the Chairperson. And joining me to my far right is Mr. Donald Brooks. Next to Mr. Brooks is Mr. Nick Alberti. And next to Mr. Alberti is Mr. Hector Rodriguez. To my left is Mr. Mike Silverstein. And next to Mr. Silverstein is Mr. James Short. We have six Members in attendance for the conduct of business today with three constituting a quorum.

Copies of today's hearing calendar and agenda are available at the receptionist desk. Please be aware that these proceedings are being recorded by a court reporter. Accordingly, we must ask you to refrain from any disruptive noises or actions in the hearing room.

1 If you have any electronic devices,
2 pagers, cell phones or such, please, make certain
3 they are turned off to avoid any interruption of
4 the proceedings.

5 When I call your case, please, come
6 forward and take a seat at the table. You will
7 note that there is a piece of paper on each table
8 for you to sign-in. This is to ensure the
9 correct spelling of your name for the record.

10 The Open Meetings Act requires that
11 the public hearing on each case be open to the
12 public. The Board may, consistent with Section
13 405(b) of the Open Meetings Act, enter a closed
14 meeting during or after the public hearing on a
15 case to consult with an attorney to obtain legal
16 advice, discuss settlement agreements or
17 deliberate upon a decision in an adjudication
18 proceeding.

19 Okay. That concludes my introductory
20 remarks. We are starting a little bit later this
21 morning because we didn't see those who were
22 scheduled to appear for their 9:30 status cases,

1 but I'm going to call them just in case and then
2 we will get to your hearing. I see that you are
3 here. I'm just going to go through the list, a
4 few cases ahead of you, just to make sure that
5 someone is not here.

6 The first case scheduled on our
7 calendar is Case No. 14-PRO-00102, Lee's Liquor
8 located at 2339 Pennsylvania Avenue, S.E.,
9 License No. 95751, in ANC-7B.

10 I note that this hearing has been
11 canceled, that the parties have submitted a
12 settlement agreement.
