CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So
now, we will go back to our regular order.
And I'm calling Case No. 12-PRO-00087, Le
Liquors located at 1776 Columbia Road, N.W.,
License No. 90659 in ANC-1C.

This is a status for a Protest
Hearing. When you are ready, if you would
just identify yourselves for the record?

MR. GUTHRIE: Ted Guthrie.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

MR. GUTHRIE: ANC-1C.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning.
And you are?

MR. LE: Yes, my name is Quang Le,
1776 Columbia Road.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And
you are the?

MR. LE: The --

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Are you the
owner?

1 MR. LE: Yes.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Are
3 there any preliminary matters you need to
4 bring to our attention?

5 MR. GUTHRIE: We did the
6 mediation. We have got an agreement in
7 principle. We -- I can't sign-off on it yet,
8 because this is the new ANC and I'm not
9 authorized to do it yet. It's set for the
10 meeting at the beginning of March.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So you
12 expect to have a signed agreement?

13 MR. GUTHRIE: Expect to have it
14 resolved, yes.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.
16 In the meantime, I'm just going to go ahead
17 and set this for hearing, but once you have a
18 voluntary agreement and you submit it and the
19 Board signs-off on it, then it will be taken
20 off the calendar, if that happens.

21 Okay. The Protest Hearing will be
22 set for March 20th at 1:30 p.m. And I just

1 need to read you a couple of instructions in
2 the event it goes to hearing, which it sounds
3 like is unlikely.

4 You should have received in a
5 mailing from Adjudication Assistant Sarah
6 Fashbaugh a letter explaining the protest
7 process and a copy of the Protest Information
8 Form.

9 If you don't have those documents,
10 please, see Ms. Fashbaugh at the conclusion of
11 this hearing. It is important that you review
12 those rules, complete and submit the Protest
13 Information Form seven days before the date of
14 the hearing. It needs to be submitted to ABRA
15 and to the opposing parties.

16 IF we don't receive a copy of your
17 PIF, your application or your protest,
18 whichever side you are on, could be subject to
19 dismissal. It is an important form that
20 assists the Board in narrowing the protest
21 issues and facilitating the process and
22 keeping parties on point during the hearing.

1 But you hopefully won't get to
2 that. All right. If you have any other
3 questions though and there is a hearing, you
4 should contact Ms. Fashbaugh at (202) 397-
5 3971.

6 Okay. That's all I --

7 MR. GUTHRIE: And once we get the
8 settlement agreement signed by both parties,
9 we can just submit it to the office here and--

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes, bring it
11 to Ms. Jenkins' attention, our general
12 counsel.

13 MR. GUTHRIE: Okay.

14 MR. LE: Thank you.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Thank
16 you very much.

18 (Status) Hearing in the above-entitled matter
19 was concluded at 9:46 a.m.)
