12 our instructions that I read in the previous  
13 case that you need to pay attention to to  
14 prepare for your protest hearing.

15 The purpose of the protest hearing  
16 is to determine whether the establishment is  
17 appropriate in the section of the District  
18 where it's located. That's Section 23-1607 of  
19 our Regulations.

20 You should have received a copy of  
21 the protest information form and exhibit form  
22 through the mail from Tesha Anderson. If you

1 haven't please see her.

2 The protest information form, or  
3 PIF, and the exhibit form are required to be  
4 served by Ms. Anderson on behalf of the Board  
5 and on all opposing parties in this matter  
6 seven days before the date of the hearing.

7 If we don't receive a copy of your  
8 PIF, your application or your protest is  
9 subject to dismissal.

10 Likewise, if we don't receive a  
11 copy of the exhibit form and the exhibits  
12 themselves your exhibits maybe excluded from  
13 the record upon the finding that the opposing  
14 party has been prejudiced or no good cause for  
15 failure to submit has been shown.

16 Likewise, witnesses, other than  
17 the party may also be subject to exclusion if  
18 they're not identified ahead of time to both  
19 the Board and the parties within those seven  
20 days. So these deadlines are very important  
21 and you don't want to miss them.
