AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of H Street Country Club please come forward?

This is Case #14-PRO-00002, Par Bar, LLC, trading as H Street Country Club, 1335 H Street, Northeast; License #ABRA-076649. This is a Retailer CT, Termination of Settlement Agreement. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet.

My name is La Verne Fletcher and I'm conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent, pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2.

Introductions beginning with the Applicant?

MR. ENGLERT: Yes. My name is Joe Englert. I'm a managing member of the establishment.

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Englert, would you spell your name for the Court Reporter,

1 please?

2 MR. ENGLERT: It is E-N-G-L-E-R-T.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

4 And on behalf of ANC 6A?

5 MR. WILLIAMS: Good morning. Jay
6 Williams for ANC 6A. I'm a Commissioner for
7 single-member District 6A05 and the Chair of
8 the Alcoholic Beverage Licensing Committee.

9 MS. FLETCHER: And Mr. Williams,
10 how do you spell your first name?

11 MR. WILLIAMS: J-A-Y.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

13 ANC 6A does have standing as a
14 protestant. We need to set a date for a
15 mediation, a status hearing and a protest
16 hearing. I'll give you the dates for the
17 status hearing and protest hearing first.

18 The date for the status hearing is
19 April 23, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. -- April 23rd at
20 9:30.

21 The protest hearing is set for
22 June 4, 2014, at 1:30 p.m.

1 We need to set a date for
2 mediation to occur prior to April 23rd. The
3 first available date in March is Tuesday,
4 March 18 at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00 or 1:00.

5 MR. WILLIAMS: Yes. I can do that
6 date. Do you want to do -- what -- 10:00
7 o'clock on the -- it was the 18th, you said?

8 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

9 MR. WILLIAMS: Do you want to do
10 10:00 o'clock on the 18th?

11 MR. ENGLERT: Yes. That's this
12 coming -- yes.

13 MR. WILLIAMS: So that's a week
14 from tomorrow, right?

15 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

16 Okay. So mediation is set for
17 Tuesday, April 18 at 10:00.

18 MR. WILLIAMS: Maybe we can roll
19 in Rock 'n Roll Hotel as well because I think
20 Mr. Englert represents them.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, we can do them
22 at the same time if you like.

1 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay.

2 MS. FLETCHER: If that's okay with
3 you, Mr. Englert. You both just have to agree
4 to do them both at the same time.

5 MR. WILLIAMS: I don't see any
6 problem with that. Do you?

7 MR. ENGLERT: No.

8 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So mediation
10 is set for Tuesday, March 18 at 10:00.

11 The Roll Call Hearing in this
12 matter is concluded.
