AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of Madam's Organ please come forward -- the parties in the matter of Madam's Organ?

This is Case #14-PRO-00007, Madam's Organ trading as Madam's Organ, 2461 18th Street, Northwest; License #ABRA-025273. This is a Retailer CT, Termination of Settlement Agreement. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet.

My name is La Verne Fletcher and I'm conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent, pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2.

Introductions beginning with the Applicant?

MR. BIANCO: Good morning, Ms. Fletcher. Richard Bianco on behalf of the Applicant.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.

1 Bianco.

2 And would you spell your name for
3 the Court Reporter?

4 MR. BIANCO: Sure. My first name
5 is Richard; last name is Bianco -- B-I-A-N-C-
6 O.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

8 And on behalf of ANC 1C?

9 MR. SIMPSON: William Simpson on
10 behalf of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
12 Simpson.

13 ANC 1C does have standing as a
14 protestant.

15 We need to set a date for the
16 status hearing, the protest hearing and
17 mediation. I'll give you the date for the
18 status and protest hearings first.

19 The time for the status hearing is
20 -- well, the date and time -- April 23, 2014,
21 at 9:30 a.m.

22 The protest hearing is set for

1 June 4 at 4:30 p.m.

2 We need to set a date for
3 mediation to occur prior to the April 23rd --

4 MR. SIMPSON: Ms. Fletcher?

5 MS. FLETCHER: Yes?

6 MR. SIMPSON: June 4th is actually
7 the date of Advisory Neighborhood Commission
8 1C's monthly meeting of which I am the Chair.
9 Would it be possible to have that date
10 adjusted so that it won't conflict with our
11 meeting that night?

12 MR. BIANCO: We would support the
13 request for a change in date provided that
14 it's earlier and not later.

15 MR. SIMPSON: That would be fine.

16 MS. FLETCHER: What you're going
17 to need to do, Mr. Simpson and Mr. Bianco,
18 just make a joint request to Martha Jenkins.

19 I'm going to make a note that
20 you'll be doing that. I'll leave the date on
21 the record that I stated. But petition Martha
22 to change it to an earlier date.

1 I'll let her know that you'll be
2 doing that.

3 MR. SIMPSON: Thank you.

4 MS. FLETCHER: So the protest
5 hearing is set for June 4 at 4:30. But I've
6 made a note that you're going to petition
7 Martha Jenkins to make it earlier.

8 The Roll Call Hearing is
9 concluded.

10 MR. BIANCO: We need the mediation
11 date.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, I didn't give
13 you the mediation date. I'll give you that
14 anyway. I should still give you that.
15 Thanks.

16 Okay. So we're into April for the
17 mediation dates.

18 The first available date is
19 Tuesday, April 1st at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00 or
20 1:00.

21 MR. BIANCO: I'm available. I can
22 do 1:00 o'clock.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Is that good for
2 you, Mr. Simpson?

3 MR. SIMPSON: That'd be fine.
4 Yes.

5 MS. FLETCHER: The mediation is
6 set for Tuesday, April 1.

7 Okay. Now the Roll Call Hearing
8 is concluded.

9 MR. SIMPSON: Thank you very much.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
