1 hours are Monday through Saturday, 9:00 a.m.
2 to 12:00 a.m. And there's no voluntary
3 agreement in this case.

4 I would move that we approve. Do

4 for Upper Crust Pizza at 1747 Pennsylvania
5 Avenue, N.W. in ANC 2B. There's no
6 voluntary agreement in this case and it's
7 located in an area where it is not going to
8 be impacting residents.

9 So I would move that we approve
10 this application. Do I have a second?

9 and Saturday, 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. And
10 this is located in ANC 6A. It's H Street
11 Country Club, 1335 H Street, N.E., License
12 No. 76649.

13 I would move that we placard this
14 one just to be on the safe side. This is
15 one that residents might have an interest
16 in. Is there a second?

14 to include Friday from 8:00 p.m. to 2:00
15 a.m. And the Licensee is also requesting
16 approval of entertainment on the eve of
17 seven holidays; Martin Luther King Day,
18 President's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July,
19 Labor Day, Columbus Day and Veteran's Day.

20 This one has an apparent conflict
21 with the voluntary agreement. Section 3 of
22 that agreement says entertainment on

1 Saturday only, so therefore I would move
2 that we deny this application. Do I have a
3 second?

4 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any
6 comments?

3 It's P.J. Clarke's and Sidecar, 1600 K
4 Street, N.W., License No. 84688.

5 I would recommend that we
6 postpone consideration of this one until
7 April 4th. Do I have a second?

8 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any

11 therefore I would move that we re-placard
