3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Before we
4 get to our next hearing, we are running an hour
5 behind today, we have just a few agenda items
6 that the Board needs to vote on that won't take
7 very long. They will take five minutes, I think.

8 Okay. The first is the Cancellation
9 Agenda. We only have one item on the
10 Cancellation Agenda, which is Brother's Liquors
11 located at 1140 Florida Avenue, N.E., ABRA No.
12 084857.

13 This license is closing the business
14 and is no longer in need of a license and has
15 requested cancellation of the license.

16 So I move that we cancel it.

17 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second it.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Silverstein
19 has seconded the motion.

20 All those in favor say aye.

21 ALL: Aye.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

1 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
2 passes 5-0-0.

3 Next we have a Cease and Desist Agenda
4 for Class B Manufacturers. We again have one
5 establishment on this agenda and that is
6 Chocolate City Beer located at 2801 8th Street,
7 N.E. The licensee did not make its second year
8 payment and the License No. is 085708.

9 I move that we issue a Cease and
10 Desist Order for this establishment. Do I have a
11 second?

12 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Silverstein
14 seconded the motion.

15 All those in favor say aye.

16 ALL: Aye.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
19 passes 5-0-0. And this will be set forth in
20 Board Order No. 2015-128.

21 Next we have a Cease and Desist Agenda
22 for Class A Retailers. We have seven

1 establishments in which the licensee did not
2 renew. I'm going to read them and we can vote on
3 them.

4 The first one is ABRA No. 086499,
5 Frederick P. Winner.

6 The second one is ABRA No. 000023,
7 District Liquors.

8 The third one is ABRA No. 024362,
9 Uptown Wine and Spirits.

10 The fourth one is ABRA No. 060113,
11 Columbia Wine & Liquors.

12 Five is ABRA No. 088121, Crown
13 Liquors.

14 Six is ABRA No. 088222, Stop & Shop
15 Liquors.

16 Seven is The Cocktail Shop, ABRA No.
17 093942.

18 I move that we issue Cease and Desist
19 Orders for those licensees.

20 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Silverstein
22 has seconded the motion.

1 All those in favor say aye.

2 ALL: Aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
4 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
5 passes 5-0-0.

6 And the first one, Winner is Board
7 Order No. 2015-130; District Liquors is Board
8 Order No. 2015-131; Uptown Wine and Spirits is
9 Board Order No. 2015-132; Columbia Wine & Liquors
10 is Board Order No. 2015-133; Crown Liquors, No.
11 5, is Board Order No. 2015-134; No. 6, Stop &
12 Shop Liquors is Board Order No. 2015-135; and The
13 Cocktail Shop is Board Order No. 2015-137.

14 So that concludes our agenda items and
15 we can go back to our hearing schedule.

16 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
17 went off the record at 12:05 p.m. and resumed at
18 6:45 p.m.)

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We are
20 back on the record to do the Board's Agendas for
21 April 8, 2015.

22 We will start with the Legal Agenda.

1 The first item on the Legal Agenda is a review of
2 the primary American Source of Supply Amendment
3 Proposal dated February 26, 2015 submitted by
4 Paul Pascal, Esq. on behalf of the District of
5 Columbia Association of Beverage Alcohol
6 Wholesalers.

7 I move that we postpone this review
8 until April 22nd. Do I have a second?

9 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has
11 seconded the motion.

12 All those in favor say aye.

13 ALL: Aye.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
15 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
16 passes 4-0-0.

17 No. 2 is a review of a Recommendation
18 of Amendment of Procedural Regulations under
19 Title 23, Municipal Regulations dated March 25,
20 2015 submitted by Chairperson Ronald Austin on
21 behalf of ANC-4B.

22 No action is required on this. This

1 will be considered in accordance with our April
2 29th rulemaking.

3 Okay. We have a Supplemental Legal
4 Agenda. The first item is a review of off-site
5 storage request submitted by Michael Fonseca,
6 Esq. on behalf of Doi Moi dated March 30, 2015.
7 Doi Moi is located at 1800 14th Street, N.W.,
8 License No. 088683.

9 I move that we approve this off-site
10 storage request.

11 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.
13 Rodriguez has seconded the motion.

14 All those in favor say aye.

15 ALL: Aye.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
17 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
18 passes 4-0-0.

19 No. 2 is a letter of clarification
20 submitted by Margie A.S. Lehrman, Esq. on behalf
21 of Jos. A. Magnus & Co. dated April 1, 2015.
22 Jos. A. Magnus & Co. is located at 2052 West

1 Virginia Avenue, N.E., License No. 097825.

2 I think that this letter had a few
3 requests in it. The first one dealt with
4 requesting off-site storage. And I would be
5 moving that we approve that request.

6 And the second request dealt with
7 their providing an interpretation of
8 manufacturers under Title 5 and asking if we
9 would agree with the interpretation. And I would
10 suggest that we do.

11 And then there was a third request
12 asking, I guess, if we agreed with an
13 interpretation with the law that goes into
14 effect, I think, around April 22nd or so. It's
15 not in effect yet, so I would move that we hold
16 off responding to that request until the law is
17 in effect.

18 So that would be my motion for all
19 three.

20 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr. Short
22 has seconded the motion. Any other requests or

1 comments? Okay.

2 All those in favor say aye.

3 ALL: Aye.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
5 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
6 passes 4-0-0.

7 No. 3 is a request for reconsideration
8 of Board Order No. 2015-117 submitted by Lisa
9 Drazin, Trustee. The Bernice J. Drazin Trust
10 dated April 2, 2015 as related to Pop's Seabar
11 located at 1817 Columbia Road, N.W., License No.
12 087585.

13 This is a request for reconsideration
14 of a Board Order, but I think they dismissed her
15 -- dismissed them as a party because she didn't
16 show up at Roll Call. That's my recollection. I
17 think this is a hard one for me. We have notice
18 that -- oh, she said she didn't show up because
19 she didn't get notice. And our records show that
20 notice was sent to her address of record.

21 I don't know. Does somebody want to
22 make a motion on this or a comment? This kind of

1 thing bothers me, because I know, you know, we
2 have, you know, evidence that we did send it to
3 her at the right address.

4 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: I make a motion
5 that we deny, Madam Chair.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So Mr.
7 Rodriguez has made a motion that we deny. Is
8 there a second?

9 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Second, okay.

11 All those in favor say aye.

12 ALL: Aye.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
14 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
15 passes then 4-0-0. As much as I don't like to do
16 it, I think that the evidence shows that it was
17 sent to her. Okay.

18 And there was an opposition to that
19 request for reconsideration. Actually, that was
20 read and considered by the Board in connection
21 with the request, so no action is required for
22 No. 4.

1 No. 5 is a settlement agreement
2 between ANC-2F and The Dabney dated April 1,
3 2015. The Dabney is located at 1216-1226 9th
4 Street, N.W., License No. 097803.

5 I move that we approve this settlement
6 agreement with modifications to Clause 2 on page
7 1, which addresses any changes to the model and
8 it's too broad and our General Counsel can help
9 them with the language. Do I have a second?

10 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr. Short
12 has seconded the motion.

13 All those in favor say aye.

14 ALL: Aye.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
16 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
17 passes 4-0-0.

18 No. 6 is a settlement agreement among
19 ANC-3C, Cleveland Park Citizens Association and
20 Coppi's Organic Restaurant dated March 31, 2015.
21 Coppi's is located at 3321 Connecticut Avenue,
22 N.W., License No. 096458.

1 I move that we approve this settlement
2 agreement contingent upon modification to the
3 entertainment endorsement in accordance with
4 Paragraph 1 of their settlement agreement.

5 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And Mr. Rodriguez
7 has seconded the motion.

8 All those in favor say aye.

9 ALL: Aye.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
11 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
12 passes 4-0-0.

13 No. 7 is a settlement agreement
14 between ANC-4D and Lucky Corner Store dated April
15 6, 2015. Lucky Corner Store is located at 5335
16 Georgia Avenue, N.W., License No. 093115.

17 I move that we approve this agreement.
18 Do I have a second?

19 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
21 seconded the motion.

22 All those in favor say aye.

1 ALL: Aye.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
4 passes 4-0-0. And this will be set forth in
5 Board Order 2015-136.

6 No. 8 is a review of a trademark
7 agreement between Proximo Restaurant, LLC and
8 LLJ, Inc. dated March 30, 2015. It is related to
9 Minibar/Barmini located at 855 E Street, N.W.,
10 License No. 089911.

11 And this is just an FYI. No action is
12 required.

13 No. 9, 10 and 11 all refer to the same
14 issue. No. 9 is a Notice of Violation of
15 Settlement Contract submitted by Lyle Blanchard,
16 Esq. on behalf of group of 10 protestants dated
17 March 16, 2015. Ibiza is located at 1222 1st
18 Street, N.E., License No. 074456.

19 No. 10 is a reply to that notice by
20 Sean Morris, Esq. on behalf of Ibiza dated March
21 20, 2015.

22 And No. 11 is a response to reply to

1 Notice of Violation of Settlement Contract
2 submitted by Lyle Blanchard dated April 2, 2015.

3 So these are all related to Ibiza and
4 I would move that we refer this matter to
5 enforcement for investigation.

6 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has
8 seconded the motion.

9 All those in favor say aye.

10 ALL: Aye.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
12 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
13 passes 4-0-0.

14 No. 12 is a request to postpone the
15 Board decision regarding Primary American Source
16 of Supply Amendment Proposal dated February 26,
17 2015 submitted by Michael Fonseca, Esq. on behalf
18 of D.C. Retail Liquor Dealers Association dated
19 April 3, 2015.

20 I move that we grant this request and
21 postpone consideration until April 22nd. Do I
22 have a second?

1 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
3 seconded the motion.

4 All those in favor say aye.

5 ALL: Aye.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
7 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
8 passes 4-0-0.

9 Okay. That completes our Legal
10 Agendas.

11 So we can now turn to our Licensing
12 Agendas. The first item on our Licensing Agenda
13 is an application for safekeeping of license by
14 Chief Ike's Mambo Room located at 1725 Columbia
15 Road, N.W., License No. 017940. It's an original
16 request for safekeeping.

17 I move that we approve for six months.
18 Do I have a second?

19 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
21 seconded the motion.

22 All those in favor say aye.

1 ALL: Aye.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
4 passes 4-0-0.

5 No. 2 is an application for
6 safekeeping of license by Mothership located at
7 3301 Georgia Avenue, N.W., License No. 091237.
8 It is also an original request.

9 I move that we approve for a period of
10 six months. Do I have a second?

11 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has
13 seconded the motion.

14 All those in favor say aye.

15 ALL: Aye.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
17 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
18 passes 4-0-0.

19 No. 3 is another application for
20 safekeeping of license by Staples Beer & Wine
21 Grocery located at 1364 Florida Avenue, N.E.,
22 License No. 096294.

1 I move that we approve for six months.

2 Do I have a second?

3 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez
5 seconded the motion.

6 All those in favor say aye.

7 ALL: Aye.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
9 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
10 passes 4-0-0.

11 Finally, No. 4 on this Licensing
12 Agenda is a request for a change of hours by
13 Sosnick's Liquor located at 2318 4th Street, N.E.,
14 License No. 072301.

15 I move that we approve the licensing
16 request for an extension of hours. Do I have a
17 second?

18 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
20 seconded the motion.

21 All those in favor say aye.

22 ALL: Aye.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
2 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
3 passes 4-0-0.

4 Okay. The Supplemental Licensing
5 Agenda. The first item is a review of a Writ of
6 Execution with additional documentation from Ron
7 Hunt of Capitol Hill Cabaret, Inc. requesting an
8 involuntary transfer of license. This is with
9 respect to AKA, Inc. located at 2046 West
10 Virginia Avenue, N.E., License No. 084241.

11 I move that we approve. Do I have a
12 second?

13 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
15 seconded the motion.

16 All those in favor say aye.

17 ALL: Aye.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
20 passes 4-0-0.

21 No. 2 is a review of additional
22 information in support of request for

1 reinstatement of a canceled license. It is by
2 Recess Bar located at 727 15th Street, N.W.,
3 License No. 081805.

4 I move that we approve this request.
5 Do I have a second?

6 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
8 seconded the motion.

9 All those in favor say aye.

10 ALL: Aye.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
12 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
13 passes 4-0-0.

14 And finally, No. 3 is a request for a
15 disposal permit to transport remaining alcohol
16 inventory to licensed sister establishment at 575
17 7th Street, N.W. This is by Rosa Mexicano, 5225
18 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W., License No. 088012.

19 I move that we approve. Do I have a
20 second?

21 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has

1 seconded the motion.

2 All those in favor say aye.

3 ALL: Aye.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
5 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
6 passes 4-0-0.

7 We have a Second Supplemental
8 Licensing Agenda.

9 No. 1 is an application for a new
10 Retailer Class CX multi-purpose facility with
11 wine pub permit. The establishment is District
12 Winery located at 385 Water Street, S.E., license
13 number to be determined. Okay.

14 So I move that we hold a Fact-Finding
15 Hearing on this application. Do I have a second?

16 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has
18 seconded the motion.

19 All those in favor say aye.

20 ALL: Aye.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
22 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion

1 passes 4-0-0.

2 And No. 2 is an application to extend
3 an entertainment endorsement to a sidewalk cafe.
4 Entertainment on the sidewalk cafe to include a
5 live band, not to exceed three performers,
6 dancing and cover charge will not be extended to
7 the sidewalk cafe. This is for Marriott Marquis
8 located at 901 Massachusetts Avenue, N.W.,
9 License No. 093961.

10 I move that we approve. Do I have a
11 second?

12 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
14 seconded the motion.

15 All those in favor say aye.

16 ALL: Aye.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
19 passes 4-0-0.

20 Okay. Now we have an Agenda to Vacate
21 Cease and Desist Orders of which there is one.
22 It is ABRA No. 000023, District Liquors located

1 at 1211 11th Street, N.W.

2 So I move that we approve vacating the
3 Cease and Desist Order with respect to District
4 Liquors. Do I have a second?

5 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez has
7 seconded the motion.

8 All those in favor say aye.

9 ALL: Aye.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
11 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
12 passes 4-0-0. And this will be set forth in
13 Board Order 2015-122.

14 Okay. We have a Notice of ABC Board's
15 Intent to Issue Cease and Desist Orders for Class
16 C and D Retailers. This is a list of C and D
17 Retailers that the Board will be issuing Orders
18 to Cease and Desist on April 22, 2015 to the
19 following licensees because they didn't make
20 their second or third year payments or both.
21 Okay. Okay. So this is a very long list. I'll
22 count how many pages it is. Two, three, four,

1 five, six pages with about 40 to 50
2 establishments.

3 So as this is just a notice and not
4 actually issuing the orders, I think that we
5 could approve putting this in the record that a
6 notice of all the places listed on this
7 Wednesday, April 8, 2015 Board's Intent to Issue
8 Cease and Desist Orders to Class C and D
9 Retailers.

10 Okay. This list is already up on
11 ABRA's website for everybody to see what we are
12 voting on, so I don't think it's necessary to
13 name each one, if that's all right with others
14 here?

15 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: That's fine, Madam
16 Chair.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So we are
18 just going to vote to issue this Notice of ABC
19 Board's Intent to Issue a Cease and Desist Order
20 on April 22nd and we will be back on the 22nd to
21 vote actually on the Cease and Desist Orders.
22 Okay. Okay. So do I have a second?

1 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

2 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr. Brooks
4 has seconded the motion.

5 All those in favor say aye.

6 ALL: Aye.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
8 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
9 passes 4-0-0.

10 Okay. We have one more item. This is
11 also a Notice of Board's Intent to Issue Cease
12 and Desist Orders for Class C and D Retailers.
13 And that we will be issuing Orders to Cease and
14 Desist on April 22, 2015 to the following
15 licensees for the reasons stated below:

16 This is pretty quick, so I'm going to
17 run through it.

18 Doubletree Washington DC didn't make
19 the third year payment.

20 Courtyard By Marriott did not make
21 third year payment.

22 Marriott Residence Inn/Crios didn't

1 make third year payment.

2 West End Cinema didn't make three year
3 payment.

4 Art Soiree House didn't make three
5 year payment.

6 E Street Lounge didn't make three year
7 payment.

8 Georgetown Club at Suter Tavern didn't
9 make three year payment.

10 Aramark Entertainment, LLC (Verizon
11 Center) didn't make three year payment.

12 Motor Yacht Celebrity (1 of 3) didn't
13 make three year payment.

14 Panas Gourmet Empanadas, the licensee
15 didn't make the second or third year payments.

16 And Rice Bar, the licensee didn't make
17 the third year payment.

18 So I move that we issue this Notice of
19 Intent to Issue a Cease and Desist order.

20 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.

22 Rodriguez has seconded the motion.

1 All those in favor say aye.

2 ALL: Aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
4 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
5 passes 4-0-0.

6 Okay. I think that completes our
7 agendas. And we will just do our votes on the
8 closed sessions for when we meet next which is in
9 two weeks.

10 As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
11 Beverage Control Board for the District of
12 Columbia and in accordance with Section 405 of
13 the Open Meetings Amendment Act of 2010, I move
14 that the ABC Board hold a closed meeting on April
15 22, 2015 for the purpose of seeking legal advice
16 from our counsel on the matters identified on the
17 Board's Agenda for April 22, 2015 as published in
18 the DC Register on April 17, 2015.

19 Is there a second?

20 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
22 seconded the motion. I'll now take a roll call

1 vote on the motion before us now that it has been
2 seconded.

3 Mr. Brooks?

4 MEMBER BROOKS: I agree.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez?

6 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Ms. Miller
8 agrees.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short?

10 MEMBER SHORT: I agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: As it appears
12 that the motion has passed by a 4-0-0 vote, I
13 hereby give notice that the ABC Board will hold
14 this aforementioned closed meeting pursuant to
15 the Open Meetings Amendment Act of 2010. Notice
16 will also be posted on the ABC Board hearing room
17 bulletin board, placed on the electronic calendar
18 on ABRA's website and published in the DC
19 Register in as timely a manner as practicable.

20 As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
21 Beverage Control Board for the District of
22 Columbia and in accordance with Section 405 of

1 the Open Meetings Amendment Act of 2010, I move
2 that the ABC Board hold a closed meeting on April
3 22, 2015 for the purpose of discussing and
4 hearing reports concerning ongoing or planned
5 investigations of alleged criminal or civil
6 misconduct or violations of law or regulations
7 and seeking legal advice from our counsel on the
8 Board's Investigative Agenda for April 22, 2015
9 as published in the DC Register on April 17,
10 2015.

11 Is there a second?

12 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
14 seconded the motion. I'll now take a roll call
15 vote on the motion before us now that it has been
16 seconded.

17 Mr. Brooks?

18 MEMBER BROOKS: I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez?

20 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Ms. Miller
22 agrees.

1 Mr. Short?

2 MEMBER SHORT: I agree.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It appears that
4 the motion has passed by a 4-0-0 vote. I hereby
5 give notice that the ABC Board will hold this
6 aforementioned closed meeting pursuant to the
7 Open Meetings Amendment Act of 2010. Notice will
