CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. I'd like to welcome you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Today is April 17th, 2013.

My name is Ruthanne Miller. I'm the Chairperson. Joining me to my far right is Mr. Donald Brooks. To my immediate right is Mr. Nick Alberti and to my immediate left is Mr. Mike Silverstein. We have four members in attendance for the conduct of business today with three constituting a quorum.

16 The Open Meetings Act requires
17 that the public hearing on each case be open
18 to the public. The may, consistent with
19 Section 405(b) of the Open Meetings Act, enter
20 a closed meeting during or after the public
21 hearing on a case to consult with an attorney,
22 to obtain legal advice, discuss settlement

1 agreements or deliberate upon a decision in an
2 adjudication proceeding.

3 Okay. We'll now turn to our first
4 case on the morning calendar, and that is Case
5 No. 13-PRO-00007, Fainting Goat located at 13
6 U Street, N.W., License No. 91244 in ANC 1B.

7 I don't see anybody coming
8 forward. My understanding is actually this
9 involves a protest hearing and I believe the
10 parties have signed a settlement agreement and
11 submitted it to the Board. So we won't be
12 seeing anybody I guess this morning on that
13 case and the Board will take up the settlement
14 agreement for review at a later time.
