CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Our next Fact-Finding Hearing is for Georgetown University. Yes, so if you could sign-in and then when you are ready, introduce yourselves for the record.

MS. De BELLIS: Hi, I'm Andi De Bellis. I'm the coordinator of this event from Georgetown University.

MS. CARLTON: Amanda Carlton. I'm the Associate Director in the Center for Student Engagement at Georgetown University.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: What's your name again?

MS. CARLTON: Amanda Carlton.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Amanda Carlton, okay. And your position is what?

MS. CARLTON: Associate Director in the Center for Student Engagement.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And what's your position, Ms. De Bellis?

1 MS. De BELLIS: I'm the Student  
2 Coordinator.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: You're the  
4 Student Coordinator. Okay. Okay.

5 INVESTIGATOR PERU: Investigator  
6 Jason Peru with ABRA.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Great.  
8 Okay. Is this a graduation-related event?

9 MS. CARLTON: No, it is not.

10 MS. De BELLIS: No.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It's not.  
12 Okay.

13 MS. De BELLIS: It's our Annual  
14 Georgetown Day, which is a campus-wide  
15 celebration at the end of the semester. And  
16 so the event takes place the entire day, but  
17 the kegger portion of it is from 4:00 to  
18 midnight.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The what  
20 portion of it?

21 MS. De BELLIS: The keg event.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, the keg

1 event. Okay.

2 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So  
4 this is annual. Have you all been involved  
5 with this? Have you been involved with this  
6 before?

7 MS. CARLTON: This is my third  
8 year --

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Third year.  
10 Okay.

11 MS. CARLTON: -- in this event and  
12 actually Andi's second year as the Student  
13 Coordinator.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, okay,  
15 good.

16 MS. CARLTON: So we do the same  
17 renewal.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good. You  
19 did the exact same thing last year?

20 MS. De BELLIS: Yes, we did.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So are  
22 you making any changes this year?

1 MS. De BELLIS: This year the big  
2 change is the venue has been moved from  
3 indoors to outdoors.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, okay.  
5 And so how are you securing that then?

6 MS. De BELLIS: So we have a two-  
7 layer barricade system. We have an entire  
8 squared-off section of barricades. Then there  
9 will be a 3 foot buffer in between another set  
10 of barricades. And we will have officers  
11 roaming in between the buffer area.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And is this  
13 open just to Georgetown University or to the  
14 public?

15 MS. De BELLIS: Just to Georgetown  
16 University students.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And  
18 I'm not sure if I'm remembering correctly, but  
19 when you check people for IDs and stuff, you  
20 have their names and ages, right?

21 MS. De BELLIS: We have the  
22 Registrar's list to check against their birth

1 dates.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

3 MS. CARLTON: Close to 150 pages  
4 of names and birth dates of all of our  
5 registered undergrad and graduate students  
6 that we check, both their Government-issued ID  
7 and their Georgetown University ID against to  
8 make sure that birth dates match and then that  
9 the names match as well.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Great, okay.  
11 Did you have any problems last year?

12 MS. De BELLIS: No, we did not.

13 MS. CARLTON: No.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

15 MS. CARLTON: It was great last  
16 year.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And the  
18 outside is the only thing that is changing?

19 MS. De BELLIS: Yep.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All  
21 right. Do others have questions then?

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: Just for

1 clarification.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: Is campus  
4 security providing --

5 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- police?

7 MS. De BELLIS: Yes, we have both  
8 the Georgetown University Police Department  
9 and we do have some reimbursable MPD detail.

10 MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay. And so if  
11 I understand this, it's a confined area where  
12 you have to be 21 to get in to the beer garden  
13 area?

14 MS. De BELLIS: The beer garden  
15 area, yes, you have to be 21. There is also  
16 going to be a concert going on at the same  
17 time, which is all ages that has no check-in  
18 requirement.

19 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right. But so is  
20 consumption confined to --

21 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

22 MS. CARLTON: Yes.

1 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- the --

2 MS. De BELLIS: No alcohol is  
3 allowed outside of that, yes.

4 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- area? Great.  
5 Thanks.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Others?  
7 Well, let me ask you before I ask Mr. Peru.  
8 Do you have any other applications before us  
9 for events or is this the only one?

10 MS. De BELLIS: This is the only  
11 one for that day, yes.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: This is the  
13 only one for that day?

14 MS. De BELLIS: Yes, um-hum.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. There  
16 might -- I can't remember if you had  
17 graduation once or not.

18 MS. De BELLIS: We have three,  
19 four graduation times, but we have -- we are  
20 submitting the application today.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

22 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And  
2 let me just say, we are not on those, but just  
3 so -- are those graduation ones, are they  
4 going to be a few or are they going to be the  
5 same type? Are they going to be --

6 MS. De BELLIS: Oh, the same type.  
7 We typically have them every year.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right.

9 MS. De BELLIS: The same thing.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Same thing?

11 MS. De BELLIS: Yeah.

12 MS. CARLTON: They are limited  
13 though just to senior class members, so it's  
14 not opened as broadly to the campus committee,  
15 but we use the same kind of 21 and over  
16 processes and procedures.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And in  
18 the past, do you recall, did you have --  
19 because not every application has a Fact-  
20 Finding Hearing, so I just kind of what to see  
21 what's out there.

22 MS. De BELLIS: Last year we did

1 have a Fact-Finding Hearing.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All  
3 right. Mr. Peru, do you have any questions  
4 about this?

5 INVESTIGATOR PERU: Yes.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

7 INVESTIGATOR PERU: Just one. You  
8 mentioned barriers that you put up. What type  
9 of barriers do you guys have up?

10 MS. De BELLIS: They are 4 foot  
11 bike racks. They are metal bike racks.

12 INVESTIGATOR PERU: 4 foot bike  
13 racks?

14 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

15 INVESTIGATOR PERU: And you said  
16 there is two layers?

17 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

18 INVESTIGATOR PERU: So there is  
19 one layer of bike racks and then there is a  
20 space in between?

21 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

22 INVESTIGATOR PERU: And then

1 another row of bike racks?

2 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

3 MS. CARLTON: Yes, to keep from  
4 handing over.

5 INVESTIGATOR PERU: So then that's  
6 why I asked.

7 MS. CARLTON: Um-hum.

8 INVESTIGATOR PERU: Because of the  
9 height of the actual barricades.

10 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

11 INVESTIGATOR PERU: And how many--  
12 do you know exactly how many police officers  
13 or reimbursable detail members you are going  
14 to be having?

15 MS. De BELLIS: We have three  
16 reimbursable detail and 15 campus police  
17 officers to start with. And they will add  
18 throughout the evening, if the crowd gets  
19 larger.

20 INVESTIGATOR PERU: So 15 police  
21 will be on -- just assigned to that venue?

22 MS. De BELLIS: Yes.

1                   INVESTIGATOR PERU: Just assigned  
2 to the event?

3                   MS. De BELLIS: Yep.

4                   INVESTIGATOR PERU: And there is  
5 only -- I'm looking at this diagram that you  
6 submitted. Where is -- how many entries are  
7 here on this?

8                   MS. De BELLIS: There is one entry  
9 into the beer garden. One entry/exit and then  
10 in the case of an emergency, we can slide the  
11 barricades open in the back to allow for an  
12 exit towards the -- there is a building off to  
13 that side.

14                  INVESTIGATOR PERU: And who is  
15 checking IDs exactly?

16                  MS. De BELLIS: We have university  
17 administrators and there will also be our  
18 officers and that's kind of over the --

19                  INVESTIGATOR PERU: Are the  
20 university administrators or yourself, are you  
21 guys TIPS-certified? Anybody has any kind of  
22 training?

1 MS. De BELLIS: She has.

2 MS. CARLTON: Yes, we have TIPS  
3 trained folks as well.

4 INVESTIGATOR PERU: Okay.

5 MS. CARLTON: And then again we  
6 will be using the system of multiple checks  
7 back against the Georgetown University ID, the  
8 Government-issued ID and then the Registrar's  
9 official list of student names and birth  
10 dates.

11 INVESTIGATOR PERU: And what --  
12 will you be on-site as point of contact  
13 throughout the night?

14 MS. De BELLIS: Um-hum, yep.

15 INVESTIGATOR PERU: Okay. Those  
16 are all the questions I have.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Any  
18 other questions? Okay. We asked you a lot of  
19 questions the years before and everything has  
20 gone well, so that's great. Do you have any  
21 questions for us on anything? All right.

22 Then I'm going to move that we

1 approve this application. Do I have a second?

2 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez  
4 seconded the motion.

5 All those in favor say aye.

6 ALL: Aye.

7 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: All those in  
8 favor say aye.

9 ALL: Aye.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
11 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
12 passes 5-0-0. Okay. So we will just sign off  
13 on this now.

14 I hope you get good weather for  
15 your outdoor event.

16 MS. De BELLIS: Hope so, too. We  
17 are paying very close attention.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Are you going  
19 to have a tent if it --

20 MS. CARLTON: We do have a portion  
21 of it tented where the stage is for our audio  
22 equipment.
