CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The next case on the morning calendar is Case No. 12-AUD-00053, Churreria Madrid Restaurant located at 2505 Champlain Street, N.W., License No. 60806 in ANC 1C.

MR. RIVERO: Board's indulgence, please.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

MR. RIVERO: Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

MR. RIVERO: Fernando Rivero for the District of Columbia standing in for Louise Phillips.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning.

MR. GIRON: Ernesto Giron, vice-president of M St. Enterprises.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr. Giron, did you receive notice of this hearing?

MR. GIRON: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Did you read

1 it and understand it?

2 MR. GIRON: Yes, I did.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Then
4 we're going to move that the notice become
5 part of this record, if there's no objection.

6 All right. Then are there any
7 preliminary issues in this case?

8 MR. RIVERO: Yes, thank you. The
9 parties have an Offer in Compromise to present
10 to the Board at this time, and that Offer in
11 Compromise consists of a fine of \$6,000
12 payable within 60 days. That's 4,000 for
13 charge 1 and 2,000 for charge 2.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.
15 Giron, are you agreeable to that Offer in
16 Compromise of a fine of \$6,000 payable within
17 60 days? It's \$4,000 for the first charge and
18 2,000 for the second.

19 MR. GIRON: Yes, I am.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And you
21 understand that you waive your right to a
22 hearing by accepting an Offer in Compromise?

1 MR. GIRON: Yes, I do.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Are
3 there Board questions?

4 (No audible response.)

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.
6 Then I would move that the Board accept this
7 Offer in Compromise of \$6,000 payable within
8 60 days; 4,000 for the first charge, 2,000 for
9 the second charge. Is there a second?

10 MEMBER BROOKS: I second.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
12 has seconded the motion. All those in favor
13 of the Offer in Compromise, say aye?

14 (Chorus of ayes.)

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
16 opposed?

17 (No audible response.)

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 abstaining?

20 (No audible response.)

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Then the
22 Offer in Compromise is approved. The motion
