CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We're back on the Agenda with our Meeting Agenda.

So, first on the agenda is a request from a licensee to increase the number of sidewalk caf, seats on 14th Street Northwest from six seats to eight seats and to increase the number of tables from three tables to four tables.

There is a conflict with an existing Board Order. This is ANC 2B, the establishment's Policy, 1903 14th Street Northwest, License No. 76804. However, I would recommend that we amend our Board Order and approve the request to increase the seats and tables as requested.

Do I have a second?

MEMBER NOPHLIN: Second.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any comments?

Those in favor say aye.

1 ALL: Aye.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 opposed? All those abstaining.

4 And then the vote is six-zero-
5 zero to grant their request.

6 Second on our agenda is our
7 review of a sidewalk caf, application for 45
8 seats. Proposed sidewalk caf, hours of
9 operation and hours of alcoholic beverage
10 sales/service will be Sunday through
11 Thursday, 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m, Friday and
12 Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. There's no
13 Voluntary Agreement for this establishment.
14 And it's an ANC 4C. The establishment is
15 Sabor Latino Bar& Grill at 3910 14th Street
16 Northwest, License No. 84113.

17 I would recommend that we placard
18 this request.

19 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Any
21 comments?

22 MEMBER MOBLEY: I think that

1 Board Member Alberti did ask that we check
2 the name, verify the name of the
3 establishment.

4 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes. Yes. On
5 the outside of the establishment.

6 MEMBER MOBLEY: Yes. Just to be
7 sure.

8 MEMBER ALBERTI: But that's just
9 a reminder to investigate that.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I
11 think that we can still vote and request a
12 second placarding period?

13 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

15 MEMBER MOBLEY: Yes.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.

17 Then all those in favor -- wait a second.

18 To placard this, do I have a
19 second?

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All
22 those in favor say aye.

1 ALL: Aye.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 opposed? And all those abstaining?

4 Then the vote is six-zero-zero to
5 placard.

6 Okay. Number three, there's a
7 few different requests in it. It's for the
8 Don Juan Restaurant & Carryout at 1660
9 Lamont Street Northwest, License No. 15934
10 requesting a change of hours of operation
11 and hours of alcoholic beverage
12 sales/service, entertainment hours and
13 sidewalk caf, hours of operation, and hours
14 of alcoholic beverage sales/services.

15 The current hours of operation
16 and yours of alcoholic beverage
17 sales/service for the premises are Sunday
18 through Thursday 11:00 a.m. to 1:40 a.m.,
19 Friday and Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 2:40 a.m.
20 The proposes premises hours of operation and
21 hours of alcoholic beverage sales/service
22 for Sunday through Thursday are 11:00 a.m.

1 to 2:00 a.m. and Friday and Saturday 11:00
2 a.m. to 3:00 a.m.

3 The current entertainment hours
4 are Sunday through Thursday 7:00 p.m. to
5 1:40 a.m., Friday and Saturday 7:00 a.m. to
6 2:40 a.m.

7 The proposed entertainment hours
8 are: Sunday through Thursday 11:00 a.m. to
9 2:00 a.m., and Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 3:00
10 a.m. This is only 20 minutes later.

11 Okay. The current sidewalk caf,
12 hours of operation and hours of alcoholic
13 beverage sales and services are Monday
14 through Friday 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. and
15 Saturday and Sunday 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.
16 The proposed sidewalk caf, hours and
17 operation and hours of alcoholic beverage
18 sales/services are Sunday through Thursday
19 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m., two hours
20 difference, and Friday and Saturday 11:00
21 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. And that's again, with
22 two hours more.

1 There's no Voluntary Agreement in
2 this case.

3 So, I would recommend approving
4 the request for the change of hours and
5 entertainment, but a placard being the
6 sidewalk caf,. Do I have a second?

7 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Any
9 other comments?

10 All those -- well we'll do it
11 separately.

12 All those in favor of approving
13 the hours of entertainment and changing the
14 premises hours say aye.

15 ALL: Aye.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
17 opposed? All those abstaining?

18 The vote is six-zero-zero.

19 And then all those approving of
20 the motion to placard for the sidewalk caf,
21 change in hours of operation say aye.

22 ALL: Aye.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
2 opposed? All those abstaining?

3 And the vote is six-zero-zero.

4 Number 4 is the request for a
5 change of hours, and hours of alcoholic
6 beverage sales Monday through Sunday, 9:00
7 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. to the proposed hours
8 Monday through Sunday, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00
9 a.m. And it's for Bell Wine and Liquor,
10 1821 M Street Northwest, it's License No.
11 226. There's no conflict with the Voluntary
12 Agreement. It's in ANC 2B.

13 I recommend we approve this
14 request. Do I have a second on that.

15 MEMBER NOPHLIN: Second.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Comments?

17 All those in favor say aye.

18 ALL: Aye.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
20 opposed? All those abstaining?

21 And then the vote is six-zero-
22 zero.

1 Number 5 is a request for a
2 change of hours to change Sunday hours of
3 alcoholic beverage sales/service. The
4 current -- this is for FADO Irish Pub and
5 Restaurant at 803 7th Street Northwest,
6 License No. 25663. The request is to change
7 from the current Sunday hours of 10:00 a.m.
8 to 2:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. for
9 alcoholic beverage sales/service. And
10 there's no Voluntary Agreement in this case.

11 I would move to approve the
12 request. Do I have a second?

13 MEMBER NOPHLIN: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any
15 comments?

16 All those in favor say aye.

17 ALL: Aye.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 opposed? All those abstaining.

20 And the vote is six-zero-zero to
21 approve.

22 Number 6 is a request from a

1 license to increase the sidewalk caf,
2 seating from 18 seats to 40 seats. It's for
3 Petits Plats at 2653 Connecticut Avenue
4 Northwest, License No. 60146 in ANC 3C. And
5 the establishment has a public space permit
6 which does allow the 40 seats.

7 I would move to approve this
8 request. Do we have a second?

9 MEMBER MOBLEY: Second.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any
11 comments?

12 All those in favor say aye.

13 ALL: Aye.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
15 opposed? All those abstaining?

16 The vote is six-zero-zero.

17 Number 7 on the Board's agenda is
18 a letter, dated April 12, 2012 from ANC 1C
19 requesting reinstatement in the Bistro 18
20 Protest, Bistro 18 is located at 2420-2422
21 18th Street Northwest. And the License No.
22 86876.

1 I would move that we approve this
2 request. Do I have a second?

3 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any

5 comments?

6 All those in favor say aye.

7 ALL: Aye.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

9 opposed? All those abstaining?

10 And the vote is six-zero-zero to
11 approve.

12 And finally, the Board would like
13 to announce that it has come to a decision
14 in the Case No. of King's Deli and Grocery
15 located at 3651 Georgia Avenue Northwest,
16 Case No. 11-PRO-00047, which is a new
17 application for a Retailer's Class A.

18 I would move at this time that we
19 approve the application and we can issue the
20 order within 30 days.

21 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Any

1 comments on this?

2 All right. So what's before us is
3 to officially approve King's Deli and
4 Grocery application. I have a motion that's
5 been seconded. All those in favor say aye.

6 ALL: Aye.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
8 opposed? All those abstaining?

9 And the vote is six-zero-zero to
10 approve the King's Deli and Grocery
11 application. And due this approval, I would
12 move that we deny the Retailer's Class A
13 license for Aman Liquors which is located
14 within 400 feet. Because it can't be
15 located within 400 feet and now that we've
16 approved this other case, it would be.

17 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. I
19 have a motion, it's been seconded. Any
20 comments.

21 Okay. All those in favor of the
22 motion say aye.

1 ALL: Aye.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 opposed? all those abstaining?

4 Okay. Then the motion passes by
5 a vote of six-zero-zero.

6 And that concludes our agenda for
7 April 25, 2012. And I will just read the
8 closing.

9 Thank you. All right.

10 As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
11 Beverage Control Board for the District of
12 Columbia and in accordance with Section 405
13 of the Open Meetings Amendment Act of 2010,

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Ms. Miller
8 agrees.

9 Mr. Silverstein?

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Jones?
