CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. The next case is Case No. 14-PRO-00003, Little Miss Whiskey's Golden Dollar located at 1104 H Street, N.E., License No. 79090, in ANC-6A. Good morning.

MR. THORPE: Good morning, Mark Thorpe, owner of Little Miss Whiskey's Golden Dollar.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

MR. WILLIAMS: Good morning, Jay Williams on behalf of ANC-6A.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Any matters you need to bring to our attention?

MR. WILLIAMS: I don't think so.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Your hearing date is June 4, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. For the record, you may have been listening, but I want to repeat that prior to your hearing date, you should receive a Protest Information Form and Exhibit Form. You need to submit

1 those forms and the exhibits themselves to Ms.
2 Anderson on behalf of the Board and to the
3 opposing parties seven days before the date of
4 the hearing.

5 If you don't submit those, if you
6 don't submit your PIF, your termination
7 proceeding and your protest against that could
8 be dismissed.

9 If you don't submit your Exhibit
10 Form and exhibits, your exhibits may be
11 excluded from the record upon a finding that
12 the opposing party has been prejudiced or no
13 good cause for the failure to submit has been
14 shown.

15 Likewise, witnesses other than a
16 party may be subject to exclusion if not
17 identified on the PIF and that means by name,
18 not just category.

19 Okay. These forms are very
20 important. The Board uses them and I think
21 they are useful to both sides to knowing how
22 to prepare for the hearing. So if you have

1 any questions, you can contact Ms. Anderson,
2 442-6492, or Ms. Jenkins.

3 MR. WILLIAMS: A brief clarifying
4 question. Is it an exhibit list or the actual
5 exhibits need to be submitted a week before?

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Both.

7 MR. WILLIAMS: Both. Okay. Thank
8 you.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And on the
10 Board and on the parties.

11 MR. WILLIAMS: Right.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Okay.
