3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The next case is
4 Case No. 15-CC-00004, West End Market located at
5 2424 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., License No.
6 90448, in ANC-2A.

7 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board
8 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of
9 Columbia.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning, Mr.
11 Rivero. And over here we have?

12 MS. WAHABZADAH: Good morning, Board
13 Members. My name is Rema Wahabzadah.

14 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Please, speak up.

15 MS. WAHABZADAH: Sorry. My name is
16 Rema Wahabzadah. I'm counsel for the licensee.
17 Sitting to my left is Mr. Eun as principal of the
18 license.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

20 INTERPRETER YANG: Sung Yang, Korean
21 Interpreter.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Okay. I

1 think we have an oath for an Interpreter. I just
2 have to put my hands on it. Okay. This is for
3 Korean, correct? Korean language?

4 INTERPRETER YANG: Yes.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. If you
6 could raise your hand?

7 Do you solemnly affirm that you will
8 faithfully and accurately interpret the
9 proceedings in this matter from Korean into
10 English and from English into Korean to the best
11 of your ability?

12 INTERPRETER YANG: I do.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. Thank
14 you.

15 All right. So my first question is
16 did respondent receive notice of this hearing? I
17 guess that goes to counsel.

18 MS. WAHABZADAH: Yes.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes?

20 MR. EUN: Yes.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And did he read
22 it and understand it?

1 MR. EUN: Yes.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So he
3 doesn't have any notice issues, correct? You got
4 notice of this hearing today?

5 MR. EUN: That's correct.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Are there
7 any preliminary matters in this case?

8 MR. RIVERO: The parties do not have
9 an Offer in Compromise to present at this time.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

11 MR. RIVERO: However, the parties are
12 continuing to work on an Offer in Compromise.
13 Should one materialize, we will ask for another
14 Status Hearing perhaps at the end of May.

15 Currently, the Show Cause Hearing is
16 set for June 3rd.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Correct.

18 MR. RIVERO: The Government has a
19 conflict on that date.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: You have a
21 conflict?

22 MR. RIVERO: Yes. We have conferred

1 with the parties for June 24th as a date that is
2 available for both parties, should this matter
3 reach the stage of Show Cause. So we would
4 request that date if it's available or thereafter
5 or we can work with the attorney for the Board to
6 set a date if one is not available, at this time.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Okay. As
8 of now, that date is not available. July 15th is
9 or do you want to just -- if you know you can do
10 it, we can schedule it, otherwise --

11 MR. RIVERO: Sure. A brief
12 indulgence, please.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

14 MR. RIVERO: July 15th is the date that
15 was proposed?

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes.

17 MR. RIVERO: That date actually works
18 for both parties.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Is there
20 a time? Okay. All right. Then this Show Cause
21 Hearing is going to be rescheduled for July 15th,
22 11:00 a.m. Okay. Thank you.
