met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing  
Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W.,  
Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Ms. LaVerne  
Fletcher, Agent, presiding.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: And, Mr. Yang, there  
4 is one other case, I don't know if you are aware,  
5 that -- okay, thank you. I'll let you know when  
6 that one is called. Thank you.

7 Would the parties in the matter of  
8 Master Liquors please come forward? The parties  
9 in the matter of Master Liquors. This is Case  
10 No. 15-PRO-00035, 18th & D Liquors, Inc. t/a  
11 Master Liquors, 1806 D Street, N.E., License No.  
12 ABRA-074594. This is a Retailer Class A License  
13 renewal.

14 The protest issues are adverse impact  
15 on peace, order and quiet and pedestrian safety.

16 My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'm  
17 conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's  
18 Agent pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2.

19 Introductions beginning with the  
20 applicant.

21 MR. BRILEY, JR.: Johnnie B. Briley,  
22 owner.

1                   AGENT FLETCHER: And how do you spell  
2                   Johnnie?

3                   MR. BRILEY, JR.: J-O-H-N-N-I-E.

4                   AGENT FLETCHER: And what's the last  
5                   name again?

6                   MR. BRILEY, JR.: B-R-I-L-E-Y.

7                   AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.  
8                   Briley. And would you -- are you filling in the  
9                   information on the contact sheet already? Thank  
10                  you. And your name, sir?

11                  MR. BRILEY, SR.: James Boyd Briley,  
12                  Sr.

13                  AGENT FLETCHER: And what was the  
14                  middle name?

15                  MR. BRILEY, SR.: James Boyd, B-O-Y-D.

16                  AGENT FLETCHER: And present on behalf  
17                  of the group of individuals?

18                  MS. COOK-SHYOBITZ: Becky Cook-  
19                  Shyobitz.

20                  AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. And would  
21                  you please spell your name for the record?

22                  MS. COOK-SHYOBITZ: B-E-C-K-Y last

1 name is Cook-Shyobitz, C-O-O-K hyphen S-H-Y-O-B-  
2 I-T-Z.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.  
4 Are there any other individuals from your group  
5 present today?

6 MS. COOK-SHYOBITZ: No, not present.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Which is fine. I  
8 know that you are the designated representative  
9 and it is fine that you appear on behalf of the  
10 group. Your group of 17 is granted standing  
11 today. They will maintain that standing only if  
12 four other people from your group that are not  
13 present today appear for the Status Hearing.  
14 It's fine that you represent the group today. By  
15 the date of the Status Hearing, the Board needs  
16 to see a total of five faces.

17 MS. COOK-SHYOBITZ: Okay.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: So in effect, the  
19 group is granted conditional standing and the  
20 Board will grant full standing at the Status  
21 Hearing and I'll give you the date for that in a  
22 moment.

1           The date for the Status Hearing is  
2 going to be June 24 at 9:30 a.m.

3           MR. BRILEY, SR.: Pardon me.

4           AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.

5           MR. BRILEY, SR.: Could we move the  
6 time up just slightly because of the traffic  
7 getting into the --

8           MR. BRILEY, JR.: Or back.

9           MR. BRILEY, SR.: -- area?

10          AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. Status Hearings  
11 are always set at the same time. They never  
12 change.

13          MR. BRILEY, SR.: Okay.

14          MR. BRILEY, JR.: Thank you.

15          MR. BRILEY, SR.: 9:30?

16          AGENT FLETCHER: 9:30.

17          MR. BRILEY, SR.: Okay.

18          MR. BRILEY, JR.: Thank you.

19          AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. And just for  
20 the record, Mr. Briley, Sr. was just speaking,  
21 yes?

22          MR. BRILEY, SR.: Yes. Thank you.

1                   AGENT FLETCHER: The Protest Hearing  
2 is set for July 22nd at 1:30 p.m.

3                   And we need to set a date for  
4 mediation to occur prior to June 24. The next  
5 available date for mediation is Friday, June 12th.  
6 Friday, June 12th, it can be at 9:00, 10:00 or  
7 11:00 in the morning.

8                   MR. BRILEY, SR.: 10:00 would be  
9 preferable.

10                  MS. COOK-SHYOBITZ: I can't do that.

11                  AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. We will move  
12 on.

13                  MR. BRILEY, JR.: Which one? You  
14 can't do that date at all?

15                  MS. COOK-SHYOBITZ: Another date would  
16 be better.

17                  AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, we will move on  
18 to the next date. The next available date is  
19 Tuesday, June 16. Same time, 9:00, 10:00 or  
20 11:00 on Tuesday, June 16.

21                  MS. COOK-SHYOBITZ: I could do 9:00 or  
22 10:00.

1 MR. BRILEY, SR.: Preferably 10:00,  
2 please.

3 MR. BRILEY, JR.: 10:00.

4 AGENT FLETCHER: 10:00? Is that good  
5 for everyone?

6 MR. BRILEY, SR.: Yes.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Any questions at all?

8 MR. BRILEY, JR.: No.

9 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Then mediation  
10 is set for Tuesday, June 16th at 10:00 a.m. See  
11 you then. Thank you.

12 MR. BRILEY, JR.: Thank you.

13 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay.
