met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing
Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W.,
Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Ms. LaVerne
Fletcher, Agent, presiding.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of Sosnick's Liquor please come
5 forward? Sosnick's Liquor. This is Case No. 15-
6 PRO-00030, Sylvia & David Industries, Inc. t/a
7 Sosnick's Liquor, 2318 4th Street, N.E., License
8 No. ABRA-072301, Retailer Class A License
9 renewal.

10 The protest issues are adverse impact
11 on peace, order and quiet.

12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher and I'm
13 conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's
14 Agent pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2.

15 Introduction beginning with the
16 applicant, please.

17 MS. SYLVIA KIM: My name is Sylvia
18 Kim.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. And would
20 you, please, spell that?

21 MS. SYLVIA KIM: S-Y-L-V-I-A K-I-M.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Kim.

1 And you are the owner?

2 MS. SYLVIA KIM: Yes.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. Your
4 name, sir?

5 MR. KIM: David Kim.

6 AGENT FLETCHER: And your name, ma'am?

7 MS. JEEYUM KIM: Jeeyum Kim.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: And would you spell
9 that for the record, please?

10 MS. JEEYUM KIM: It's J-E-E-Y-U-M last
11 name K-I-M.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. And for
13 the record, let me introduce Mr. Sung Yang. He
14 is the Korean interpreter for the applicant that
15 was requested by ABRA. And Mr. Yang's name is
16 spelled S-U-N-G Y-A-N-G.

17 INTERPRETER YANG: Yes.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: And thank you very
19 much.

20 And present on behalf of ANC-5E?

21 MS. HOBAUGH: Sally Hobaugh,
22 Commissioner of 5E10.

1 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.
2 Hobaugh. Would you spell your last name for the
3 record?

4 MS. HOBAUGH: H-O-B-A-U-G-H.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
6 ANC-5E does have standing as a protestant. We
7 need to set a date for a mediation, a Status
8 Hearing and a Protest Hearing. I'll give you the
9 dates for the Status and Protest Hearing first.

10 The Status Hearing is scheduled for
11 June 24 at 9:30 a.m.

12 The Status Hearing is scheduled for
13 July 22nd at 1:30 p.m.

14 We need to set a date for mediation to
15 occur prior to the June 24th Status Hearing. I'll
16 give you the next date available for mediation.
17 If that's not good, let me know and we will keep
18 going through the calendar. The first date
19 available for mediation is Thursday, July the 11th
20 at 9:00 or 10:00 in the morning.

21 MS. HOBAUGH: So that's after the
22 Status Hearing date?

1 AGENT FLETCHER: The Status Hearing is
2 June 24.

3 MS. HOBAUGH: Oh.

4 AGENT FLETCHER: The mediation is
5 going to occur before June 24.

6 MS. HOBAUGH: I thought you said July
7 11.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Oh, I'm sorry. If I
9 did, I made a mistake.

10 MS. HOBAUGH: Okay.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: I should have said,
12 for the Status Hearing I should have said, June
13 24. If I said July, that was a mistake.

14 MS. HOBAUGH: And what was the next
15 date of mediation?

16 AGENT FLETCHER: The first available
17 date for mediation is Thursday, June 11.

18 MS. HOBAUGH: June 11. Okay.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: At 9:00 or 10:00.

20 MS. JEEYUM KIM: The 10:00 would work
21 okay for us.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: Is that good for you,

1 Ms. Kim?

2 MS. JEEYUM KIM: Yes, that's fine.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: 10:00?

4 MS. HOBAUGH: Yes.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Okay. So then
6 mediation is set for Thursday, June 11 at 10:00.

7 And, Mr. Yang, I'm going to request
8 that you assist us with translation for Ms. Kim
9 throughout the process, just so that you know.

10 INTERPRETER YANG: All right.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: If that's okay with
12 you. Any questions at all?

13 MS. SYLVIA KIM: No, that's fine.

14 MS. JEEYUM KIM: Do we meet here?

15 AGENT FLETCHER: For the mediation?

16 MS. JEEYUM KIM: Yes.

17 AGENT FLETCHER: For the mediation,
18 you will actually check-in with the receptionist.
19 The mediation may be in this room, most likely,
20 but just check-in with the receptionist first, so
21 she can let me know that you are here. And my
22 card is on the table. I have been in

1 communication with you --

2 MS. JEEYUM KIM: Yes.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: -- already.

4 MS. JEEYUM KIM: Thank you.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, Ms. Kim, but if
6 you have any questions, my card is on the table.

7 MS. JEEYUM KIM: I took one already.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. No questions
9 then the Roll Call Hearing is concluded. Thank
10 you for coming.

11 MS. JEEYUM KIM: Thank you very much.

12 MS. SYLVIA KIM: Thank you.

13 MR. KIM: Thank you.
