CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. I would like to welcome you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Today is May 29, 2013.

My name is Ruthanne Miller. I'm the Chairperson. Joining me to my far right is Mr. Donald Brooks, to my immediate right is Mr. Nick Alberti and to my immediate left is Mr. Mike Silverstein. The Board has four Members in attendance for the conduct of business today with three constituting a quorum.

Copies of today's hearing calendar and agenda are available at the receptionist desk. Please be aware that these proceedings are being recorded by a court reporter. Accordingly, we must ask you to refrain from any disruptive noises or actions in the hearing room.
