3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties
4 in the matter of Bin 1301, U Street, please
5 come forward. The parties in the matter of
6 Bin 1301 Wine Bar.

7 This is Case No. 13-PRO-00063, SST
8 Management, LLC, trading as Bin 1301 Wine Bar,
9 1301 U Street, N.W., License No. ABRA-091682.
10 This is a Retainer CT New Application.

11 The protest issues are adverse
12 impact on peace, order and quiet, residential
13 parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety,
14 and overconcentration.

15 My name is La Verne Fletcher.
16 I'll be conducting the Roll Call Hearing as
17 the Board's agent, pursuant to D.C. Official
18 Code 1601.2.

19 Introductions beginning with the
20 applicant, please.

21 MR. JACKSON: Yes. My name is
22 Jeff Jackson. I'm representing Bin 1301.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Jackson, do you
2 have a letter of designation from the
3 Applicant?

4 MR. JACKSON: Yes. It's on file.

5 MS. FLETCHER: I don't have it.

6 MR. JACKSON: Yes, it was
7 submitted.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. I don't -- I
9 don't have that, Mr. Jackson. I'm going to
10 take -- when was it submitted? Do you know?

11 MR. JACKSON: At the time of the
12 application.

13 MS. FLETCHER: And where is the
14 owner today, Mr. Jackson?

15 MR. JACKSON: In Ethiopia.

16 MS. FLETCHER: So, Mr. Jackson,
17 I'm going to ask you to -- I don't use the
18 license application files for protest
19 hearings. We don't use them for that purpose.

20 So, if you could -- I'll accept
21 what you're saying today as you being the
22 representative for the licensee. But, could

1 you submit something in the letter of
2 designation form or some sort for the -- for
3 the protest file.

4 MR. JACKSON: I can.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And do
6 you remember who the licensing specialist was
7 in this case?

8 MR. JACKSON: Yes. I believe it
9 was Roxanne Smith.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And I'll
11 check that, too.

12 MR. JACKSON: Okay.

13 MS. FLETCHER: And I understand
14 that sometimes you submit those with the
15 application.

16 MR. JACKSON: Yes.

17 MS. FLETCHER: But they don't work
18 their way over to the protest process.

19 MR. JACKSON: Okay.

20 MS. FLETCHER: And so we don't
21 always know. But I accept what you're saying
22 to be true, and I'll make a note that that is

1 forthcoming.

2 MR. JACKSON: Okay.

3 MS. FLETCHER: And the other
4 thing, Mr. Jackson, I'm going to give you some
5 dates for a status hearing and a protest
6 hearing and mediation.

7 Do you know when the owner is
8 returning? Well, you know the process. He'll
9 need to be present --

10 MR. JACKSON: He will be returning
11 the end of this month.

12 MS. FLETCHER: The end of this
13 month. Okay. So I'm going to set the -- I'm
14 going to set the mediation in July.

15 MR. JACKSON: Okay.

16 MS. FLETCHER: So, I'm going to
17 give you the dates for the status hearing and
18 the protest hearing first. The date for the
19 status hearing is July 31st at 9:30 a.m. It's
20 July 31st.

21 And the protest date is September
22 25 at 1:30 p.m.

1 Ms. Sterling, introduce yourself,
2 please, for the hearing.

3 MS. STERLING: I'm sorry. Joan
4 Sterling for Shaw DuPont Citizen's Alliance.

5 MS. FLETCHER: And, Ms. Sterling,
6 did the SDCA provide the applicant at least
7 seven days' notice of this meeting?

8 MS. STERLING: Yes, we did.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. May I see
10 your notice, please.

11 Mr. Jackson, do you know if your
12 client received a copy of this notice of this
13 --

14 MR. JACKSON: Yes, they did.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.

16 I have a letter from the Shaw
17 DuPont Citizens Alliance, dated May 17,
18 notifying the applicant of its May 16 meeting.
19 Thank you.

20 The Shaw DuPont Citizens Alliance
21 has standing as a protestant. We've already
22 set the date for the status and protest

1 hearings, so let me give you some dates for
2 mediation.

3 Mr. Jackson, do you have a
4 preference if I look at the first week or the
5 second week in July?

6 MR. JACKSON: Preferably the first
7 week. I'll be out of town from the 14th
8 through the 21st.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. See, we've
10 got a holiday on the 4th. Let's see. We
11 could do it on Tuesday, July 2nd.

12 MR. JACKSON: That's sounds --

13 MS. FLETCHER: Is that good?
14 Nine, ten, eleven or one?

15 MR. JACKSON: Preferably one for
16 me.

17 MS. STERLING: That's fine.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Does that work for
19 you, Ms. Sterling?

20 MS. STERLING: Okay.

21 MS. FLETCHER: So, I've got
22 mediation for ten o'clock on Tuesday, July 2nd.

1 MR. JACKSON: Did you say ten?

2 MS. STERLING: Did you say -- He
3 was saying one.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, you said.
5 Okay.

6 MR. JACKSON: One.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for
8 clarifying that, because I -- I put that down
9 for ten. Thank you. It's one o'clock. One
10 o'clock on July 2nd. Okay. Okay. Thank you.

11 Thank you, Mr. Jackson, for
12 coming.

13 MR. JACKSON: Thank you.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
