This is Case Number 12-PRO-00048, 18th & D Liquors, Inc., trading as Master Liquors, 1806 D Street NE, License Number ABRA-074594. This a Retailer Class A, Renewal Application. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet, residential parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety.
