9 review it.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.

13 MR. SMITH: Sure.

14 AGENT FLETCHER: So the application is
15 dismissed. It depends. It's going to be
16 dismissed. We will wait to see what happens with
17 reinstatement. We will work out the logistics
18 later.

19 MR. SMITH: Thank you.

20 AGENT FLETCHER: And but I have made
21 a note that a settlement agreement is
22 forthcoming.
