4 "discourage." So it will read "discourage
5 loitering." That's all I have for this one.

3 that is not connected to the establishment. 6D
4 requiring participation in the Business
5 Improvement District, deleting that. And 7B,
6 deleting the words "its assigns." That's all I
7 have. Do I have a second.

9 it though. Will you just check it as I read it,
10 make sure that --

11 MEMBER ALBERTI: I don't have it in
12 front of me.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, you don't
14 have that?

15 MEMBER ALBERTI: You want to skip that
16 one and go on to the next one?

18 a settlement agreement between ANC 6C and Union
19 Kitchen dated June 16, 2015. Union Kitchen is
20 located at 538 3rd Street, N.E., License No.

12 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
13 aye?

14 (Chorus of ayes)

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
16 opposed?

1 Okay. Now going back to No. 1, Mr.
2 Alberti, you have that in front of you?

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes, what was the
4 question?

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It's Walter
6 Johnson.

7 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. I
9 move that we modify. I have a No. 13 written
10 down. Do you see a modification for that? Or is
11 that just the one --

12 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes, No. 13. Yes,
13 I'm sorry.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Are they
15 intemperate?

16 MEMBER ALBERTI: So No. 13 should be
17 modified to clarify that they're referring to
18 persons of intemperate habits.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Which is a term
20 of art used in our statute.

21 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

1 MEMBER ALBERTI: It's appears that's
2 what they're referring to and that it should be
3 mae clear that that's what they're referring to.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And next
5 I have No. 15.

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: I think No. 15 is
7 okay. No. 16 is we're going to delete No. 16,
8 which says that they can't sell to strawman
9 buyers. And we're allowing that.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Number what?

11 MEMBER ALBERTI: Straw buyers.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I thought we
13 weren't allowing straw buyers.

14 MEMBER ALBERTI: No, we're not. They
15 can say they're not going to sell to a person who
16 they know -- they can refuse sale to someone who
17 they believe to be a strawman buyer.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right, but didn't
19 that -- and maybe I should get my computer.
20 Didn't that provision prohibit that, so therefore
21 we were saying we should take it out?

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: No, the next one was

1 -- No. 16 says they're going to refuse service to

2 --

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right.

4 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- in the future sell
5 some -- refuse service to strawman buyers. No.
6 15 says you're going to refuse service when you
7 know that they're buying it for someone else.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh. Okay. So
9 you're saying -- well, you don't want to -- you
10 probably want to look at this, too. You want to
11 pull up a chair?

12 MEMBER ALBERTI: No, I know. I
13 remember reading it.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

15 MEMBER ALBERTI: I can see it from
16 here actually. We've allowed 15 --

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We've
18 allowed it.

19 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- in the past.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: So if they have
21 sold it before to a strawman, we're saying
22 they --

1 MEMBER ALBERTI: So, it --

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: If we allow it,
3 then we take 15 out.

4 MEMBER ALBERTI: No, what we're
5 saying, we've allowed 15 to be in there.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: To prohibit it?

7 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right. We've allowed
8 that prohibition which says that if I know you're
9 buying alcohol --

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: For someone under
11 21.

12 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- for someone else
13 who --

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes.

15 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- who shouldn't
16 buying it --

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right.

18 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- I'm not going to
19 sell it to you. And that's okay.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

21 MEMBER ALBERTI: No. 16 says, oh,
22 yesterday you were buying it for somebody else,

1 but today you're buying it for yourself. I have
2 to sell it to you.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, I see.

4 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Take reasonable
5 steps.

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: That's not part of
7 this.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: That's loitering
9 and stuff. Okay. Right.

10 MEMBER ALBERTI: So we're taking No.
11 16 out.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. So
13 it's 16. All right.

14 MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay?

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I get
16 that. Then there's 19. What is that?

17 MEMBER ALBERTI: And 17, sale of
18 business. Seventeen is notification of sale of
19 business.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right. We're
21 deleting that 17.

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right. Seventeen

1 we're deleting.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Seventeen,
3 delete.

4 MEMBER ALBERTI: No. 19, I forget what
5 19 is.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: No. 19 we're
7 deleting "assign."

8 MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay. We're taking
9 out the word "assigns" on 19.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right. And then
11 20.

12 MEMBER ALBERTI: No. 20 is they can't
13 stipulate the penalty, which is --

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Which is the last
15 line. "Any violation shall be deemed" --

16 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes. Right. Any
17 violation.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: -- "a per se
19 violation of the" -- okay. So the second -- I
20 mean, the last line should be deleted in
21 paragraph 20.

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right. Right. And

1 it's cause for making a point to ABRA.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: All right. We're
4 good.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: So our attorneys
6 will work with the parties on the exact language.

7 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right. So we did 9,
8 16, 17, 19 and 20, is that correct? Or 13. I'm
9 sorry.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I have 13, 15 --

11 MEMBER ALBERTI: No, not 15.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Sixteen. Sorry.
13 Thirteen, sixteen --

14 MEMBER ALBERTI: Seventeen, nineteen
15 and twenty.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes.

17 MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. I
19 move to modify as so indicated.

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Alberti
22 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say

1 aye?

2 (Chorus of ayes)

8 Risa Harao on behalf of Stanton Liquors. No
9 written response was filed by the protestant
10 group of nine. Stanton Liquors is located at
11 1044 Bladensburg Road, N.E., License No. 071601.
12 We heard arguments on the motion this morning and
13 ruled on it and we denied the motion to dismiss.
14 So I don't think any action is required at this
15 point. It's going to be set forth in Board Order
16 2015-320.

17 Okay. So that completes our agenda
18 and all that's left is our votes on the closed
19 meetings for our next session, which will be July
20 8th.

21 As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
22 Beverage Control Board for the District of

1 Columbia and in accordance with Section 405 of
2 the Open Meetings Amendment Act of 2010, I move
3 that the ABC Board hold a closed meeting on July
4 8th, 2015 for the purpose of seeking legal advice
5 from our counsel on the matters identified on the
