3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The next case
4 is another Protest (Status) Hearing case, Case
5 No. 14-PRO-00039, UMaya located at 733 10th
6 Street, N.W., License No. 94099, in ANC-2C.

7 When you are ready, you can
8 introduce yourselves for the record.

9 MR. MATTHEWS: Good morning,
10 Jermaine Matthews on behalf of UMaya.

11 MR. HURWITZ: Ely Hurwitz,
12 attorney for UMaya Restaurant.

13 MR. WILSEY: Kevin Wilsey on
14 behalf of ANC-2C.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

16 MR. TINPE: John Tinpe, ANC-2C.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Great. All
18 right. So all the parties are here. Anything
19 you all wish to tell the Board or any issues
20 you have? Otherwise --

21 MR. WILSEY: We just -- I just
22 last night received a draft of a settlement

1 agreement from Mr. Hurwitz. We haven't had an
2 opportunity to discuss it, but we are making
3 some progress to try to work that out.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Great. Okay.

5 MR. WILSEY: We are getting there.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good.

7 All right. I'm going to tell you the same
8 things I told the parties before, in the event
9 that you go to hearing, that the
10 appropriateness of the establishment is what
11 is at issue in these hearings.

12 You will be receiving a Protest
13 Information Form in the mail a few weeks
14 before the hearing. You will need to fill
15 that out and serve it on all the parties and
16 on the Board seven days before the hearing.

17 If you don't do that, your protest
18 or your application is subject to dismissal,
19 so, please, do that.

20 And you will also get an Exhibit
21 Form and you need to submit that within seven
22 days and attach your exhibits to that as well

1 and serve that.

2 In the Protest Information Form be
3 sure to identify your witnesses by full name
4 and identify what they will be testifying to
5 and you will also be asked to identify
6 succinctly your issues or remaining issues.

7 Some times parties work out some of the issues
8 and there are just some remaining and so we
9 all need to know that, so we need to know the
10 focus of the hearing. So this makes the
11 hearing go much more smoothly.

12 If you don't file your Exhibit
13 Form in time, then your exhibits could be
14 subject to exclusion as well if you could have
15 filed them earlier or if there is prejudice to
16 the party that didn't get them.
