CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The next case is another Protest Hearing (Status) case, 15-PRO-00042, Jumbo Liquors located at 1122 H Street, N.E., License No. 420, in ANC-6A. It's a renewal.

When you are ready, if you could introduce yourself for the record?

MR. LEE: Good morning, Board Members. My name is Kevin Lee representing Jumbo Liquors, Inc. t/a Jumbo Liquors. Next to me is the owner of Jumbo Liquors.

MS. CHU: Yes, Sum Ho Chu, Jumbo Liquors owners.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good morning.

MR. WILLIAMS: Good morning. My name is Jay Williams. I'm the co-chair of the ANC-6A Alcoholic Beverage Licensing Committee and I'm here on behalf of ANC-6A.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And is

1 there anything either party wishes to report to
2 the Board?

3 MR. WILLIAMS: We are in active
4 settlement agreement negotiations. I am
5 guardedly optimistic that we will reach an
6 agreement. Part of it is I need to talk to some
7 of the commissioners and make sure that everybody
8 is comfortable with where we are, but I'm pretty
9 optimistic that we are headed in that direction.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Great.
11 Yes?

12 MR. LEE: Yes.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

14 MR. LEE: We already talked about
15 already before we start the hearing.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good. All
17 right. Well, then your Protest Hearing is
18 scheduled for September 9, 2015 at 4:30 p.m., if
19 you end up going to hearing. And I just want to
20 highlight for you the importance of the Protest
21 Information Form and the Exhibit Form that you
22 should receive well over a week before, because

1 it's due seven days ahead of the hearing to the
2 other side and the Board.

3 In the Protest Information Form, you
4 will need to identify your issues and your
5 witnesses. Your issues as hopefully they will
6 have become narrowed by that time and your
7 witnesses by name, not just by, you know, what
8 type of person or whatever witness.

9 And an Exhibit Form listing your
10 exhibits, but also attaching your exhibits. And
11 if they are not, if these exhibits and forms,
12 shared within seven days, you could risk their
13 exclusion at the hearing, because the point is
14 for the hearing to be focused and for everybody
15 to be on notice and fairly have an opportunity to
16 address the witnesses and the exhibits.

17 MR. LEE: Okay.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: If you don't get
19 something in the mail, if you do go forward,
20 contact Janae Raines. I have the number, 442-
21 4353.
