CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We're back on the record to do the Board's agenda for August 7, 2013.

First item on the agenda is a settlement agreement dated July 22nd, 2013 between Sticky Rice and Bobby Pittman of the Linden Neighborhood Association. Sticky Rice is located at 1224 H Street, N.E., License No. 072783.

I move that we approve this settlement agreement but with some modifications, that being to paragraphs 4, 5, 9 and 10. Do I have a second?

MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any comments by Board Members?

(No audible response.)

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All those in favor, say aye?

(Chorus of ayes.)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
2 opposed?

3 (No audible response.)

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
5 abstaining?

6 (No audible response.)

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
8 3-0-0.

9 Okay. I just want to say that our
10 attorney will be in touch with the parties and
11 explain the modifications.

12 Okay. No. 2 is a settlement
13 agreement dated June 17th, 2013 between
14 Brooklyn's Finest and a Group of Residents.
15 That is Brooklyn's Finest located at 3126-3128
16 12th Street, N.E., License No. 092010.

17 I would move approval of this
18 settlement agreement with a modification to
19 paragraph 9. And paragraph 4 should be deleted.

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: I believe we --

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: In my view
22 that's because that one discriminates against

1 college students. What?

2 MEMBER ALBERTI: I believe we
3 discussed modifying No. 11, too, paragraph 4.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes, paragraph
5 11, correct, the language could be improved
6 there and our attorney will assist them with
7 that. So then it would be motion to modify the
8 settlement agreement to paragraphs 9 and 11 and
9 to delete No. 4. Do I have a second?

10 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Alberti as
12 seconded the motion. Any other comments?

13 (No audible response.)

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Then all
15 those in favor, say aye?

16 (Chorus of ayes.)

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 opposed?

19 (No audible response.)

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
21 abstaining?

22 (No audible response.)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Then the motion
2 passes 4-0-0.

3 Okay. No. 3 is a motion to dismiss
4 a notice to show cause dated July 22nd, 2013
5 from Matthew LaFande, counsel for Little Miss
6 Whiskey. Little Miss Whiskey is located at 1104
7 H Street, N.W., License No. 079090. And there
8 are other pleadings associated with this at No.
9 2 on our supplemental agenda. So we have a
10 motion to dismiss, an opposition from the
11 Government and then a reply. Motion to dismiss
12 is for lack of jurisdiction because the
13 investigative report was not filed within 90
14 days of the alleged occurrence.

15 I would move that we deny the motion
16 to dismiss on grounds that case law supports
17 that this type of directive to serve the report
18 within 90 days is directory and not mandatory.

19 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.
21 Brooks has seconded the motion. Any other
22 comments?

1 (No audible response.)

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Motion's
3 been seconded. All those in favor of the motion
4 to deny the motion to dismiss, say aye?

5 (Chorus of ayes.)

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
7 opposed?

8 (No audible response.)

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
10 abstaining?

11 (No audible response.)

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
13 4-0-0.

14 Okay. No. 4 is a settlement
15 agreement dated April 10, 2013 between Circa and
16 ANC 2B. Circa is located at 1601 Connecticut
17 Avenue, N.W., License No. 76074.

18 I move that we approve this
19 application with modification to paragraph 5.
20 Do I have a second?

21 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.

1 Brooks has seconded the motion. All those in
2 favor, say aye?

3 (Chorus of ayes.)

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
5 opposed?

6 (No audible response.)

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
8 abstaining?

9 (No audible response.)

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
11 4-0-0. And our attorney will explain that
12 modification.

13 No. 6 is a request dated July 26,
14 2013 from Premium Distributors of Washington,
15 D.C. for approval to provide retailers with
16 products valued at more than \$50 and less than
17 500.

18 I move that we approve.

19 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, this is No.
21 6. I skipped No. 5. But okay. This is No. 6.

22 Okay. Mr. Brooks has seconded the

1 motion. All those in favor, say aye?

2 (Chorus of ayes.)

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
4 opposed?

5 (No audible response.)

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
7 abstaining?

8 (No audible response.)

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
10 4-0-0.

11 Let's go back to No. 5, which is a
12 request to change hours of operation and alcohol
13 sales for inside premise and summer garden.
14 This is for Righteous Cheese located at 1309 5th
15 Street, N.E., License No. 089981.

16 I move that we placard the
17 application to change the hours for the summer
18 garden and approve the hours for the interior.

19 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
21 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
22 aye?

1 (Chorus of ayes.)

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 opposed?

4 (No audible response.)

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
6 abstaining?

7 (No audible response.)

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. The
9 motion passes 4-0-0.

10 Okay. That completes our agenda.
11 We also have a supplemental agenda.

12 No. 1 on the supplemental agenda is
13 a review of revised floor diagram dated August
14 6th, 2013 from Each Peach Market. Each Peach
15 Market is located at 3068 Mount Pleasant Street,
16 N.W., License No. 92449.

17 I move that we postpone this vote on
18 this floor diagram until next week.

19 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
21 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
22 aye?

1 (Chorus of ayes.)

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 opposed?

4 (No audible response.)

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
6 abstaining?

7 (No audible response.)

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The motion
9 passes 4-0-0.

10 Okay. No. 2 we have already done.
11 No. 2 says it's a reply in support of motion to
12 dismiss related to the Little Miss Whiskey
13 motion and we have already ruled on that with
14 respect to No. 3 on our agenda. So there's no
15 further action here.

16 MEMBER ALBERTI: That's No. 2 on our
17 agenda. Oh, no, no. No, no. Excuse me.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

19 MEMBER ALBERTI: Strike that.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: No. 3.

21 MEMBER ALBERTI: I'm sorry. I
22 thought you were referring to this number.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

2 MEMBER ALBERTI: Go ahead.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: No. 3 is a
4 request for a stipulated license dated July 5th,
5 2013, and there is a letter of support from ANC
6 2E. The Licensee is Kintaro located at 1039
7 33rd Street, N.W., License No. 083214.

8 I move that we approve this request.

9 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
11 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
12 aye?

13 (Chorus of ayes.)

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
15 opposed?

16 (No audible response.)

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 abstaining?

19 (No audible response.)

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
21 4-0-0.

22 No. 4 is a request for safekeeping

1 in light of the business being sold. That is Le
2 Deux Garcons located at 3712-3714 Macomb Street,
3 License No. 086355.

4 I move that we approve this
5 application. Do I have a second?

6 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
8 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
9 aye?

10 (Chorus of ayes.)

11 MEMBER ALBERTI: How many months is
12 the application for?

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Let's check it.
14 This involves a restaurant that's closed.

15 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And that's why
17 it's going into safekeeping.

18 MEMBER ALBERTI: Well, I would like
19 to offer a friendly amendment that we approve
20 this for six months.

21 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I can't

1 remember where we were before. Is this a
2 substitution amendment?

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: It's just a
4 friendly amendment.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Friendly
6 amendment.

7 MEMBER ALBERTI: If you'll accept
8 it, then we can move forward.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: A friendly
10 amendment. Yes, okay. So the friendly
11 amendment is that we approve it for safekeeping,
12 and that would be for six months. And Mr.
13 Brooks has seconded the motion, I believe.

14 MEMBER BROOKS: Yes.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those in
16 favor, say aye?

17 (Chorus of ayes.)

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 opposed?

20 (No audible response.)

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
22 abstaining?

1 (No audible response.)

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
3 4-0-0.

4 Okay. No. 5 is a request for
5 reconsideration and fact finding with respect to
6 a license which was involuntarily transferred by
7 the Board to the landlord. License is currently
8 in safekeeping. The establishment is Fino
9 located at 3011 M Street, N.W., License No.
10 060545. My understanding is that this license
11 is at issue before the courts and until there's
12 a court order no action should be taken by the
13 Board.

14 So I would move that we deny this
15 request for reconsideration and fact finding.
16 Do I have a second?

17 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
19 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
20 aye?

21 (Chorus of ayes.)

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

1 opposed?

2 (No audible response.)

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

4 abstaining?

5 (No audible response.)

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes

7 4-0-0.

8 And that concludes our supplemental

4 planned investigations of alleged criminal or

9 Register on August 9, 2013. Is there a second?

10 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

10 today, August 7, 2013, and the Board is
11 adjourned. Thank you.
