CHAIR MILLER: Okay. We are on the record for the Board licensing agenda to begin with and then our legal agenda. First item on the licensing agenda is an application for safekeeping of license.

This is for Fresh and Green, located at 4330 48th Street, NW, License Number 087502. I move that we approve this application for safekeeping for six months. Do I have a second?

MR. SHORT: Second.

CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Short seconded the motion. All those in favor say aye.

(Chorus of ayes)

CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed, all those abstaining? Motion passes, 6-0-0.

Number 2 is an application for substantial change to increase the seating capacity from 222 seats to 420 seats and an entertainment endorsement including dancing.

1 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed,
2 all those abstaining? Motion passes, 7-0-0.

3 Number 4 is a corporate name
4 change application for Nomad Hookah Bar,
5 located at 1200 H Street, NE, License Number
6 087558. I move that we deny this application.
7 Do I have a second?

8 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

9 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Silverstein has
10 seconded the motion. All those in favor say
11 aye.

12 (Chorus of ayes)

13 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed,
14 all those abstaining? Motion passes, 7-0-0.

15 Now we have a supplemental
16 licensing agenda. First item on the
17 supplemental licensing agenda is a request to
18 restore a license cancelled for non-payment of
19 fees in which the writer of the letter says
20 that he would pay all the applicable fees.

21 It's for Legends Restaurant and
22 Carry Out, located at 2157 P Street, NW,

1 License Number 073982. So I would move that
2 we refer this to Licensing for further
3 investigation of this matter. Do I have a
4 second?

5 MR. SHORT: Second.

6 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Short has
7 seconded the motion. All those in favor --

8 MR. ALBERTI: I would like to
9 speak to this.

10 CHAIR MILLER: Yes, I'm sorry.
11 Discussion?

12 MR. ALBERTI: Okay. I'm going to
13 vote to deny the motion. I think that this
14 license should be cancelled or it should
15 stand. Because in more than two years, not
16 only did this licensee not pay their fee for
17 more than two years, they didn't request an
18 extension of safekeeping as required.

19 So for two years, we hear nothing
20 from these folks. So I have to assume that --
21 and the license was cancelled in 2011 or 2012,
22 I believe. When was their license cancelled,

1 2012? So the license was cancelled in 2012.

2 And for two years we hear nothing from them.

3 And now they come to us and say,
4 whoops, we want to reinstate that license. So
5 I think that they need to apply for a new
6 license.

7 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Point well
8 taken.

9 MALE PARTICIPANT: We had a
10 motion.

11 MR. ALBERTI: Madam, we have a
12 motion on the floor. So we have to vote on
13 the motion.

14 CHAIR MILLER: People can vote
15 down the motion if they agree with Mr.
16 Alberti. So the motion is to refer it to
17 Licensing to check on the status of this case.
18 He allegedly was --

19 (Off the record comments)

20 CHAIR MILLER: Oh, my goodness.
21 No. Okay. Do I need to repeat anything?

22 (Off the record comments)

1 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. There's a
2 motion that I made that was seconded by Mr.
3 Silverstein, I think, to refer to licensing.
4 Because in the letter the person says that he
5 never was billed.

6 And I was saying, if you don't
7 agree with this motion and you agree with Mr.
8 Alberti, you're welcome to vote down the
9 motion so Mr. Alberti can support his motion.

10 So, okay, so the motion that's on
11 the table right now is to refer to Licensing,
12 and it's been seconded. All those in favor
13 say aye.

14 (Chorus of ayes)

15 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed.

16 (Chorus of opposed)

17 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Then the
18 motion fails by a vote of 3-4-0. Opposing the
19 motion is Short, Rodriguez, Alberti and
20 Brooks. Okay, so Mr. Alberti, do you have a
21 motion?

22 MR. ALBERTI: I move that we would

1 deny this request to restore the license.

2 CHAIR MILLER: Okay.

3 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: I second the
4 motion.

5 CHAIR MILLER: All right. The
6 motion, are there any other comments? Okay.
7 All those in favor then of denying the request
8 to restore the license say aye.

9 (Chorus of ayes)

10 CHAIR MILLER: Opposed,
11 abstaining?

12 MEMBER JONES: I abstain.

13 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Then that
14 motion passes 6-1-0, okay, with Mr. Jones
15 dissenting. Okay.

16 MR. ALBERTI: No.

17 MEMBER JONES: No, I'm abstaining.

18 CHAIR MILLER: Oh, abstaining.

19 MR. ALBERTI: So 6-0-1.

20 CHAIR MILLER: Yes, okay. 6-0-1,
21 okay.

22 Number 2 is a request to expand

1 the second floor increasing seating from 61 to
2 144. This is Cedar Hill Bar and Grill,
3 located at 2200 Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue,
4 091887. Substantial change may already have
5 been completed without approval. I move that
6 we placard this request. Do I have a second?

7 MR. SHORT: Second.

8 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Short has
9 seconded the motion. All those in favor say
10 aye.

11 (Chorus of ayes)

12 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
13 All those abstaining? Motion passes, 7-0-0.

14 Number 3 is a letter from Paul
15 Pascal providing for application of request
16 for expansion of summer garden seating. This
17 is for Bidwell, located at 1309 5th Street,
18 NE, License Number 092990. I move that, oh,
19 I move that we, yes, that we placard this
20 application. Do I have a second?

21 MR. ALBERTI: Second.

22 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Alberti has

1 seconded the motion. All those in favor say
2 aye?

3 (Chorus of ayes)

4 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed,
5 all those abstaining? Motion passes, 7-0-0.
6 Okay. That completes our licensing agendas.

7 We can now turn to our legal
8 agenda. Okay, starting on the legal agenda is
9 a review of a settlement agreement dated July
10 29, 2014, between ANC 4B and the VIP Room.
11 This is for the VIP Room, located at 6201 3rd
12 Street, NW, License Number 94561.

13 I move that we postpone
14 consideration of the settlement agreement
15 until after we make the qualifications
16 determination.

17 MR. SHORT: Second.

18 CHAIR MILLER: All right. Mr.
19 Short has seconded the motion. All those in
20 favor say aye.

21 (Chorus of ayes)

22 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?

1 All those abstaining? Motion passes 7-0-0.

2 Number 2 is a review of an
3 amendment to a settlement agreement dated July
4 29, 2014, between ANC 4B and Takoma Station
5 Tavern. Takoma Station Tavern is located at
6 6914 4th Street, NW, License Number 94842.

7 I move that we approve with
8 modifications. The first being to their
9 Paragraph Number 3 in which there's a repeat
10 of certain things with different hours. It'll
11 be obvious, I think, when we see it. And they
12 can also confer with Ms. Jenkins.

13 Second is 5D in which we suggest
14 that telephone number for managers be replaced
15 with contact numbers for the establishment.

16 And for Paragraph 5C, that a
17 reference be added to it that the cameras will
18 be utilized in accordance with Section 25-403G
19 of Title 25 in which it sets forth that the
20 cameras utilized by the establishment need to
21 be operational, that any footage of a crime of
22 violence or a crime involving a gun is

1 maintained for a minimum of 30 days.

2 And the security footage is made
3 available within 48 hours upon the request of
4 ABRA or the Metropolitan Police Department.
5 So that should be added.

6 Okay. So with those
7 modifications, I move that we approve the
8 amendment to the settlement agreement. Do I
9 have a second?

10 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

11 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez has
12 seconded the motion. All those in favor say
13 aye.

14 (Chorus of ayes)

15 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
16 All those abstaining? Motion passes, 7-0-0.

17 Okay. Number 3, 4 and 5 are all
18 related to Number 3 which is a petition for
19 reconsideration from Roderic Woodson on behalf
20 of Holland and Knight, LLP, dated July 28th,
21 2014, related to our decision in DC Eagle in
22 which we did not extend the protest period

1 that they had asked for on grounds that they
2 didn't have notice of the application.

3 I would move that we grant the
4 motion for reconsideration on grounds that I
5 think that Mr. Woodson made good arguments
6 that the evidence showed in our hearing that
7 the placard was not placed conspicuously and
8 that it was very difficult to notice. And
9 conspicuous means that it's easy to notice.

10 And I think that the intent of the
11 statute is for an abutting property to have
12 notice. And I also think that if there is any
13 injustice it would be to them, the abutting
14 property owner, and that the statute doesn't,
15 that the courts have ruled in favor of a
16 hearing on the matter as opposed to a
17 dismissal on a technicality.

18 And I understand the other side of
19 this is that the other side couldn't probably
20 find a more conspicuous place. But I don't
21 think that the abutting property should have
22 to suffer with that. So that's my motion. Do

1 I have a second?

2 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

3 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Mr.

4 Silverstein has seconded the motion. Anybody
5 else wish to speak to it?

6 MR. ALBERTI: Yes, Madam Chair. I
7 will deny this motion solely on the fact that
8 the motion for reconsideration offers no new
9 arguments, no new information, no new
10 arguments. He is simply asking us to reverse
11 ourselves. I made my decision, and I see no
12 reason to rethink my decision based on the
13 lack of new information and new arguments.

14 CHAIR MILLER: Yes?

15 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I seconded
16 the motion so that it could be discussed. I'm
17 share my opinion with Mr. Alberti. This is
18 simply old wine in old bottles. It's time for
19 us all to move on.

20 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Any others?

21 I just want to speak to that, because I
22 thought about that myself in deciding to grant

1 this. And I basically said that we erred in
2 finding, I don't know, in not dealing with the
3 conspicuous issue at least.

4 And I thought that was new. I
5 thought it was a new argument, because we
6 hadn't erred until, we couldn't have erred
7 until we came to that conclusion.

8 So anyway, all right. I don't
9 think we did articulate conspicuous very well
10 in that decision. So, okay. There's a motion
11 that's been seconded. All those in favor say
12 aye.

13 (Chorus of ayes)

14 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?

15 (Chorus of opposed)

16 CHAIR MILLER: I made a mistake.

17 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Madam Chair,
18 I --

19 CHAIR MILLER: Okay.

20 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Because I'm
21 opposed.

22

1 CHAIR MILLER: All those
2 abstaining?

3 MR. SHORT: Abstain.

4 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. You're
5 abstaining. So I believe the vote is 5-1-1.
6 No.

7 (Simultaneous speaking)

8 MR. ALBERTI: One to five.

9 CHAIR MILLER: One to five to one.
10 I know, okay. I wasn't trying to trick you.
11 All right.

12 (Off the record comments)

13 CHAIR MILLER: And then Short is
14 abstaining. All right. Okay, so --

15 MR. ALBERTI: I move that we deny
16 this motion.

17 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Is there a
18 second?

19 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

20 CHAIR MILLER: All right. Mr.
21 Brooks has seconded the motion. All those in
22 favor of denying the petition for

1 reconsideration say aye.

2 (Chorus of ayes)

3 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?

4 All those abstaining?

5 MR. SHORT: Abstain.

6 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. So the vote

7 on that one is 5-1-1. Miller dissents and

8 Short abstains. Okay.

9 That brings us to Number 6, review
10 of Anis Amri's and Ahmed Bizri's motion for
11 reconsideration of Board's order to place ABC
12 license in safekeeping from Paul Pascal, Esq.
13 on behalf of Pascal and Weiss, P.C., dated
14 August 4, 2014.

15 Nomad Hookah Bar is located at
16 1200 H Street, NE, License Number 087558. I
17 move that we deny the motion. Do I have a
18 second?

19 MR. ALBERTI: Second.

20 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Mr. Alberti
21 has seconded the motion. All those in favor
22 of denying say aye.

1 (Chorus of ayes)

2 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
3 All those abstaining? Motion passes, 7-0-0.

4 Number 7 is an objection to notice
5 of intent to nullify and void settlement
6 agreement and stay of enforcement of
7 settlement agreement for Cheerz, submitted by
8 Alpha McPherson, president of GEEDDS, dated
9 August 4th, 2014.

10 Cheerz is located at 7303 Georgia
11 Avenue, NW, License Number 095178. And this
12 appears to be an FYI and no action is
13 required.

14 Actually, I would suggest that
15 that is true of Number 8 and 9. Number 8 is
16 a review of letter in support of objection to
17 Board, 2014-279, from Gina Masterson related
18 to Cheerz. And 9 is a letter in support of
19 objection to Board Order 2014-279 from Sara
20 Green, ANC 4B01. Okay. So those are FYIs.

21 And then we have a review of
22 technical amendment rule making. And I move

1 that we postpone consideration of this rule
2 making until September 10th after recess. Do
3 I have a second?

4 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

5 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez has
6 seconded the motion. All those in favor say
7 aye.

8 (Chorus of ayes)

9 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
10 All those abstaining? Motion passes, 7-0-0.

11 Okay. We now have, finally, a
12 supplemental legal agenda. First is a letter
13 dated July 25th, 2014, from Michael Fonseca,
14 Counsel for Drizly, Inc. I move that we
15 approve the request. Do I have a second?
16 This is Drizly, Drizly?

17 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I second,
18 yes.

19 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. All those in
20 favor say aye.

21 (Chorus of ayes)

22 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?

1 All those abstaining? Motion passes 7-0-0.

2 Number 2 and 3, they are the
3 motion to dismiss and an opposition to a
4 motion to dismiss the motion in the VIP Room
5 case, located at 6201 3rd Street, submitted by
6 Richard Bianco, with the motion to dismiss.

7 And the group of five or more have
8 submitted an opposition in Number 3. I move
9 that we also postpone this motion to dismiss
10 until after we determine the qualifications
11 issue. Do I have a second?

12 MR. SHORT: Second.

13 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Short seconded
14 the motion. All those in favor say aye.

15 MR. ALBERTI: So this is --

16 CHAIR MILLER: I'm sorry?

17 MR. ALBERTI: -- the motion for
18 Number 2?

19 CHAIR MILLER: Yes. The motion to
20 dismiss in the VIP Room case. It's a motion
21 to dismiss and an opposition. And what we
22 decided at the hearing was in regards to --

1 MR. ALBERTI: No, I meant, so
2 Number 2, the motion is to deny the --

3 CHAIR MILLER: No, to postpone.
4 We're just going to postpone consideration
5 until we decide on the qualifications issue.

6 MR. ALBERTI: I know, right, okay.
7 I got you.

8 CHAIR MILLER: Okay? All right.

9 MR. ALBERTI: Thank you.

10 CHAIR MILLER: Yes. Okay, all
11 those in favor then say aye.

12 (Chorus of ayes)

13 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
14 Abstaining? Motions passes 7-0-0.

15 Number 4 is an amendment to a
16 settlement agreement dated August 1st, 2014,
17 between American City Diner and ANC3 4G.
18 American City Diner is located at 5532
19 Connecticut Avenue, NW, License Number 094922.
20 I move that we approve the settlement
21 agreement. Do I have a second?

22 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

1 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Silverstein
2 seconded the motion. All those in favor say
3 aye.

4 (Chorus of ayes)

5 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
6 All those abstaining?

7 MEMBER JONES: Abstain.

8 CHAIR MILLER: Motion passes, 7-0-
9 1 with Mr. Jones abstaining.

10 MEMBER JONES: Correction, 6-0-1.

11 CHAIR MILLER: Oh, you're correct.
12 Thank you, 6-0-1, with Mr. Jones abstaining.

13 MR. ALBERTI: Mr. Jones, you
14 count, even though you might not want to be.

15 (Laughter)

16 CHAIR MILLER: All right. Review
17 of settlement agreement, dated July 19th,
18 2014, between Chikiting Restaurant and ANC 1A.
19 Chikiting Restaurant is located at 3226 11th
20 Street, NW, License Number 0954459. I move
21 that we approve the settlement agreement. Do
22 I have a second?

1 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Would you
2 approve with modifications?

3 MR. ALBERTI: Oh, there're
4 modifications there, right?

5 CHAIR MILLER: Do you have a
6 modification to this?

7 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Are there
8 modifications in it?

9 CHAIR MILLER: I don't have, I
10 don't. Do you have modifications?

11 MR. ALBERTI: I --

12 CHAIR MILLER: We can look at it.

13 MR. ALBERTI: I just want to take
14 a look. Just one second.

15 (Off the record comments)

16 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. We're going
17 to come back to Number 5. Number 6 is a
18 memorandum of ANC 2A in opposition to
19 Applicant's petition to stay Order 2014-287.

20 And it's related to Shadow Room,
21 located at 2131 K Street, NW, License Number
22 075871. You may recall that the Applicant

1 filed a petition to stay our order, based on
2 the fact that they're appealing our order to
3 put in an appeal.

4 And on August 6th, we voted to
5 grant that petition. However, since that time
6 now, we haven't issued a written order. And
7 just this time we have this opposition.

8 So I would recommend that we take
9 a vote today, having considered the opposition
10 that have been, that we vote again, in light
11 of that opposition, whether we will wish to
12 grant the petition for the stay. And I would
13 move that we do, again, grant the petition for
14 the stay.

15 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Seconded.

16 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Mr.
17 Rodriguez has seconded it. All those in favor
18 say aye.

19 (Chorus of ayes)

20 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
21 All those abstaining?

22 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I abstain.

1 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Mr. Alberti
2 are you voting?

3 MR. ALBERTI: So this is Shadow
4 Room?

5 CHAIR MILLER: Yes.

6 MR. ALBERTI: And the motion
7 again?

8 CHAIR MILLER: The motion, I said
9 that we had already granted the motion, the
10 petition to stay last week.

11 MR. ALBERTI: Right.

12 CHAIR MILLER: However, we hadn't
13 issued a written order. And so therefore we
14 could consider the opposition to the stay
15 which we have read, you know, and vote again
16 in considering the opposition that's been
17 filed, if we can do that.

18 And so then, the motion that I
19 made was, having considered that opposition,
20 I would move again though to grant the stay.
21 And that was seconded.

22 MR. ALBERTI: Okay. And so I will

1 approve, I vote to approve that motion.

2 CHAIR MILLER: So let's do it
3 again, because I don't remember. All those in
4 favor say aye.

5 (Chorus of ayes)

6 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
7 All those abstaining? All right, then --

8 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Abstain.

9 CHAIR MILLER: That's right. So
10 the motion passes, 6-0-1, with Silverstein
11 abstaining. All right.

12 That brings us to Number 8 which
13 is a Sur-Reply to DC Eagle's petition for
14 reconsideration from Paul Pascal related to
15 the DC Eagle case. We already voted on it.
16 Although this doesn't provide for Sur-Reply,
17 so I would suggest that we could strike this,
18 providing pleadings on the issue based on the
19 pleadings that our rules didn't provide for.
20 it.

21 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Okay.

22 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. Number 9,

1 review of resume and architect license of the
2 Applicant's expert witness, submitted by Risa
3 Hirao, Esq. on behalf of Pascal and Weiss
4 related to Saloon 45, 1821 18th Street, NW,
5 License Number 094842.

6 This is just an FYI for our
7 agenda. But with respect to Saloon 45, the
8 hearing that we had last week we left open the
9 record for them to file the resume of their
10 expert witness. And so this is it. So this
11 is just an FYI.

12 Number 10 is a motion for
13 reconsideration submitted by Gina Mondesir on
14 behalf of Mondesir Law Offices related to
15 Bistro 18, located at 2420 18th Street, NW,
16 License Number 86876.

17 I move that we postpone
18 consideration of this motion until September
19 10 when we return from recess so that the
20 Government has an opportunity to file those.
21 Do I have a second?

22 MR. ALBERTI: Second.

1 CHAIR MILLER: Who was that?

2 MR. ALBERTI: Second.

3 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Alberti. All
4 those in favor say aye.

5 (Chorus of ayes)

6 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?
7 All those abstaining? Motion passes, 7-0-0.
8 Okay.

9 MR. ALBERTI: So Mike was right on
10 Number 5? It's modifications to Number 7
11 having to do with the, you know, reporting
12 violations, they can't request show cause,
13 they can only request --

14 CHAIR MILLER: Oh, show cause --

15 MR. ALBERTI: -- an investigation. So
16 it was that show cause language on Number 7.

17

18 CHAIR MILLER: Okay. So we're
19 going back to Number 5 which was a settlement
20 agreement between Chikiting Restaurant and ANC
21 1A. So I'm going to move to approve with
22 modifications to --

1 MR. ALBERTI: Item 7.

2 CHAIR MILLER: Oh, Number 7?

3 MR. ALBERTI: Item 7, yes.

4 CHAIR MILLER: Item 7, okay. Item
5 7, great. Okay. All those in favor say aye?

6 (Chorus of ayes)

7 CHAIR MILLER: All those opposed?

8 All those abstaining? Motion passes 7-0-0.

9 Okay. So that completes our agenda. And I'll
10 request to vote on closed meeting for when we
11 return September 10th.

12 As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
13 Beverage Control Board for the District of
14 Columbia and in accordance with Section 405 of
15 the Open Meetings Amendment Act of 2010, I
16 move that the ABC Board hold a closed meeting
17 on September 10, 2014, for the purpose of
18 seeking legal guidance from our Counsel on the
19 matters identified on the Board's agenda for
20 September 10th, 2014, as published in the D.C.
21 Register on September 5th, 2014. Is there a
22 second.

1 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

2 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
3 seconded the motion. I'll now take a roll
4 call vote for the motion before us, now that
5 it's been seconded. Mr. Brooks?

6 MEMBER BROOKS: I agree.

7 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Alberti?

8 MR. ALBERTI: I agree.

9 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez?

10 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: I agree.

11 CHAIR MILLER: Miller agrees. Mr.
12 Silverstein?

13 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I agree.

14 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Short?

15 MR. SHORT: I agree.

16 CHAIR MILLER: Mr. Jones?

17 MEMBER JONES: I agree.

18 CHAIR MILLER: It appears that the
19 motion has passed by 7-0-0 vote. I hereby
20 give notice that the ABC Board will hold this
