MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of FR & LH, LLC, trading as To Be Determined, please come forward. The parties in the matter of FR & LH, LLC.

This is Case No. 14-PRO-00067. FR & LH, LLC, trading as To Be Determined, 1515 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W., License No. ABRA-095966. It's a retailer CR, a new application. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet, and parking.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher and I'm conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent, pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2.

Introductions, beginning with the Applicant.

MR. KLINE: Good morning. Andrew Kline on behalf of the Applicant.

MR. MOTTAGHI: Steve Mottaghi.

MS. FLETCHER: Steve, would you

1 state your last name again and spell it for
2 the record.

3 MR. MOTTAGHI: Sure. It's
4 Mottaghi. M O-T-T --

5 MS. FLETCHER: M - I'm sorry? M

7 MR. MOTTAGHI: M O-T-T-A-G-H-I.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Mr.
9 Kline, that's with a K

11 MR. KLINE: K-L-I-N-E.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. For ANC
13 2E?

14 MR. BIRCH: Yes. Thomas Birch. B-
15 I-R-C-H.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you Mr.
17 Birch. And the individuals - oh.

18 MS. CRUSE: Karen Tammany Cruse
19 representing the Citizens Association of
20 Georgetown.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And Ms.
22 Cruse, would you spell your name for the

1 record, please.

2 MS. CRUSE: Karen. K-A-R-E-N.
3 Tammany. T-A-M-M-A-N-Y. Cruse. C-R-U-S-E.

4 MS. FLETCHER: And Ms. Cruse, just
5 so that you know, for some reason I don't see
6 the protest actually filed by the Citizens
7 Association of Georgetown, but if I recall
8 correctly, you did.

9 MS. CRUSE: Yes.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. I'm just
11 letting you know I'll contact you after the
12 roll call hearing -

13 MS. CRUSE: Okay. Thank you.

14 MS. FLETCHER: - to make sure I
15 get that - make sure I get a copy of that.

16 MS. CRUSE: They were hand-
17 delivered.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Exactly. Yes. I
19 don't know how I know that you did, but I know
20 that you did.

21 (Laughter)

22 MS. CRUSE: Because I'm always so

1 efficient.

2 MS. FLETCHER: And so there's also
3 a group of individuals. If those individuals
4 would stand behind the microphone and read
5 your name - state your name and spell it for
6 the court reporter.

7 MS. BUNNELL: I'm Judith Bunnell.
8 B-U-N-N-E-L-L.

9 MR. PLATT: Sure. Allan Platt. A-
10 L-L-A-N. P-L-A-T-T.

11 MS. BOWLING: Good morning. I'm
12 Laura Bowling. L-A-U-R-A. B, as in boy, O-W-L-
13 I-N-G. Just like bowling alley.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

15 MS. ROBINSON: Page Robinson. P-A-
16 G-E, Robinson.

17 MS. RUTLEDGE: Good morning. My
18 name is Susan Rutledge. It's R-U-T-L-E-D-G-E.
19 Thank you.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

21 MR. SYNADINOS: Good morning. My
22 name is Dimos Synadinos, and it's spelled D-I-

1 M-O-S, and S-Y-N-A-D-I-N-O-S.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Spell the first
3 name for me one more time.

4 MR. SYNADINOS: D-I -

5 MS. FLETCHER: B as in boy?

6 MR. SYNADINOS: D as delta, I-M-O-
7 S.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, thank you.

9 MR. SYNADINOS: You're welcome.

10 MR. PASTRE: Good morning. Peter
11 Pastre. P-A-S-T-R-E.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you Mr.
13 Pastre. Okay. That's everybody. Oh --

14 MS. CRUSE: Do you want an
15 original copy of the petition, the protest -

16 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. Yes. Thank
17 you.

18 MS. CRUSE: I've got that.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you
20 very much.

21 And have you decided - this is for the
22 individual group. Have you decided who's

1 going to be the designated representative for
2 your group?

3 MS. CRUSE: Yes.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Who's that going to
5 be?

6 MS. CRUSE: Mr. Pastre.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Pastre,
8 would you please pull your chair up to the
9 table.

10 MR. PASTRE: Okay.

11 MS. FLETCHER: And would you also
12 fill out that information on the contact
13 information sheet. So Mr. Pastre will be the
14 person that receives the notices, and the
15 person that we contact directly from this
16 point forward, and I'm assuming that everyone
17 present is in agreement with Mr. Pastre being
18 the designated representative.

19 Just checking to make sure that
20 everyone present -- all of the individuals
21 present signed the protest letter. I recognize
22 most of the names.

1 Dimos - is your first name Jim?

2 MR. SYNADINOS: Yes.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So that's
4 you.

5 MR. SYNADINOS: Yes.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Just wanted
7 to make sure. Thank you.

8 MR. SYNADINOS: Yes. The English
9 version.

10 (Laughter)

11 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So that's
12 Jim, S-Y-N-A-B-I --

13 MR. SYNADINOS: It's S-Y-N-A-D for
14 delta, I-N-O-S.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, D as in delta.
16 Okay.

17 So now there's Jim Dimos
18 Synadinos.

19 MR. SYNADINOS: Synadinos. Thank
20 you. It's very Greek.

21 (Laughter)

22 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so Peter

1 Pastre - okay I see. So everyone signed the
2 protest letter. All of the individuals present
3 did sign the protest letter. There are seven
4 individuals present from the protest group.
5 There were originally 17 from your group. The
6 ten that are not here, and who did not
7 designate representatives, are not considered
8 protestants, but the roll call notice says
9 that either you have to come in person or
10 designate a representative. The seven of you
11 that are here are granted standing as
12 protestants. So we've got ANC 2E, the Citizens
13 Association of Georgetown, and a Group of
14 Seven, represented by Peter Pastre.

15 MR. PASTRE: Pastor.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Pastor. Okay. So
17 we need to schedule a date for mediation, a
18 status hearing, and a protest hearing. I'll
19 give you the date for the status hearing
20 first, and the protest hearing.

21 The status hearing is set for
22 October the 8th at 9:30. This October 8th at

1 9:30 a.m.

2 The protest hearing is set for
3 November 5 at 4:30 p.m. November 5 at 4:30.

4 MR. PASTRE: Four --

5 MS. FLETCHER: At 4:30. And we
6 need to set a date for mediation to occur
7 prior to October the 8th. I'll give you some
8 dates that are available.

9 Next Tuesday, September 23 is
10 available, if that's good for anyone.

11 MS. CRUSE: I'm not available.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. What about -
13 let's see. What about Tuesday, September 30.
14 Is that good for you Mr. Birch? Mr. Kline,
15 that's good?

16 MR. KLINE: That works for us.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Is that good for
18 you Mr. Pastre?

19 MR. PASTRE: Do you need me to
20 answer as well?

21 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

22 MR. PASTRE: It depends on the

1 time.

2 MS. FLETCHER: It can be at 9:00,
3 10:00, 11:00 or 1:00.

4 MR. PASTRE: Morning would be best
5 for me. 9:00.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Is that good for
7 you, Mr. Kline?

8 MR. KLINE: Yes. That'll work.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Birch, is 9:00
10 good for you?

11 MR. BIRCH: So the 30th at 9:00?

12 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. So mediation
13 is set for 9:00 o'clock on September 30.

14 And you'll receive written notice
15 too. We just also give out the dates during
16 the roll call.

17 Any questions at all?

18 (No response)

19 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. The roll call
20 hearing is concluded. Thank you.

21 (Whereupon, at 10:12 a.m., the
22 roll call hearing was concluded)
