3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We are
4 back on the record for the agendas for September
5 16, 2015. And let's start with the Legal Agenda.

6 The first two items on the Legal
7 Agenda are related to the same establishment.
8 They are settlement agreements between Central
9 Shaw Neighborhood Association and Ivy and Coney
10 dated June 2, 2015 and between ANC-6E and Ivy and
11 Coney, same date, License No. 092860.

12 These were two settlement agreements
13 that are being merged into one as they are the
14 exact same terms and the new settlement agreement
15 has one signature page with all three parties
16 signatures.

17 And I move that we approve it.

18 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second it.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez has
20 seconded the motion.

21 All those in favor say aye.

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: I would like to

1 offer --

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Is that a
3 comment? Comment?

4 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: I would like to offer
7 a friendly amendment.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes.

9 MEMBER ALBERTI: That we approve with
10 modifications.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Ivy and Coney?

12 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. What?

14 MEMBER ALBERTI: To Items 3B and C.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Wait a second.

16 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: We had
17 modifications?

18 MEMBER ALBERTI: This is where they
19 need -- they mention brunch, but they need to
20 define --

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, yes, you are
22 absolutely right.

1 MEMBER ALBERTI: They need to define
2 the time frame for brunch.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: You're absolutely
4 right. Okay.

5 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes. And we have
6 sought clarification on whether -- what their
7 intent was by specifying seating capacity, if
8 their intent was to also imply that that is total
9 capacity or not.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I believe you are
11 talking about a provision that talks about number
12 for seats?

13 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And it doesn't
15 make any reference to the Certificate of
16 Occupancy.

17 MEMBER ALBERTI: And it makes no
18 reference to total occupancy.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So my
20 understanding is that we just want the parties to
21 make sure they understand that this applies only
22 to seats and doesn't --

1 MEMBER ALBERTI: And doesn't apply to
2 total, unless they want to amend it.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: That's right.
4 Okay. All right. Anything else?

5 MEMBER ALBERTI: That's it.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Thank you. All
7 right. So I move that we approve as modified
8 with respect to amending to clarify the hours of
9 brunch and that's it, but the parties should also
10 have the ability to amend if they want to clarify
11 with respect to Certificate of Occupancy. Okay.
12 Do I have a second?

13 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. The
15 motion has been seconded.

16 All those in favor say aye.

17 ALL: Aye.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
20 passes 3-0-0.

21 No. 3 is a settlement agreement
22 between ANC-6A and Jumbo Liquors dated August 20,

1 2015. Jumbo Liquors is located at 1122 H Street,
2 N.E., License No. 000420.

3 I move that we approve with
4 modification. And the modification would go to
5 there is a requirement, if I can find it --

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: 6C.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Thank you. 6C
8 that goes -- that deals with participating in the
9 Business Improvement District, if one exists,
10 correct, 6C. And while that is, I would say, an
11 allottable organization to participate in, it's
12 not the Board's role to require that
13 participation, so I would move that they delete C
14 from the settlement agreement.

15 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

16 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Madam Chair?

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes?

18 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: The omnibus bill,
19 in fact, expressly prohibits our requiring that
20 in a settlement agreement.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Another
22 good reason. All right.

1 Then all those in favor say aye.

2 ALL: Aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
4 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
5 passes 4-0-0.

6 Okay. No. 4 is a request for Sunday
7 delivery dated September 1, 2015 by Premium
8 Distributors of Washington, D.C., LLC located at
9 3500 Fort Lincoln Drive, N.E., License No.
10 060290.

11 I move that we approve this request.

12 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second it.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And Mr. Rodriguez
14 has seconded the motion.

15 All those in favor say aye.

16 ALL: Aye.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
19 passes 5-0-0.

20 Okay. We have a Supplemental Legal
21 Agenda. The first item is a settlement agreement
22 between ANC-2F and Espita Mezcaleria dated

1 September 2, 2015. Espita Mezcaleria is located
2 at 1250 9th Street, N.W., License No. 099558.

3 I move that we approve this settlement
4 agreement. Do I have a second?

5 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Alberti
7 seconded the motion.

8 All those in favor say aye.

9 ALL: Aye.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
11 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
12 passes 5-0-0.

13 No. 2 is a settlement agreement
14 between ANC-1B and Freehand dated August 14,
15 2015. Freehand is located at 1924 T Street,
16 N.W., License No. 099260.

17 Okay. I move that we approve with
18 modification. And modification to the clause
19 which I believe is on page 1 dealing with noise
20 from furniture. I don't have this in front of
21 me, but there is a provision that references
22 metal chairs that should be deleted. And instead

1 the parties can make reference to providing
2 furniture that is --

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: Designed to --

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: -- designed,
5 thank you.

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- mitigate noise.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Thank you.

8 That's right. Okay. That's the only
9 modification, I can see.

10 MEMBER ALBERTI: No. There is also
11 Item K where it says -- it has to do with --

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The assigns or
13 the unilateral term?

14 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- the assigns. They
15 can't assign this. And Item J --

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right.

17 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- which has to
18 include the phrase "or otherwise as allowed by
19 D.C. Statute." And that is with respect to
20 requests to modify the settlement agreement.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So my
22 understanding on that one is, I'm not sure if

1 they say it in these terms, but it is to address
2 the right to unilaterally terminate.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It's not --

5 MEMBER ALBERTI: But we have to
6 include a stipulation that it can be done as
7 provided by the statute.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

9 MEMBER ALBERTI: So we just add the
10 term "or otherwise allowed by statute."

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And they
12 will confer with our legal counsel on this, I
13 assume.

14 MEMBER ALBERTI: Absolutely.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes.

16 MEMBER ALBERTI: I always do.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So the
18 three modifications deal with the furniture
19 related to noise. Deleting the assigns, the
20 reference to assigns.

21 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And providing

1 termination as otherwise provided by statute,
2 which encompasses unilateral termination.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Then I
5 move to approve with those modifications. Do I
6 have --

7 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has
9 seconded the motion.

10 All those in favor say aye.

11 ALL: Aye.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
13 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
14 passes 6-0-0. All right.

15 No. 3 is a settlement agreement
16 between ANC-6E and Texas de Brazil dated
17 September 1, 2015. Texas de Brazil is located at
18 455 Massachusetts Avenue, Suite #100, N.W.,
19 License No. 098330.

20 I move that we approve this settlement
21 agreement. Do I have a second?

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Any
2 comments?

3 All those in favor then say aye.

4 ALL: Aye.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
6 opposed? All those abstaining?

7 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Mr. Brooks
8 seconded.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
10 seconded. Okay.

11 All those in favor say aye.

12 ALL: Aye.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
14 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
15 passes 6-0-0.

16 No. 4 is a review of off-site storage
17 request dated September 8, 2015 by Pizzeria
18 Paradiso located at 2000 Massachusetts Avenue,
19 N.W., License No. 016192.

20 I move that we approve this off-site
21 storage request. Do I have a second?

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: I'll allow Hector to

1 second it.

2 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second it.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And this
4 deals with storage invoices.

5 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: I don't know why.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez
7 seconded the motion.

8 All those in favor say aye.

9 ALL: Aye.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
11 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
12 passes 6-0-0.

13 No. 5 is another review of off-site
14 storage request dealing with invoices dated
15 September 8, 2015 by Pizzeria Paradiso. This one
16 is located at 3282 M Street, N.W., License No.
17 060575.

18 I move that we approve this request.
19 Do I have a second?

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Alberti
22 seconded the motion.

1 All those in favor say aye.

2 ALL: Aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
4 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
5 passes 6-0-0.

6 That completes our Legal Agendas.
7 Turning now to our Licensing Agenda.

8 The first item on the Licensing Agenda
9 is an application for safekeeping of a license by
10 Raku An Asian Diner located at 1900 Q Street,
11 N.W., License No. 023943.

12 I move that we approve.

13 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.
15 Silverstein seconded. This would be for a six
16 month period ending March 31, 2016.

17 All those in favor say aye.

18 ALL: Aye.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
20 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
21 passes 6-0-0.

22 No. 2 is an application for a

1 safekeeping of license. The original request is
2 by Skewers/Café Luna located at 1633 P Street,
3 N.W., License No. 099313.

4 I move that we also approve this one
5 for six months ending on March 31, 2016. Do I
6 have a second?

7 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Silverstein
9 seconded the motion.

10 All those in favor say aye.

11 ALL: Aye.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
13 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
14 passes 6-0-0.

15 No. 3 is an application for a class
16 change from Retailer C Restaurant to Retailer C
17 Tavern. This is for Chateau located at 3439
18 Benning Road, N.E., License No. 010574.

19 I move that we placard this
20 application. Do I have a second?

21 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has

1 seconded the motion. Any comments?

2 All those in favor say aye.

3 ALL: Aye.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
5 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
6 passes 6-0-0.

7 No. 4 is an application for class
8 change from Retailer B grocery store to Retailer
9 A liquor store in ANC-8C. This is MLK Mini
10 Market located at 3333 Martin Luther King, Jr.
11 Avenue, S.E., License No. 095905.

12 I move that we refer this to
13 licensing.

14 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second it.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez has
16 seconded the motion.

17 All those in favor say aye.

18 ALL: Aye.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
20 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
21 passes 6-0-0.

22 No. 5 is a request for a change of

1 hours. This is by Market of Columbia Plaza
2 located at 516 23rd Street, N.W., License No.
3 097197.

4 I move that we approve. Do I have a
5 second?

6 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.
8 Silverstein seconded the motion.

9 All those in favor say aye.

10 ALL: Aye.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
12 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
13 passes 6-0-0.

14 No. 6 is an application for a summer
15 garden with seating for 53. The establishment is
16 Bar Pilar located at 1833 14th Street, N.W.,
17 License No. 072472.

18 I move that we placard this
19 application.

20 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has
22 seconded the motion. Any comments?

1 All those in favor say aye.

2 ALL: Aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
4 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
5 passes 6-0-0.

6 No. 7 is an application for a
7 manager's license by Oliver A. Kopinski, ABRA No.
8 100240.

9 I move that we approve this
10 application. Do I have a second?

11 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
13 seconded the motion.

14 All those in favor say aye.

15 ALL: Aye.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
17 opposed?

18 MEMBER SHORT: Abstain.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All those
20 abstaining?

21 MEMBER SHORT: Abstain.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So the

1 vote is 5-0-1 with Board Member Short abstaining.

2 Okay. We have a Supplemental
3 Licensing Agenda.

4 The first item is a request to extend
5 safekeeping status of a license for Five Guys
6 located at 1335 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W., License
7 No. 071127.

8 It has been in safekeeping since July
9 28, 2010, so I move that we hold a Fact-Finding
10 Hearing on this request. Do I have a second?

11 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez
13 seconded the motion. Any comments?

14 All those in favor then say aye.

15 ALL: Aye.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
17 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
18 passes 6-0-0.

19 No. 2 is a request to extend
20 safekeeping. Status of the license, it's a first
21 request by Davis Market located at 3819 Georgia
22 Avenue, N.W., License No. 060094.

1 I move that we approve this
2 safekeeping until March 31st. Do I have a second?

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Alberti
5 seconded the motion.

6 All those in favor say aye.

7 ALL: Aye.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
9 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
10 passes 6-0-0.

11 No. 3 is a request to remove a license
12 from safekeeping status. This is for Duffy's
13 Irish Pub located at 2106 Vermont Avenue, N.W.,
14 License No. 072539.

15 I move that we approve this request.
16 Do I have a second?

17 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Alberti
19 seconded the motion.

20 All those in favor say aye.

21 ALL: Aye.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

1 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
2 passes 6-0-0.

3 Okay. No. 4 is a letter from Attorney
4 Stephen O'Brien requesting an involuntary
5 transfer of License No. ABRA-086034 from 3150
6 Restaurant Group, LLC to Via Umbria, LLC and
7 determine if a transfer of ownership must be
8 submitted. Via Umbria is located at 1525
9 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W., License No. 100387.

10 So I would advise that a transfer
11 request is not necessary, because our
12 understanding from our official records is that
13 the applicant or Via Umbria has already filed --
14 or Steve O'Brien has filed a change of location
15 application. And in that application it has
16 already been filed or checked a change of
17 ownership as well, so that that document
18 suffices.

19 And we have also already voted to
20 placard this license. So I would suggest that we
21 advise that an involuntary transfer application
22 is not necessary. Do I have any other comments?

1 All right.

2 Then all those in favor of that
3 conclusion say aye.

4 ALL: Aye.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
6 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
7 passes 5-0-0.

8 No. 5 is a request to reinstate a
9 canceled license. This is for Mova located at
10 2204 14th Street, N.W., License No. 087030.

11 I move that we continue this request
12 to next week. Do I have a second?

13 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
15 seconded the motion.

16 All those in favor say aye.

17 ALL: Aye.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: No? All those
19 opposed? All those abstaining? Okay. The
20 motion passes 6-0-0. Did Mr. Rodriguez do it?

21 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.

1 Rodriguez seconded the motion.

2 I knew it was on my right side, yes.

3 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: We look alike and
4 we sound alike.

5 MEMBER BROOKS: Yes, we do.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: No. 6 is a
7 request to extend the temporary license through
8 January 5, 2016 in accordance with the temporary
9 Certificate of Occupancy. This is for DC Eagle
10 located at 3701 Benning Road, N.E., License No.
11 093984.

12 So I move that we approve this
13 extension of the temporary license through the
14 date requested, which is January 5, 2016. But we
15 also schedule a Fact-Finding Hearing on a date to
16 be determined to see what is happening with this
17 temporary Certificate of Occupancy. Do I have a
18 second?

19 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has
21 seconded the motion. Any other comments?

22 All those in favor then say aye.

1 ALL: Aye.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
4 passes 5-0-0.

5 No. 7 are revised architectural floor
6 plans for a new full-service grocery store, that
7 being Dean & DeLuca located at 3276 M Street,
8 N.W., License No. 018083.

9 And I move that we refer this to
10 licensing.

11 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second it.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.
13 Rodriguez has seconded the motion. Any comments?
14 Okay. I think that this has been referred to
15 licensing before. I believe that the applicant
16 has made some changes and it needs to be referred
17 to licensing one more time to review those
18 changes.

19 Okay. All those in favor then say
20 aye.

21 ALL: Aye.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

1 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
2 passes 5-0-0.

3 Then we have a Cancellation Agenda.
4 The first item on the Cancellation Agenda is
5 ABRA-090705, Virginia Murphy, which involves a
6 solicitor's license at 100 S Street, Helena
7 Highway Street, Helena, California.

8 In any event, the employer, Trincherro
9 Family Estates has requested cancellation of this
10 license as the employee no longer works for the
11 company. So I move that we approve cancellation
12 of this license. Do I have a second?

13 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
15 seconded the motion.

16 All those in favor say aye.

17 ALL: Aye.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion
20 passes 5-0-0.

21 There was another item scheduled after
22 this, but that item has been taken off the

1 agenda.

2 So that completes all of our agendas
3 for September 16, 2015. And what remains is to
4 vote on the closed meeting for September 24th,
5 next week.

6 As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
7 Beverage Control Board for the District of
8 Columbia and in accordance with Section 405 of
9 the Open Meetings Amendment Act of 2010, I move
10 that the ABC Board hold a closed meeting on
11 September 24, 2015 for the purpose of seeking
12 legal advice from our counsel on the matters
13 identified on the Board's Agenda for September
14 24, 2015 as published in the DC Register on
15 September 18, 2015.

16 Is there a second?

17 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
19 seconded the motion. I'll now take a roll call
20 vote on the motion before us now that it has been
21 seconded.

22 Mr. Brooks?

1 MEMBER BROOKS: I approve.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez?

3 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: I approve.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Ms. Miller

5 approves.

6 Mr. Silverstein?

7 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I approve.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short?

9 MEMBER SHORT: I approve.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It appears that

11 the motion has been approved by a 5-0-0 vote.

12 I hereby give notice that the ABC
13 Board will hold this aforementioned closed
14 meeting pursuant to the Open Meetings Amendment
15 Act of 2010. Notice will also be posted on the
16 ABC Board hearing room bulletin board, placed on
17 the electronic calendar on ABRA's website and

17 Mr. Brooks?

18 MEMBER BROOKS: I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez?

20 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Ms. Miller
22 agrees.

1 Mr. Silverstein?

2 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I agree.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short?

4 MEMBER SHORT: I agree.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It appears that
6 the motion has passed by a 5-0-0 vote.

7 I hereby give notice that the ABC
8 Board will hold this aforementioned closed
9 meeting pursuant to the Open Meetings Amendment
10 Act of 2010. Notice will also be posted on the
11 ABC Board hearing room bulletin board, placed on
12 the electronic calendar on ABRA's website and
13 published in the DC Register in as timely a
14 manner as practicable.

15 And that concludes our business for
16 September 16, 2015 and we are adjourned.
