3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay, we're
4 back on the record for today's agenda. The
5 first item is a review of supplemental
6 documentation for a Pending Grocery Store B
7 Application, in ANC 6C, it's Giant, located at
8 300 8th Street, NE, license number 91952. I
9 move that we postpone this consideration until
10 next week. Do I have a second?

11 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
13 has seconded the motion, all those in favor
14 say aye.

15 (Chorus of ayes)

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
17 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
18 3-0-0.

19 Second is a request to increase
20 seating capacity for Rose's Luxury, located at
21 717 8th Street, S.E., license number 90884.
22 I move that we approve, do I have a second?

1 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
3 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
4 say aye.

5 (Chorus of ayes)

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
7 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
8 3-0-0.

9 Number 3 is the review of an
10 application for a manager's license for
11 Charles W. Idol. I move that we approve this
12 application, do I --

13 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
15 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
16 say aye.

17 (Chorus of ayes)

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
20 3-0-0.

21 Number 4 is an application for
22 manager's license for Dennis Philipson. I

1 move that we approve, do I have a second?

2 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
4 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
5 say aye.

6 (Chorus of ayes)

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
8 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
9 3-0-0.

10 Number 5 is an application for
11 manager's license for Kenon C. Pratt. I move
12 that we deny this application, do I have a
13 second?

14 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
16 has seconded the motion. All those in favor
17 of denying the application, say aye.

18 (Chorus of ayes)

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
20 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
21 3-0-0.

22 Number 6 is an application for

1 manager's license for Donald Spencer. I move
2 that we approve, do I have a second?

3 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
5 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
6 say aye.

7 (Chorus of ayes)

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
9 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
10 3-0-0.

11 And Number 7 is an application for
12 manager's license for Celestina Ferrufino. I
13 move that we approve. Do I have a second?

14 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
16 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
17 say aye.

18 (Chorus of ayes)

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Aye?

20 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Aye.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All
22 those opposed? All those abstaining? Motion

1 passes 3-0-0.

2 Number 8 is a motion to continue
3 to purchase hearing, dated September 30, 2013,
4 from Sarah Green of ANC 4B1, the establishment
5 issue is Sunshine Bar & Lounge, located 7331
6 Georgia Avenue N.W..

7 The licensee has not responded to
8 the motion, though she was served, and the
9 time has passed. I move that we approve the
10 motion. Do I have a second?

11 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr.
13 Silverstein seconded the motion. All those in
14 favor, say aye.

15 (Chorus of ayes)

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
17 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
18 3-0-0.

19 Number 9 is a request dated
20 September 18, 2013, to reinstate the protest
21 of Group of Five or More from Jeremy Sigmon,
22 the establishment is Climax, located at 900

1 Florida Avenue, N.W., license number 088290.

2 I move that we deny, on grounds that no good
3 reason was provided. Is there a second?

4 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
6 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
7 say aye.

8 (Chorus of ayes)

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
10 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
11 3-0-0.

12 Okay, Number 10 is a request dated
13 September 19, 2013, to reinstate the protest
14 of ANC 1B, with respect to the same
15 establishment, Climax.

16 And I would move that we deny it
17 for the same reason, that no good cause was
18 presented. And this ANC 1B should have
19 understood our regulations on this. Is there
20 a second?

21 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks

1 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
2 say aye.

3 (Chorus of ayes)

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
5 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
6 3-0-0.

7 Number 11 is a request dated
8 September 16, 2013, from E&J Gallo Winery for
9 approval to provide retailers with products
10 valued at more than \$50 and less than \$500.
11 I move that we approve. Do I have a second?

12 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
14 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
15 say aye.

16 (Chorus of ayes)

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
19 3-0-0.

20 Number 12 is another request from
21 E&J Gallo Winery, dated September 30, 2013,
22 for approval to provide retailers with

1 products valued at more than \$50 and less than
2 \$500. And I move that we approve. Do I have
3 a second?

4 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
6 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
7 say aye.

8 (Chorus of ayes)

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
10 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
11 3-0-0.

12 Number 13 is a review of a request
13 dated September 23, 2013, from Crown Imports,
14 for approval to provide retailers with
15 products valued at more than \$50 and less than
16 \$500. I move that we approve. Do I have a
17 second?

18 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
20 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
21 say aye.

22 (Chorus of ayes)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
2 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
3 3-0-0.

4 Number 14 is a review of
5 settlement agreement, dated September 24,
6 2013, between ANC 1A and El Atardecer
7 Restaurant, which is located at 3475 14th
8 Street, N.W., license number 092346.

9 I move that we approve with
10 modifications to Paragraphs 4, 8, and 10, and
11 our attorneys will communicate with the
12 parties about the modifications. Do I have a
13 second?

14 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those in
16 favor, say aye.

17 (Chorus of ayes)

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
20 3-0-0.

21 Number 15 is a Settlement
22 Agreement dated September 18th, 2013, between

1 Group of Five or More and Marvin. Marvin's
2 located at 2007 14th Street, N.W., license
3 number 76116. I move that we approve this
4 Settlement Agreement. Do I have a second?

5 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
7 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
8 say aye.

9 (Chorus of ayes)

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
11 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
12 3-0-0.

13 Number 16 is a Settlement
14 Agreement dated September 15, 2013, between
15 ANC 6B and District Taco. District Taco's
16 located at 656 Pennsylvania Avenue, S.E.,
17 license number 092797. I move that we approve
18 the Settlement Agreement, with modification to
19 Paragraph 5. Do I have a second?

20 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
22 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,

1 say aye.

2 (Chorus of ayes)

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
4 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
5 3-0-0.

6 Okay, that concludes the regular
7 agenda. We have a supplemental agenda.
8 Number 1 on the supplemental agenda is a
9 request to re-classify outdoor space from
10 sidewalk caf, to summer garden, in ANC 3E.
11 This is Firelake Grill, located at 4200
12 Wisconsin Avenue N.W. I move that we approve
13 this request. Do I have a second?

14 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
16 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
17 say aye.

18 (Chorus of ayes)

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
20 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
21 3-0-0.

22 Number 2 is a request for a

1 stipulated license for Firelake Grill, and
2 that is now moot, because we have approved
3 Number 1.

4 Number 3 is a request for seating
5 expansion for The Exchange located at 1730
6 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., license number
7 01269 at ANC 2A. I move that we approve this
8 application. Do I have a second?

9 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
11 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
12 say aye.

13 (Chorus of ayes)

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
15 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
16 3-0-0.

17 Okay, Number 4 is a request for a
18 change of hours, which for earlier hours, and
19 indoors only. And the ANC supports this
20 request. And it's for Commissary, located
21 1443 P Street, N.W., license number 71487. I
22 move that we approve. Do I have a second?

1 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
3 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
4 say aye.

5 (Chorus of ayes)

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
7 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
8 3-0-0.

9 Number 5 is a request for
10 involuntary transfer of license and
11 safekeeping, and this is for Le Deux Garcons,
12 located 3712-3714 Macomb Street, N.W., in ANC
13 3C, and it's license number 86355, and I move
14 that we approve. Do I have a second?

15 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
17 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
18 say aye.

19 (Chorus of ayes)

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
21 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
22 3-0-0.

1 Number 6 is a request for a change
2 of hours, and this is for Takoma Park Liquors,
3 located at 6200 Eastern Avenue, license number
4 19598 and ANC 4B.

5 And approved hours are Sunday
6 through Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., and
7 they are seeking hours Sunday through Saturday
8 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. I move that we
9 approve. Do I have a second?

10 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
12 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
13 say aye.

14 (Chorus of ayes)

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
16 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
17 3-0-0.

18 Number 7 is a request for license
19 class change from a DC to a CT. And this is
20 for La Trojola Bar at 3708 14th Street, N.W.,
21 license number 92074 and ANC 4C. I move that
22 we placard this request.

1 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
3 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
4 say aye.

5 (Chorus of ayes)

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
7 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
8 3-0-0.

9 Number 8 is the motion to dismiss
10 the protest from Richard Bianco, Counsel for
11 Tropicalia Project, LLC, Bossa Brazilian
12 Bistro, located at 2463 18th Street, N.W.,
13 license number 084505.

14 We denied this motion at hearing
15 today, but we can vote on it again, as it's on
16 the agenda. So I move that we deny the motion
17 to dismiss.

18 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
20 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
21 say aye.

22 (Chorus of ayes)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
2 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion to
3 deny the motion to dismiss passes by a vote of
4 3-0-0.

5 Number 9 is a request for a
6 continuance of a protest hearing for Brian
7 Hart ANC 1C. Protestant Kalorama Citizens'
8 Association does not object to the request for
9 a continuance, however, the Applicant has
10 indicated that it does.

11 And the Applicant is Habana
12 Village, 1834 Columbia Road, N.W., license
13 number 24197. In light of Habana Village's
14 opposition, I would move that we deny the
15 request.

16 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
18 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
19 say aye.

20 (Chorus of ayes)

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
22 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes

1 3-0-0. Finally, we have three license
2 cancellations.

3 And, let's see, I think, I think
4 I'm going to move that we approve all the
5 cancellations, so I'm going to read all three
6 of them, and we can vote once.

7 One is for ABRA-078578, SOVA
8 Espresso and Wine, located at 1359 H Street,
9 N.E. Number 2 is ABRA Number 10581, Caf,
10 Japone, located at 2032 P Street, N.W., and
11 third is ABRA-60626, Fur Factory, located at
12 33 Patterson Street, N.E.

13 Okay, so all these are, I suppose,
14 cease operations and surrender license and
15 request immediate cancellation. Okay. So I'm
16 going to move to approve cancellation of all
17 three licenses. Do I have a second?

18 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay, Mr.
20 Brooks has seconded the motion. All those in
21 favor, say aye.

22 (Chorus of ayes)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
2 opposed? All those abstaining? Motion passes
3 to approve all cancellations by a vote of
4 3-0-0. Okay, that completes our business for
5 this afternoon. And we just need to vote on
6 the meeting closures.

7 As Chairperson on the Alcoholic
8 Beverage Control Board for the District of
9 Columbia, and in accordance with D.C. Official
10 Code Section 2-574(b) of the Open Meetings
11 Act, I move that the ABC Board hold a closed
12 meeting on October 16th, for the purpose of
13 seeking legal advice from our counsel on the
14 matters identified on the Board's Agenda for
15 October 16th, as published in the D.C.
16 Register on October 11, 2013. Is there a
17 second?

18 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I'll now take
20 a roll call vote on the motion before us, now
21 that it's been seconded. Mr. Brooks?

22 MEMBER BROOKS: I agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Ms. Miller
2 agrees. Mr. Silverstein?

3 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I agree.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: As it
5 appears, the motion is passed by a 3-0-0 vote.
6 I hereby give notice that the ABC Board will
7 hold this aforementioned closed meeting,
8 pursuant to the Opens Meetings Act, notice
9 will also be posted on the ABC Board Hearing
10 bulletin board, placed on the electronic
11 calendar, and ABRA's website, and published in
12 the D.C. Register, in as timely a manner as
13 practicable.

14 As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
15 Beverage Control Board for the District of
16 Columbia, and in accordance with D.C. Official
17 Code Section 2-575(b) and 2-547 of the Opens
18 Meetings Act, I move that the ABC Board hold
19 a closed meeting on October 16th, 2013, for
20 the purpose of discussing and hearing reports
21 concerning ongoing, or planned investigations
22 of alleged criminal or civil misconduct to

1 violations of law regulations and seeking
2 legal advice from our Counsel on the Board's
3 Investigative Agenda for October 16, 2013, as
4 published in the D.C. Register on October 11,
5 2013. Is there a second?

6 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks
8 has seconded the motion. I'll now take a roll
9 call vote on the motion before us, now that
10 it's been seconded. Mr. Brooks?

11 MEMBER BROOKS: I agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Ms. Miller
13 agrees. Mr. Silverstein?

14 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It appears
16 that the motion has passed by a 3-0-0 vote.
