1 P R O C E E D I N G S

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning,
4 everyone. I'd like to welcome you to the
5 regularly scheduled meeting of the District of
6 Columbia's Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.
7 Today is October 14th, 2015. My name is Ruthanne
8 Miller. I'm the Chairperson.

9 Joining me today, to my far right, is Mr.
10 Donald Brooks, and immediately to my right is Mr.
11 Hector Rodriguez, and joining us momentarily will
12 be Mr. Mike Silverstein. The Board has four
13 members in attendance for the conduct of business
14 today, with three constituting a quorum.

15 Copies of Copies of today's hearing
16 calendar and agenda are available at the
17 receptionist desk. Please be aware that these
18 proceedings are being recorded by a court
19 reporter. Accordingly, we must ask you to
20 refrain from any disruptive noises or actions in
21 the hearing room.

22 If you have any electronic devices,

1 pagers, cell phones and such, please make
2 certain they are turned off to avoid any
3 interruption of the proceedings.

4 When I call your case, please come
5 forward and take a seat at one of the tables in
6 the front. You will notice that there is a piece
7 of paper on each table for you to sign in. This
8 is to ensure the correct spelling of your name
9 for the record.

10 The Open Meetings Act requires that the
11 public hearing on each case be open to the
12 public. The Board may, consistent with Section
13 405(b) of the Open Meetings Act, enter a closed
14 meeting during or after the public hearing on a
15 case to consult with an attorney to obtain legal
16 advice, discuss settlement agreements, or
17 deliberate upon a decision in an adjudication
18 proceeding.

19 I also want to read some general
20 instructions for the show cause status hearing
21 cases that we have that will apply to all the
22 cases that I'll be calling with respect to shoe

1 cause hearing.

2 Show cause status hearing cases are
3 scheduled for 9:30, many of them. The following
4 instructions are pertinent to all of them. The
5 purpose of the status conference is to entertain
6 any preliminary matters of the parties and to
7 provide the parties with the date and time of the
8 hearing on the merits of the case if the case
9 proceeds to hearing.

10 Preliminary matters include any proposed
11 agreements of the parties to settle the case for
12 the Board's consideration, notice, Offers in
13 Compromise, and motions or questions regarding
14 procedural matters, including schedule or
15 dismissal of a case or a party for failure to
16 comply with legal requirements.

17 The Board will assume that the Applicant
18 or the Respondent had notice of this hearing by
19 his or her presence or the presence of an
20 authorized agent. However, if you have any issue
21 relating to the adequacy of your notice, you may
22 raise that with the Board when your case is

1 called.

2 The Board also has on its calendar,
3 protest hearing status cases, and I'll be
4 addressing specific instructions with respect to
5 those hearings in the individual cases.

6 So, at this point, I'm going to turn to
7 this morning's calendar, and the first case is a
8 protest hearing status case. It's Case No.
9 15-PRO-00080, Savoy Suites Hotel located at 2505
10 Wisconsin Avenue, Northwest, License No. 90804,
11 ANC-3C.

12 This hearing has been continued to
13 November 4, 2015, 9:30 a.m., at the joint request
14 of the parties.
