The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, 1250 U Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., Ms. La Verne Fletcher, Agent, presiding.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties
4 in the matter of Romeo & Juliet please come
5 forward?

6 This is Case No. 13-PRO-00136, 301
7 Romeo, LLC t/a Romeo & Juliet, 301
8 Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., License No. ABRA-
9 092684, Retailer CR, new application.

10 The protest issues are adverse
11 impact on peace, order and quiet.

12 My name is La Verne Fletcher and
13 I'll be conducting the Roll Call Hearing as
14 the Board's Agent pursuant to DC Official Code
15 1601.2.

16 Introductions beginning with the
17 applicant, please.

18 MR. SHORT: Good morning, Ms.
19 Fletcher. My name is Bryan Short standing in
20 for Andrew Kline for the applicant.

21 AGENT FLETCHER: And would you
22 please spell your name for the court reporter?

1 MR. SHORT: Certainly. It's B-R-
2 Y-A-N S-H-O-R-T.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
4 Short. And, Mr. Short, would you put your
5 contact information on that sheet on the
6 table?

7 MR. SHORT: I have, ma'am. I have
8 included Andrew's contact information, because
9 that's really who is going to be handling this
10 matter.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you
12 very much.

13 And for ANC-6C?

14 MS. WIRT: Commissioner Karen
15 Wirt, 6C02.

16 AGENT FLETCHER: And could you
17 spell your name for the court reporter, Ms.
18 Wirt?

19 MS. WIRT: Spell my name?

20 AGENT FLETCHER: For the court
21 reporter.

22 MS. WIRT: All right. Last name

1 is Wirt, W-I-R-T.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very
3 much. ANC-6C does have standing as a
4 protestant. We need to schedule a date for a
5 Status and Protest Hearing and a mediation.
6 I'll give you the date for the Status and
7 Protest Hearing first.

8 The date for the Status Hearing is
9 November the 20th at 9:30 a.m. And the date
10 for the Protest Hearing is December 11, 2013
11 at 1:30 p.m.

12 We need to schedule a date for
13 mediation to occur prior to November 20. I'll
14 give you the next dates that are available.
15 Tuesday, November 12 is available at 9:10.

16 MS. WIRT: I cannot do that day.

17 MR. SHORT: Neither can we.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: The next date
19 that is available is Thursday, November 14.

20 MR. SHORT: That's available.

21 AGENT FLETCHER: Is that good?

22 MR. SHORT: Yes, that's good.

1 MS. WIRT: That's good.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: It can be at
3 9:00, 10:00, 11:00 or 1:00. Do you have a
4 preference?

5 MR. SHORT: 10:00?

6 MS. WIRT: 10:00 is good.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: 10:00. So then
8 mediation is set for 10:00 on November 14.

9 MS. WIRT: We did have a beginning
10 of an agreement, a voluntary agreement, but we
11 hadn't agreed on all the conditions, but I can
12 give you a draft of that if that would be
13 useful.

14 AGENT FLETCHER: That will be
15 fine, Ms. Wirt.

16 MS. WIRT: This is for mediation.

17 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, I just made
18 a note of what you just said and if you enter
19 into one prior to November 14, you can just
20 send it in and then we will cancel the
21 mediation.
