3 MS. MILLER: Okay, next case is Case  
4 number 14-CC-00090 7th & L Street Market located  
5 at 700 L Street Southeast, license number 88611  
6 and ANC 6B.

7 MS. ZANIEL: Good morning, Maureen  
8 Zaniel on behalf of the District of Columbia.

9 MS. MILLER: Good morning.

10 INTERPRETER: Good morning, Korean  
11 interpreter.

12 MS. MILLER: You're the interpreter?

13 INTERPRETER: Yes.

14 MS. CHOE: Good morning. Eun Su Choe  
15 with 7th & L Street Market.

16 MS. MILLER: Okay, I'm just going to  
17 swear you in, sir, and what language are you  
18 interpreting?

19 INTERPRETER: Korean.

20 MS. MILLER: Korean. Okay, you're  
21 okay. Do you solemnly affirm that you will  
22 faithfully and accurately interpret the

1 proceedings in this matter from Korean into  
2 English and from English into Korean to the best  
3 of your ability?

4 INTERPRETER: I do.

5 MS. MILLER: Okay. Thank you. Okay,  
6 so this is a Show Cause Status Hearing and I need  
7 to ask whether Ms. Choe received notice of the  
8 Hearing?

9 INTERPRETER: Yes.

10 MS. MILLER: Okay, and did she read it  
11 and understand it?

12 INTERPRETER: Yes.

13 MS. MILLER: Okay, so there's no issue  
14 of Notice of this Hearing?

15 MS. CHOE: No.

16 MS. MILLER: Okay, good. All right.  
17 Ms. Zaniel are there any preliminary matters?

18 MS. ZANIEL: Yes. We have an offer  
19 and compromise that we would recommend the Board  
20 accept at this time. I have spoken to Ms. Choe a  
21 couple of times by phone and then again today  
22 with the interpreter, so I'm certainly satisfied

1 that she understood what we discussed.

2 MR. SILVERSTEIN: Ms. Zaniel, if you  
3 could speak more slowly. He's translating it.

4 INTERPRETER: Thank you.

5 MS. ZANIEL: Thank you.

6 MR. SILVERSTEIN: Thank you.

7 MS. ZANIEL: So the compromise is  
8 this. There would be a \$4000 fine as to charge  
9 one. Charge two would be dismissed. In addition  
10 to the \$4000 fine, there is a 10-day suspension  
11 with five days served and five days stayed  
12 pending no violation within the next year.

13 Additionally, this violation triggers  
14 other days that had been stayed and there are  
15 four of those. So for the ten plus four a total  
16 of 14 days suspension with nine days served.  
17 Those nine days would be served on the following  
18 days: December 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 and  
19 January 1, 2, 3. With respect to the fine, the  
20 licensee would have 60 days within which to make  
21 that payment with the provision that if the fine  
22 is not paid within 60 days, the license will be

1 automatically suspended. And that is the entire  
2 agreement, and again, we do believe that's an  
3 appropriate one give the charges and the history  
4 in this matter.

5 MS. MILLER: Okay. Thank you. I'm  
6 going to try to read it back as I understand it  
7 and for Ms. Choe to confirm where she is  
8 agreeable to it. A \$4000 fine for charge one to  
9 be paid within 60 days. If the whole fine is not  
10 paid within 60 days, the license will be  
11 suspended until it is paid. The license will be  
12 suspended for ten days, five days will be served,  
13 five days will be stayed pending no further  
14 violation and this violation triggers four days  
15 that were suspended and stayed pursuant to Case  
16 number 13-CC-00034; therefore, the establishment  
17 license will be suspended for a total of nine  
18 days. Those dates are December 26, 27, 28, 29,  
19 30, 31, January 1, 2, 3. Charge two is  
20 dismissed. Okay. Ms. Zaniel, was that correct?

21 MS. ZANIEL: It is correct. Thank  
22 you.

1 MS. MILLER: Okay. And Ms. Choe, do  
2 you agree to this offer and compromise?

3 INTERPRETER: Yes.

4 MS. MILLER: Okay. Do you know that  
5 this waives your right to a hearing?

6 INTERPRETER: Yes.

7 MS. MILLER: Okay, and also to appeal?

8 INTERPRETER: Yes.

9 MS. MILLER: Okay. Any questions by  
10 Board members? Mr. Jones?

11 MR. JONES: I just wanted to clarify  
12 that the charge two is being dropped.

13 MS. ZANIEL: Correct.

14 MR. JONES: Okay. That being dropped,  
15 is there a particular reason why it's being  
16 dropped or is there, can you elaborate on it?

17 MS. ZANIEL: Well it's appropriate to  
18 drop it. I think the law calls for either a  
19 warning on it and so it's not going to be fined  
20 and we felt that with the total package it's fair  
21 to dismiss the charge.

22 MR. JONES: Okay. Thank you. Thank

1 you, Madam Chair.

2 MS. MILLER: Okay. Any other  
3 questions? Okay, then I move that we approve  
4 this offer and compromise of a fine of \$4000 to  
5 be paid within 60 days and if it's not all paid  
6 within 60 days the license will be suspended  
7 until it is paid and that the license will be  
8 suspended for ten days, five days served, five  
9 days stayed and this triggers four days  
10 suspension from Case number 13-CC-00034. Dates  
11 of suspension December 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31,  
12 January 1, 2, 3. I think that covers it. We've  
13 said this one a few times so do I have a second?

14 MR. SILVERSTEIN: Second.

15 MS. MILLER: Mr. Silverstein has  
16 seconded the motion. All those in favor say aye.

17 (Chorus of ayes.)

18 MS. MILLER: All those opposed?

19 MR. JONES: Opposed.

20 MS. MILLER: All those abstaining?

21 Motion passes I believe by a vote of 6 to 1 to 0  
22 with Mr. Jones dissenting opposed. Mr. Jones

1       opposed.   Okay.   Okay, thank you very much.
