3 MS. MILLER: Okay, the next case is  
4 Case number 14-AUD-00044, Le Pain Quotidien  
5 located at 2815 M Street Northwest, license  
6 number 77337 and ANC 2E.

7 MR. STERN: Michael Stern representing  
8 the District of Columbia.

9 MR. FONSECA: Good morning members of  
10 the Board. Michael Fonseca, F-O-N-S-E-C-A, on  
11 behalf of PQ Georgetown, Le Pain Quotidien.

12 MS. BARKER: I'm Susan Barker. I'm  
13 district manager of the Le Pain Quotidien.

14 MS. MILLER: Okay.

15 MR. FONSECA: The district manager's  
16 been authorized by corporate headquarters to  
17 accept an offer of compromise. We have received  
18 the Notice of Show Cause. It's been read,  
19 discussed with counsel. They understand it and  
20 we waive reading.

21 MS. MILLER: Great, okay. Did you  
22 introduce yourself for the record, Mr. Stern?

1 MR. STERN: I think I did, but Michael  
2 Stern representing the District of Columbia.

3 MS. MILLER: Okay, so do we have any  
4 preliminary, oh, Mr. Jones, welcome.

5 MR. JONES: Thank you Madam Chair.  
6 Just a clarification counselor, you indicated  
7 that the general management authorized and I may  
8 have missed this, but do we have this in writing?

9 MR. FONSECA: Do not. We can follow up  
10 with that and she's not a judge, she's a district  
11 manager in Maryland and DC.

12 MR. JONES: District manager, I  
13 apologize. Okay, so you say we can follow up  
14 with that?

15 MR. FONSECA: Yes, we can if that's,  
16 if the Board requires that.

17 MS. MILLER: Aren't you also  
18 authorized to represent the owner as their  
19 attorney?

20 MR. FONSECA: Yes. We typically do  
21 want to have a representative sign. Occasionally  
22 I've signed the paperwork, but we normally make

1       sure that the licensee representative does so  
2       that's why I have the district manager here.

3               MS. MILLER:   Okay.   Okay, that's fine  
4       to submit then.   We can go forward but its fine  
5       to submit that in writing as well, the  
6       authorization.   Okay.   If there is something.   Is  
7       there?

8               MR. STERN:   Yes, there is.

9               MS. MILLER:   All right.

10              MR. STERN:   The advisement to an  
11       agreement which we hope the Board will accept is  
12       an offer and compromise.   That consists of a fine  
13       of \$2000 to be paid within 30 days though I  
14       understand the check is here now, and I can tell  
15       the Board that the quarterly statement has been  
16       filed.

17              MS. MILLER:   Okay, great.

18              MR. FONSECA:   And if I could, we do  
19       have the check.   We'll pay it today if the Board  
20       approves and so if you understand this was  
21       originally on for October 22 and appearing to  
22       show cause at that time had not reached corporate

1 so we've come back at a date prior to the  
2 December 3 Show Cause knowing that this was  
3 something that should be an offer and compromise.  
4 We thank the Board also for, and staff, for  
5 scheduling this earlier.

6 MS. MILLER: Okay, good. So do you  
7 all agree to this offer and compromise of \$2000,  
8 I guess it's accurate to say to be paid today?

9 MS. BARKER: Yes.

10 MS. MILLER: Okay. All right, any  
11 questions from Board members? All right, then I  
12 move that we approve this offer and compromise of  
13 \$2000 to be paid today. Do I have a second?

14 MR. SILVERSTEIN: Second.

15 MS. MILLER: Mr. Silverstein seconded  
16 the motion. All those in favor, say aye.

17 (Chorus of ayes.)

18 MS. MILLER: All those opposed? All  
19 those abstaining? Motion passed as 7, 0, 0.

20 MR. FONSECA: Thank you.
