CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Next Protest Status Hearing Case is Case No. 13-PRO-00120, Jack Rose, located at 2007 18th Street, N.W., License No. 81997 and ANC 1C. This is a renewal application.

When you are ready, if you would introduce yourselves for the record, please?

MR. THOMAS: Bill Thomas, owner of Jack Rose Dining Saloon, 2007 18th Street, LLC.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay, good to see you. All right.

MR. JAMES: Good morning, Dennis James, representing Kalorama Citizens Association.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Are there any issues you need to bring to the Board's attention?

MR. JAMES: We had mediation which

1 was unsuccessful.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All
3 right, so I'm going to set this for a Protest
4 Hearing, December 4, 2013 at 4:30 p.m.

5 MR. THOMAS: Four thirty?

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Four thirty,
7 my notes show. I also want to bring to your
8 attention, as I have with the other cases,
9 that you should have received a mailing from
10 Tesha Anderson. Her number is 442-6942,
11 explaining the protest process. And what's
12 most important is that protest information
13 form. That needs to be filled out and
14 submitted to ABRA and the appropriate parties
15 seven days before the hearing and that needs
16 to articulate clearly the issues that you will
17 be arguing in the hearing and your witnesses
18 so that there aren't any surprises and we can
19 focus efficiently on the case at hearing.

20 So do you have any questions about
21 that call Ms. Anderson or Martha Jenkins. Do
22 you have any questions now, feel free to ask,

1 otherwise you're set.

2 MR. JAMES: Thank you.

3 MR. THOMAS: I just want to
4 apologize for missing the last meeting. Like
5 I said, I was literally -- my operations
6 partner manager has had a sick kid now for
7 five months, seizures and stuff, and I've been
8 working really hard. And he actually called
9 me the night before. You know how you plan
10 for this meeting and you plan, you're on pins
11 and needles. He called me the night before
12 and I hadn't seen him in months. He was like
13 can we meet in the morning? I ran right into
14 work and I was sitting at work and meeting and
15 was just so important meeting with him I just
16 forgot and I'm so sorry.

17 The other note is there was a
18 rumor that the FBI interviewed me on the Pappy
19 van Winkle case. It was The New York Times
20 that interviewed, not the FBI. I just want to
21 make that clear, The New York Times, not the
22 FBI.
