- 2 PROCEEDINGS
- 3 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: We're back in
- 4 session. I apologize for I said 10 minutes. But
- 5 I didn't realize that our 10 minutes ran into a
- 6 much longer period.
- 7 The Board is back in session. There are
- 8 three members current so we do have a quorum.
- 9 And the other two members will join us shortly.
- The next case that we're calling is a
- 11 fact finding case. Pub Crawl, Lindy Promotions.
- 12 Could the parties please step forward.
- 13 Can you identify your name for the
- 14 record, please, and spell it.
- MS. BENNER: Sure. Christine Benner,
- 16 Lindy Promotions, C-h-r-i-s-t-i-n-e. Benner, B-
- 17 e-n-n-e-r.
- INVESTIGATOR PUENTE: Investigator Kevin
- 19 Puente, P-u-e-n-t-e.
- 20 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Thank you. As you
- 21 know, Ms. Benner, you were here earlier this
- 22 morning. The Board had a fact finding hearing

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- 1 regarding there were three promoters regarding a
- 2 pub crawl event that occurred on Halloween night.
- 3 Your organization participated. It was approved
- 4 by the Board. And so we're not saying that you
- 5 did anything wrong in that. But you were
- 6 approved by the Board to participate in that
- 7 event.
- 8 However, one of the major concerns that
- g came up during that promotion is that the Board
- 10 had approved your event for 3,000, and you
- 11 basically doubled the amount which clearly, as
- you heard earlier, Halloween was a perfect storm.
- 13 Everything that could have gone wrong went wrong.
- We had the testimony from the commander
- who talked about that all the extra resources
- that had to be brought in the area. I'm not
- saying that your organization was completely
- 18 responsible for it, because it was a holiday
- weekend and it was also Halloween. But you were
- 20 approved for an event and you did not abide by
- 21 the rules and the regulations that were
- 22 established. And, at least in my view, you did

- 1 not provide us with a plausible, appropriate
- response while you doubled your event.
- And so, with that said, I am recommending
- 4 to the Board that we not -- and also, you're
- s asking for New Year's Eve which, again, is a
- 6 perfect storm, and it's so close after Halloween
- 7 which is a perfect storm -- so my recommendation
- 8 to the Board is that we not approve this event
- 9 for Halloween. And it's based on the fact that
- it's -- based on what happened on Halloween and
- based on the numbers, I just cannot fathom
- 12 doubling your event.
- I mean, if you had informed me that this
- 14 happened -- I know that you said you called the
- bars. But, I think at least, if you gave us some
- 16 proof that you spoke to someone in ABRA, informed
- of us the major errors that occurred, I think
- 18 that that would be more plausible. So my
- 19 recommendation is to recommend to the Board that
- we not approve this one. That does not close you
- 21 from applying for others. But I just think
- because it's Halloween and this is New Year's,

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- that in this particular case, that's my
- 2 recommendation.
- MR. SILVERSTEIN: I second that, Mr.
- 4 Chairman.
- 5 MR. SHORT: I agree with that, Mr.
- 6 Chairman.
- 7 MR. ALBERTI: Can we allow Ms. Benner
- 8 before we --?
- 9 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: And so, if you have
- anything to add, you can, please.
- MS. BENNER: Yeah. We definitely do
- agree that the Halloween bar crawl was the
- 13 perfect storm. There were more people and we do
- take fault by that and I do apologize for that.
- This bar crawl, we would be limiting the
- number to closer to 500 people. New Year's Eve
- is more of a one-bar holiday where customers like
- 18 to go to one spot, kind of check in for that
- 19 night and have the ball drop there and be with
- their friends where a lot of places do open bars.
- 21 So we don't expect to have anywhere in the number
- of people that we had for the Halloween one. So

- we would definitely be limited to that.
- We would also, now moving forward, know
- that we should definitely be more in contact with
- 4 the Board and letting you guys know any changes
- 5 that happen, as well as with the Metro PD, making
- sure that we're all working together as a team
- 7 moving forward so that we don't have anything
- 8 that happens similar to what we just went through
- 9 at the last meeting.
- MR. ALBERTI: May I just say something?
- 11 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Sure. Go ahead.
- MR. ALBERTI: I thought I had after our
- 13 fact finding. So this is to you. This is to the
- 14 BID. This is to anyone in the audience.
- Hindsight's always wonderful. But I'm
- 16 kicking myself for having approved any bar crawls
- on Halloween on that particular weekend. I
- 18 should have known better. So I will assume some
- 19 responsibility as a person who approved it. But
- 20 I will be mindful of that in the future and my
- 21 apologies to the BID.
- 22 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: All right. So there

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- 1 is a motion --
- MR. SILVERSTEIN: I second.
- 3 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Yeah. Mr.
- 4 Silverstein has seconded the motion. Those in
- favor say aye.
- [Chorus of ayes.]
- 7 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: The motion passes
- 8 five, zero, zero.
- 9 MS. MILLER: Can I make a comment?
- 10 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Yes, Ms. Miller.
- MS. MILLER: I just want to say to Ms.
- 12 Benner that I think it was a very serious glitch
- -- if you call that a glitch -- 3,000 people,
- 14 regardless of what else was happening and that I
- 15 think that your company has a pretty good record.
- 16 But it really needs to revisit how it deals with
- 17 public safety issues and notification issues.
- MS. BENNER: Okay. Thank you.
- MS. MILLER: Thank you.
- 20 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Yes, Mr. Silverstein.
- MR. SILVERSTEIN: Very briefly, there are
- three reasons why I voted as I did, the first

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- which is the scope of the error that you made on
- 2 Halloween; 3,000 additional people unquestionably
- 3 made things worse.
- As far as the law is concerned, 25-115,
- 5 this is a temporary license by law. And we can
- 6 deny it. And we are to deny it if, under Section
- 7 D, if the applicant has failed to control the
- 8 environment of a previous event associated with a
- 9 temporary license or has sustained community
- 10 complaints or police action, the Board may deny
- 11 the license application. It is based on that
- 12 that I voted to do so.
- And the third reason is simply the danger
- of New Year's Eve that I do not ever want to
- 15 second guess myself on anything like this. And
- 16 I'd also like to take this opportunity to thank
- 17 Investigator Puente for an outstanding job in
- 18 helping us understand what happened in these
- 19 cases.
- 20 INVESTIGATOR PUENTE: Thank you.
- MR. SILVERSTEIN: Thank you, Mr.
- 22 Chairman.

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- 1 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: All right. Thank
- 2 you.
- MR. SHORT: Also, I'd like to go on the
- 4 record and thank Investigator Puente, also, for
- 5 an excellent job on his reporting. Pictures
- 6 speak volumes as to what occurred out there. And
- 7 to the BID, I'd also like to say we thank you for
- 8 the hard work you do down in DuPont Circle. And
- 9 we're going to do a lot more, if we can, to help
- 10 you out with these situations so that this
- 11 doesn't occur again. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.
