The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street N.W., Washington, D.C., Ms. La Verne Fletcher, Agent, presiding.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Are the parties
4 present in the matter of DC Shenanigans?

5 Okay. Thank you.

6 Would the parties in the matter of
7 DC Shenanigans please come forward.

8 This is Case No. 13-PRO-00158.

9 Twin T's LLC, trading as DC Shenanigans, 2450
10 18th Street, N.W., License No. ABRA-088119.

11 This is a Retailer CT License Renewal.

12 The protest issues are adverse
13 impact on peace, order and quiet and real
14 property values.

15 My name is La Verne Fletcher and I
16 am conducting the roll call hearing as the
17 Board's agent, pursuant to D.C. Official Code
18 1601.2.

19 Introductions beginning with the
20 Applicant, please.

21 MR. FONSECA: Michael Fonseca, F-
22 o-n-s-e-c-a, on behalf of the Licensee. With

1 me is its principal.

2 State your name for the record.

3 MR. HALL: My name is Thomas Hall,
4 managing member, Twin T's LLC t/a DC
5 Shenanigans.

6 MS. FLETCHER: And, Mr. Hall, that
7 is H-a-l-l?

8 MR. HALL: Yes, ma'am.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Thomas. Okay. And
10 on behalf of the ANC1C.

11 MR. GUTHRIE: Ted Guthrie, T-e-d,
12 G-u-t-h-r-i-e.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
14 Guthrie.

15 MR. JAMES: Denis James,
16 representing Kalorama Citizens Association.
17 D-e-n-i-s, J-a-m-e-s. Kalorama, K-a-l-o-r-a-
18 m-a.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
20 James.

21 MS. AUBRUN: My name is Benedicte
22 Aubrun, B-e-n-e-d-i-c-t-e, A-u-b-r-u-n, for

1 the Reed-Cooke Neighborhood Association, R-e-
2 e-d-c-o-o-k-e Neighborhood Association.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. ANC1C,
4 the KCA and Reed-Cooke Neighborhood
5 Association are the protestants in this
6 matter.

7 We will only set a date for
8 mediation today because I don't have a
9 calendar for the status of protest hearings.
10 Those dates have not been given to me.

11 We do have one date available in
12 January. That is January 30th, if anybody
13 wants to come on that day. January 30.

14 MR. GUTHRIE: What day of the week
15 is that?

16 MS. FLETCHER: That is a Thursday
17 at nine, ten, eleven or one.

18 MR. GUTHRIE: That doesn't work
19 for me.

20 MS. FLETCHER: It doesn't work?

21 MR. GUTHRIE: No.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So --

1 MR. FONSECA: I will say -- this
2 is my partner, Mr. O'Brien. He will handle
3 the mediation so if it could be in the
4 afternoon, so that day is bad.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

6 MR. FONSECA: But afternoons are
7 best for us.

8 MS. FLETCHER: All right.

9 MR. JAMES: The status would be
10 probably the first week of February?

11 MS. FLETCHER: I don't know when
12 the status is going to be right now, Mr.
13 James. I am just scheduling the protest
14 hearings and --

15 MR. JAMES: Very well. So that we
16 would do the -- make, in effect, an
17 appointment for the mediation prior to the
18 status?

19 MS. FLETCHER: We are going to
20 schedule the mediations in February. The next
21 available date in February is Tuesday,
22 February 4. And one is available at one.

1 MR. JAMES: At one?

2 MS. FLETCHER: On February 4th,
3 because that is the best time for Mr. O'Brien.

4 MR. JAMES: That is fine.

5 MR. FONSECA: That is fine. At
6 one p.m.?

7 MS. FLETCHER: At one p.m. Is
8 that okay for you, Ms. Aubrun?

9 MS. AUBRUN: Yes.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So mediation
11 is set for Tuesday, February 4 at one o'clock.

12 Okay. Thank you very much for
13 coming. Roll Call Hearing is concluded.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Do you have a
15 question, Mr. James, before we go off the
16 record?

17 MR. JAMES: We have two other
18 cases.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

20 MR. JAMES: Well, one other case.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

22 MR. JAMES: He has two others.
