1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Would the parties in
3 the matter of Bardo please come forward? The
4 parties in the matter of Bardo. This is case
5 #15-PRO-00114, trading as Bardo, 25 Potomac
6 Avenue S.E. License #ABRA-100646. This is a
7 Retailer Class DT, New application. The protest
8 issues are adverse impact on peace, order and
9 quiet and residential parking and vehicular and
10 pedestrian safety. My name is Laverne Fletcher.
11 I am conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the
12 Board's Agent pursuant to D.C. Official Code
13 1601.2. Introductions beginning with the
14 applicant, please.

15 SPEAKER: Yes, Ms. Fletcher. My name is
16 William Stewart, I'm from Bardo, I'm the owner.

17 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Mr. Stewart, that's
18 S-T-E-W-A-R-T?

19 MR. STEWART: Yes ma'am.

20 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: And present on behalf
21 of ANC 6D.

22 SPEAKER: Coralie Farlee, Chair, ABC

1 Committee.

2 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Ms. Farlee, would you
3 spell your name for the record, please?

4 MS. FARLEE: C-O-R-A-L-I-E, F-A-R-L-E-E.

5 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

6 MS. FARLEE: Can I ask about the trading
7 name here? I thought it was Bardo Big River.

8 MR. STEWART: I thought so, too.

9 MS. FARLEE: There's a t/a for the Bardo.

10 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: There's a T on the
11 end?

12 MS. FARLEE: Bardo Big River.

13 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Let me look at the
14 placard, on this it's -- the placard has Bardo,
15 but that's -- that's not -- that's that's -- we
16 can fix that.

17 MR. STEWART: That's fine.

18 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Yeah --

19 MR. STEWART: Either way.

20 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: The placard notice is
21 for --

22 MS. FARLEE: There is another different

1 Bardo.

2 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay.

3 MS. FARLEE: A different location.

4 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: True.

5 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: And so, Mr. Stewart,
6 it should be Bardo what?

7 MR. STEWART: Big River.

8 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Bardo Big River?

9 MR. STEWART: Yeah.

10 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay. So, the
11 address is correct though? 25 Potomac Avenue
12 S.E?

13 MR. STEWART: Yes.

14 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay, so it needs to
15 be Bardo Big River for this one.

16 MR. STEWART: Right.

17 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay.

18 MR. STEWART: Like she said, there's two
19 locations, so --

20 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

21 I'll correct the record on this, at this one.

22 ANC 6D has standing as a protestant. We need to

1 set a date for a mediation, a status hearing and
2 protest hearing. I'll give you the dates of the
3 status and protest hearings first. The status
4 hearing is set for January 20 at 9:30. The
5 protest is set for February 10th at 1:30. We
6 need to set a date for mediation. The next
7 available date is January the 12th at 9:00,
8 10:00, or 11:00. That's on a Tuesday.

9 MR. STEWART: I'm available for anything.

10 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay.

11 MR. STEWART: Whatever they want.

12 MS. FARLEE: Let's --

13 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: On 9:00, 10:00 or
14 11:00?

15 MS. FARLEE: I'm sorry, January 12?

16 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Yes, that's a
17 Tuesday.

18 MS. FARLEE: Let's say 10:00.

19 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: 10:00? So mediation
20 is set for Tuesday, January 12, at 10:00. Mr.
21 Stewart, did you put your contact information on
22 that sheet?

1 MR. STEWART: Uh, yes ma'am.

2 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

3 MR. STEWART: Mediation is in this
4 office, right?

5 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Yeah. When you come
6 in just check in with the receptionist. We'll --
7 it'll probably be -- it'll probably be in this
8 room. If not, I will come back and take us
9 somewhere else. Okay, any other questions at
10 all? Okay, the Roll Call Hearing is concluded.
11 Thank you.

12 MR. STEWART: Thanks for your time.

13 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Happy holidays.

14 MR. STEWART: Merry Christmas.

15 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Thank you. Merry
16 Christmas to you.

17 MS. FARLEE: 1/12 at 10:00, 1/20 at 9:30
18 and 2:10 at 1:30.

19 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: What was that, Ms.
20 Farlee?

21 MS. FARLEE: I'm just going over the
22 dates. January 10 at 10:00.

1 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Uh, January 12.

2 MS. FARLEE: Wait, 12.

3 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Uh huh, Tuesday,
4 January 12.

5 MS. FARLEE: Yeah, at 10:00.

6 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: At 10:00.

7 MS. FARLEE: The 20th at 9:30.

8 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Yes, for the um
9 status hearing --

10 MS. FARLEE: Status.

11 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Is January 20 at
12 9:30.

13 MS. FARLEE: Not at -- yeah -- and --

14 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: And for the protest
15 hearing --

16 MS. FARLEE: February 10.

17 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: It is February 10.

18 MS. FARLEE: At 1:30. Alright. Thank
19 you.

20 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Yes. The Roll Call
21 Hearing is concluded.
