2 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Would the parties in  
3 the matter of Ocopa come forward? The parties in  
4 the matter of Ocopa. This is Case #15-PRO-00112,  
5 Chicken Tortilla, trading as Ocopa, 1324 H Street  
6 Northeast, License #ABRA -- Excuse me -- excuse  
7 me in the back the court reporter is disturbed by  
8 the chatter. Thank you. This is Case #15-PRO-  
9 00112, Chicken Tortilla, trading as Ocopa 1324 H  
10 Street Northeast, License #ABRA 088102,  
11 Substantial Change. The Applicant is requesting  
12 an Entertainment Endorsement. Entertainment is  
13 to include Latin dancing and occasional live  
14 music. The protest issues are adverse impact on  
15 peace, order and quiet. My name is Laverne  
16 Fletcher. I am conducting the roll call hearing  
17 as the Board's Agent pursuant to D.C. Official  
18 Code 1601.2. Introductions beginning with the  
19 Applicant please.

20 SPEAKER: Yes, my name is Eddie Migues.  
21 I'm part owner of Ocopa.

22 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: And, Mr. Migues, would you

1 spell your last name, please?

2 MR. MIGUES: M-I-G-U-E-S.

3 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: M-A-G --

4 MR. MIGUES: Oh, excuse me. M-A --

5 MR. MIGUES: M-I --

6 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Uh huh.

7 MR. MIGUES: G-U-E-S.

8 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very  
9 much. And you?

10 SPEAKER: Hi, my name is Yolanda  
11 Woodward. I am here representing Mr. Migues on  
12 behalf of Cooper and Kirkman, his attorneys.

13 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. Ms.  
14 Woodward, there's a sign-in sheet right there.  
15 Would you put your contact information on that  
16 sheet?

17 YOLANDA WOODWARD: No problem.

18 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Thank you. And  
19 present on behalf of ANC 6A?

20 SPEAKER: Good morning, Ms. Fletcher. My  
21 name is Jay Williams. Last name W-I-L-L-I-A-M-S.  
22 And I am the current Co-Chair of the ANC 6A

1 Alcoholic Beverage Licensing Committee.

2           MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Thank you Mr.  
3 Williams. ANC 6A does have standing as a  
4 protestant. We need to set a date for a  
5 mediation, a status hearing and a protest  
6 hearing. I'll give you the date for the status  
7 and protest hearings first. The status hearing  
8 is set for January 20 -- that's January 20, 2016,  
9 at 9:30 a.m. The protest hearing is set for  
10 February 24, 2016, at 1:30 p.m. So we need to  
11 set a date for mediation. I'll give you the next  
12 available date. Does anyone want to come the  
13 week of December 28th? If so, that Tuesday and  
14 Wednesday are available.

15           JAY WILLIAMS: [inaudible 03:07] So, my  
16 thought would be to push the mediation a little  
17 bit later and see if we can resolve it before  
18 mediation, but if you prefer to set it, that's  
19 fine.

20           YOLANDA WOODWARD: I think he's trying to  
21 get that resolved as soon as possible for the  
22 holidays.

1 JAY WILLIAMS: And that's fine.

2 YOLANDA WOODWARD: That's the earliest --  
3 the 28th would be the earliest day I guess. Do  
4 we want to do it in the week of the 28th?

5 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: So, I'm not sure how  
6 the court reporter is doing.

7 JAY WILLIAMS: Oh, I'm sorry.

8 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay good, thank you.

9 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Can you tell me what  
10 another date is, but after the 28th, because Mr.  
11 Cooper is --

12 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: It was the 29th or  
13 the 30th. It was December 29 or 30.

14 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Oh, December 29th or  
15 the 30th?

16 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Uh huh.

17 JAY WILLIAMS: Sure, I'm flexible.

18 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Okay, if we have any  
19 problem with that date we can call to reschedule  
20 it?

21 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Yes.

22 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Or push the mediation

1 because Mr. Cooper is in the hospital, that's one  
2 of the reasons why I'm here.

3 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay. And if you  
4 want to go ahead --

5 YOLANDA WOODWARD: I'm not sure he'll be--

6 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: And then if you want  
7 go ahead and --

8 JAY WILLIAMS: That's fine.

9 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: -- and set something  
10 for the 29th and 30th, we can. If you want agree  
11 and get it out of the way, we'll just start that  
12 then.

13 JAY WILLIAMS: Sure, I'm flexible either  
14 one of those days, so --

15 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay, so then -- so  
16 then -- Ms. Woodward, what would work better for  
17 you? 8:00, 9:00, 10:00. I mean not 8:00, 9:00,  
18 10:00 -- 9:00, 10:00 or 11:00?

19 YOLANDA WOODWARD: 10:00 would be good.

20 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: 10:00 on the 29th or  
21 the 30th?

22 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Either day. The 29th.

1 JAY WILLIAMS: Let's do the 29th.

2 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Yeah, let's do it the  
3 29th.

4 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: 10:00 on December 29  
5 for mediation. Okay. And if anything changes my  
6 card is on the table. You're gonna receive an e-  
7 mail --

8 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Okay.

9 JAY WILLIAMS: Alright.

10 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: -- with those dates  
11 also.

12 JAY WILLIAMS: Thank you.

13 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: But if anything  
14 changes just give me a call.

15 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Okay.

16 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay. Any questions  
17 at all?

18 JAY WILLIAMS: No.

19 YOLANDA WOODWARD: No, we're good.

20 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: Okay.

21 YOLANDA WOODWARD: Thank you.
