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AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made between Alpha Restaurant, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation, trading as Au Pied De Cochon (the "Applicant") and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2E ("the ANC").

WHEREAS, the Applicant has applied for renewal of the Class "CR" alcoholic beverage license for the property located at 1335 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W., ABC Application No. 3729, which is pending before the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC Board); and

WHEREAS, the ANC represents the residents and taxpayers within its boundaries and wishes to insure that no establishment that sells alcoholic beverages will adversely affect the health, safety, and quality of life in the surrounding community; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement commemorating certain understandings regarding the Applicant's operational plans;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the agreements set forth herein, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

1. The Applicant shall at all times operate as a bona-fide restaurant for the primary purpose of food consumption. The kitchen shall be open and hot food items shall be available at all times when the establishment is open.
2. The Applicant shall strictly enforce the underage drinking laws of the District of Columbia by requiring valid official identification showing age and cooperating with ABC inspectors and the police department in enforcing the law. The Applicant shall prominently post signs inside the establishment and at the door to inform customers of the legal drinking age and of the requirement for valid identification prior to service of alcoholic beverages.
3. The Applicant shall ensure compliance with the laws of the District of Columbia regarding hours of consumption of alcoholic beverages. Accordingly, no alcoholic beverages shall be served in the establishment later than 1:30 am on the evenings of Monday through Thursday or 2:30 am on the evenings of Friday and Saturday. All bottles, glasses and similar containers used for alcohol service shall be removed from the public areas of the establishment by no later than 2:00 am on the evenings of Monday through Thursday or 3:00 am on the evenings of Friday and Saturday. The Applicant shall prominently post signs inside the establishment informing customers of the legal hours for alcohol service and of the policy described in this paragraph.
4. The Applicant shall ensure that, at all times, sufficient staff are trained and certified as ABC-licensed managers. To this end, the Applicant agrees at this time to train a fourth ABC-licensed manager on staff. An ABC manager shall be on-site at all times when alcoholic beverages are offered for sale or are present in the public areas of the establishment.
5. The Applicant recognizes its obligation to maintain the sidewalk and nearby areas in clean condition and agrees to periodically sweep and remove litter from these areas.
6. A copy of this agreement shall be kept on the premises and shall be available at all times for viewing by any person upon request.
7. The parties agree that the above provisions are conditions of the license and any failure of Applicant to adhere to the foregoing commitments would constitute grounds for the ANC to petition the ABC Board for issuance of an order to show cause pursuant to 23 D.C.M.R. §1513.5.
8. In consideration of, and in reliance upon, the foregoing agreements made by the Applicant, the ANC agrees to withdraw any objection to the application..


9. This written agreement constitutes the only agreement between the parties and may be modified only by the written agreement of both parties.

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
1. The opposition of Peter Pulsifer, Chair, on behalf of the Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2E, is **WITHDRAWN**;

4. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Protestant and the Applicant.







ORDER ON WITHDRAWN PROTEST

The application, having been protested, came before the Board for public hearing on November 24, 1998, in accordance with D.C. Code Section 25-115(c)(5)(1999 Supp.), providing for the protestants to be heard. Joseph & Cloatta Farrell, Cynthia Anthony, Single Member District Commissioner, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2E07 and Susan Michael-Smith, filed timely protest letters.

The official records of the Board reflect that the parties have now reached an agreement which has been reduced to writing, and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. Pursuant to the agreement dated January 21, 1999, the protestants have agreed to withdraw the opposition, provided however, the Board's approval of the pending application is conditioned.

Accordingly, it is this 16th day of June 1999, **ORDERED** that:



AGREEMENT

This 21st day of January, 1999, ALPHA RESTAURANT, Inc., T/A Au Pied de Cochon, ("the Applicant") 1335 Wisconsin Ave., N.W., Washington, D.C. , 20007, and Joseph M. Farrell, 3128 Dumbarton St., Cloatta Farrell, 3128 Dumbarton St., N.W., Susan Michal-Smith, 3120 Dumbarton St., N.W., and Cynthia Anthony, 3108 Dumbarton St., N.W., and formerly Single Member District Commissioner, ANC 2E-07 ("the neighbors") hereby agree as follows:

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pending before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board ("ABC Board") of the District of Columbia is the Applicant's renewal application for a class CR license for the premises at 1335 Wisconsin Ave., N.W., with Application Number 3729; and

WHEREAS, the neighbors filed a timely petition protesting the renewal of the license by letter dated November 29, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement regarding certain aspects of Applicant's operations;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above, and the covenants and promises set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Applicant will further enclose its garbage/trash holding area which is now located behind the restaurant beside Dumbarton Street, by placing a roof on said holding area (See Exhibit A attached). Said roof will be metal or metal covered.
2. The Applicant will continue in effect the concrete floor and cinder block walls of said area, including the 2' deep cinder block foundation, so that when said roof is installed the garbage/trash holding area will be impervious to rodents.
3. Applicant will continue a sliding metal door on the Dumbarton Street side of said area, which may be opened at the time of garbage/trash

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collection, but which will remain shut at all other times, and secured from the inside.

4. Applicant will continue its practice of washing down the garbage/trash area, with the wash removed by a drain inside the area which will be continuously open and unclogged and which connects to the Applicant's sewer line inside Applicant's premises, so that there will be no water or wash run-off outside the garbage area onto the sidewalks or into the gutter. The objective is to eliminate odors from said area, and to eliminate any collection of water on the sidewalk.

5. Applicant will continue its practice of having its garbage/trash picked up by a commercial rubbish and/or trash removal concern frequently during the week at reasonable pickup hours.

6. Applicant will maintain, for the duration of each license renewal, its contract with Affordable Pest Control, or similar properly licensed pest control service, with the objective of securing advice, assistance, and services necessary to eliminating the premises at 1335 Wisconsin Avenue as an attraction for pests and rodents, as described in the attached program. (A copy of the current pest control contract with Applicant and Affordable Pest Control, sanitized of price and cost information, will be made available to the neighbors and their counsel by March 15, 1999.

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
7. The structural improvements above will be completed by April 1, 1999.

8. In consideration of, and in reliance on, the commitments reflected in paragraphs 1 through 7 above, the neighbors hereby withdraw their protest of Applicant's pending liquor license renewal application.

9. The parties further agree that the above provisions are conditions of the license.
