2 [10:03 A.M.] ROLL CALL HEARING

3 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Will the parties
4 in the matter of Local 16 please come forward?
5 This is Case #16-PRO-00074. 1600 U Inc, trading
6 as Local 16, 1600 U Street Northwest. License
7 #ABRA-060467. This is a Retailer CR, petition to
8 amend or terminate settlement agreement. The
9 protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order
10 and quiet. My name is LaVerne Fletcher, I'm
11 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's
12 agent. Introductions beginning with the
13 applicant, please.

14 MR. ROME: Sure, Scott Rome from the
15 Veritas Law Firm on behalf of the applicant,
16 Local 16.

17 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Mr. Rome, would
18 you spell Veritas?

19 MR. ROME: V-E-R-I-T-A-S.

20 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Veritas Law Firm?
21 Thank you. And on behalf of ANC-1C?

22 MR. GUTHRIE: Ted Guthrie. T-E-D, G-U-T-

2 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Mr. Guthrie,
3 you're representing the ANC on this one?

4 MR. GUTHRIE: Yes, I am.

5 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay. And present
6 on behalf of ANC 2B?

7 MR. SACCO: Peter Sacco. I'm the
8 executive director of ANC 2B.

9 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Peter, would you
10 spell your last name for the record?

11 MR. SACCO: Sacco. S-A-C-C-O.

12 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: S-A-C-C-O. Thank
13 you. Did you put your contact information on
14 that sheet already?

15 MR. SACCO: Yup.

16 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
17 ANC 1C and ANC 2B have standing as protestants.
18 We need to set a date for mediation, a status
19 hearing and a protest hearing. I'll give you the

6 MR. GUTHRIE: If possible, I'd prefer not
7 to have a Thursday.

8 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay. Not on a
9 Thursday. What about Friday, August 19th at 9:00
10 or 11:00?

11 MR. GUTHRIE: August 19th?

12 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: 19th, mm hmm.
13 That's a Friday.

14 MR. GUTHRIE: That would be fine. 11:00?

15 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Is 11:00 good for
16 you, Mr. Rome?

17 MR. ROME: It's fine.

18 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Mediation is set
19 for 11:00 on Friday, August 19th. Okay, any
20 questions at all? Thank you for coming.
