ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PROTEST

The Application filed by M Street Management Group, LLC, t/a 1819 Club, for Renewal of its Retailer's Class CX License, having been protested by Terrance Lynch, on behalf of Downtown Cluster of Congregations on October 6, 2010, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board ("Board") for a Roll Call Hearing on January 3, 2011, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).


On January 3, 2011, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the Protest because the Association is not a "citizens association incorporated under the laws of the District of Columbia located within the affected area" in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601(3). The Protestant may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

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
ORDER




