ORDER ON VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT

The official records of the Alcoholic Control Board (Board) reflect that Feker Sound, Inc. t/a Little Ethiopia Restaurant, Applicant for a Retailer's Class CR license, located at 1924 9th Street, N.W., Washington D.C., and Brianne Nadeau, Chair, and Peter J. Raia, Commissioner, on behalf of Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 1B, (collectively, the Parties) have entered into a Voluntary Agreement (Agreement) dated January 9th, 2008 setting forth the terms and conditions that govern the operation of the Licensee's establishment.


The Agreement authorizes hours of operation on Sunday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. and on Friday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. The hours of sale and service of alcoholic beverages are from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., on Sunday through Thursday and from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday. The agreed hours of entertainment are from 8:00 p.m. to 1:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday and from 8:00 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. on Friday and Saturday. The Agreement has been reduced to writing and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. Both the Applicant and Commissioners Nadeau and Raia are signatories to the Agreement.

Accordingly, it is this 28th day of January 2009, **ORDERED** that:



Voluntary Agreement Little Ethiopia Restaurant

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 9 day of January 2008 by and between Feker Sound Inc. (Applicant) and ANC1B (Protestant) witnesses:

Whereas Applicant has filed a new CR01 license 80135 to be located at 1924 9th Street NW (premises) with the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC Board) ;

Whereas Protestant has filed before the ABC Board a protest opposing the granting of this application;

Whereas in recognition of the ABC Board's policy of encouraging parties to a protested proceeding to settle their differences by reaching voluntary agreements, by their signatures below, the parties hereto desire to enter into a voluntary agreement whereby (1) Applicant will agree to adopt certain measures to address Protestant's concerns and to include this agreement as a formal condition of its application, and (2) Protestant will agree to the issuance of the new license and withdraw its protest provided that such an agreement is incorporated into the ABC Board's order issuing the license, which license is conditioned upon compliance with this agreement;

Whereas Applicant has recently taken or intends to take, certain measures designed to ameliorate Protestant's concerns;

In consideration of the mutual covenants and undertakings memorialized herein, the Applicant and Protestants hereby agree as follows:

A. NOISE. Applicant will strictly comply with DC Official Code 25-725 and to that end shall make architectural improvement to the property and take all necessary actions to ensure that music, noise and vibration from the business are not audible within abutting and adjacent residential properties. Dancing is not encouraged of the patrons. No music will be played or amplified to any outdoor area. The doors and windows of the premises will be kept closed at all times during business hours when music is being played or any sound amplification device is being employed in the premises, except when persons are in the act of using the door for ingress to or egress from the premises. Applicant will discourage employee use of the rear yard to mitigate noise. The Applicant agrees to restrict all events to those run by the restaurant and will not contract the restaurant for any special events to be operated by an outside contractor.




