ORDER ON AMENDMENT TO SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The official records of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reflect that LaFourchette, Inc., t/a LaFourchette (Licensee), located at 2429 18th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. and ANC 1C entered into a Settlement Agreement (Agreement), dated May 18, 1990, that governs the operation of the Licensee's establishment.

This matter comes now before the Board to consider the Parties' Amendment to Settlement Agreement (Amendment), dated May 23, 2016, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-446 (2001).

The Amendment has been reduced to writing and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. The Licensee and Commissioner Julie Seiwel, on behalf of ANC 1C, are signatories to the Amendment.

1. The above-referenced Amendment to Settlement Agreement, dated May 23, 2016, submitted by the Parties to govern the operations of the Licensee's establishment is **APPROVED** and **INCORPORATED** as part of this Order;
2. All terms and conditions of the original Settlement Agreement not amended by the Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect; and
3. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee and ANC 1C.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).



ORDER ON VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT





1/ Mr. Charles R. Norris, Jr. is no longer a member of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.



The applicant, LA FOURCHETTE, Inc TIA LA FOURCHETTE, seeking a Class CR license to serve alcoholic beverages, agrees to the following conditions:

- 1) Hours of operation shall be 11:30 to 2 ~~PM~~; 11- To 2
SUND 10-TO 12
- 2) Table seating capacity not to exceed 75 persons;
- 3) Bar capacity not to exceed No stools; ~~ok~~
- 4) There shall be no live music. Recorded music, if any, shall be kept at a reasonable volume (i.e., not able to be heard outside).
- 5) La Fourchette will make efforts to employ neighborhood residents;
- 6) Trash will be removed (daily, weekly, time of day 4 times a week and area for trash disposal will be kept free of litter at all times.

Further, the business hopes to sustain itself by catering to residents of the Adams-Morgan and surrounding neighborhoods and as such sees no need to obtain parking at this time.

The undersigned agree to evaluate the business's impact on pedestrian and vehicular traffic after one year of operation. At that time they will mutually determine what action, if any, will be taken with respect to such traffic and its bearing on license renewal.

In addition, the undersigned agree that the license holder and the ANC may at any time review and amend this agreement subject to Board approval.
