
ORDER ON VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT



AGREEMENT

Made this 19th day of June 2000 by and between Charles T. Chang, Inc. t/a Charlie Chiang's Restaurant (the applicant) and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3F, North Cleveland Park and Forest Hills (the ANC).

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pending before the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC) is Applicant's application for a Class CR license for premises 4250 Connecticut Avenue, NW – Washington, DC, ABC Application #24996; and
WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement commemorating certain understandings regarding Applicant's operating plans;
NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises above recited, and the mutual covenants and promises set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

1. Applicant shall operate a bona fide restaurant on its premises.
2. The restaurant shall have a maximum of ¹⁴⁸~~135~~ seats for the exclusive use of dining patrons. Alcoholic beverages will be served primarily in conjunction with full meal service.
3. The bar/lounge will have a maximum of 8 seats for the primary use of patrons waiting for dining service, patrons waiting to be joined by other patrons and patrons waiting for carry-out food service.
4. The hours of operation will be 11:30am – 10:30pm, Sunday through Thursday, and 11:30am to 11:pm, Friday and Saturday.
5. Applicant shall admit no patrons to its premises after the hour of 10:30pm, Sunday through Thursday, and 11:00pm Friday and Saturday.
6. Applicant shall present no form of live entertainment and no form of recorded music other than soft background music for dining.
7. Applicant shall permit no form of dancing.
8. Applicant shall not install or utilize: any equipment for the showing of videos; juke boxes; or video games.
9. Applicant shall comply with all aspects of the Civil Infractions Act and the Litter Control Administration Act. Any alleged violations left uncorrected may be referred by the ANC to the appropriate agency.
10. An ABC licensed manager conversant with all aspects of this agreement shall be on-site at Applicant's premises during all hours of operation.
11. Any and all contemplated changes to Applicant's operation, as set forth herein or otherwise will be brought to the attention of the ANC prior to implementation only after ANC and, when required by rules and regulations, ABC Board approval.



- 12 In consideration of, and in reliance upon, the commitments reflected in paragraphs 1 through 11 above, the ANC will recommend to the ABC Board non-objection to Applicant's pending license application.
13. The parties further agree that any failure of Applicant to adhere to the foregoing commitments would constitute grounds for the ANC to petition the ABC Board for issuance of an order to show cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1513.5 to gain the Applicant's compliance with the terms of this Agreement.
