ORDER ON SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The official records of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reflect that American City Diner, Inc., t/a American City Diner (Applicant), and ANC 3/4G have entered into a Settlement Agreement, dated June 26, 2014 and approved by the Board on July 11, 2014. *See Board Order No. 2014-283.* This matter comes now before the Board to consider the Parties' revised Settlement Agreement (Agreement), dated June 26, 2014, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-446 (2001).

The Agreement has been reduced to writing and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. The Applicant and Chairperson Jim McCarthy, on behalf of ANC 3/4G, are signatories to the Agreement.

Accordingly, it is this 13th day of August, 2014, **ORDERED** that:

1. The above-referenced Settlement Agreement submitted by the parties to govern the operations of the Applicant's establishment is **APPROVED** and **INCORPORATED** as part of this Order;
2. This Settlement Agreement replaces and supersedes the Settlement Agreement approved by the Board on July 11, 2014; and
3. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and ANC 3/4G.



Pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (April 2004), any Party adversely affected by this Order may file a Motion for Reconsideration within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).

**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT CONCERNING ISSUANCE OF LICENSE
AMERICAN CITY DINER
5532 CONNECTICUT AVENUE, NW**

THIS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT made and entered into this 26th day of June, 2014, by and between American City Diner ("Applicant") and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3/4G ("ANC 3/4G").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Applicant has filed application ABRA-094922 with the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (the "Board") for a new-class D license for premises at 5532 Connecticut Avenue, NW Washington, DC 20015 ("Premises");

WHEREAS, ANC 3/4G has filed a protest before the ABC Board opposing the granting of this application;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to enter into a settlement agreement whereby Applicant will agree to adopt certain measures to address ANC 3/4G's concerns and to request that the Board include the provisions of this Agreement as conditions of approving its license;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and undertakings memorialized herein, the Applicant and ANC 3/4G hereby agree as follows:

1. **Recitals Incorporated.** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Hours of Operation and Sales.** The Applicant's permissible hours of operation shall be as follows:
Hours of Operation: Sunday-Saturday 7 a.m. to 12 a.m.
Hours of Sales and Consumption: 8 a.m. – 12 a.m.
3. **Nature of Operation.** The nature of the operation shall include interior and enclosed public space. If the applicant obtains a permit for an outdoor sidewalk cafe in public space, this agreement may be amended by mutual agreement to include such public space;
4. **Waste Management.**
 - a. Applicant will not dispose of bottle trash and recyclables before 8:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m.

- b. Applicant will ensure that all garbage is securely contained in dumpsters that are rodent-resistant and shall see that dumpster covers fit properly and remain fully closed and locked except for such times when trash and garbage is being added or removed. Applicant shall not place trash in its dumpsters in any manner that would prevent the full closure of the dumpster. Applicant shall ensure that all dumpsters used are properly maintained and replaced when damaged.
 - c. Applicant shall use its reasonable best efforts to ensure that the area around the dumpsters is kept clean at all times, that the dumpsters are placed such that they do not encroach on public space and that no garbage is placed on public space or abutting residential property.
5. **Enforcement.** The Board shall have exclusive jurisdiction to construe and enforce this Agreement. Nothing in this Agreement shall give rise to a private right of action.

WHEREFORE, by the signing of the representatives of Applicant and ANC 3/4G, Applicant hereby agrees to aforementioned covenants and ANC 3/4G agrees to the issuance of the Class D license to Applicant, provided that this Agreement is incorporated into the ABC Board's order issuing a Class D license.
