MR. DONOVAN W. ANDERSON: Um, let me recall Case #16-PRO-00065, Busboys & Poets, License #77964. Mr. Minora was here, and I had misspoken. I stated that I was going to dismiss the ANC as a party. The ANC was not a party. It's the abutting property owner who's the party for this case, and the abutting property owner did not show up.

So, therefore, the abutting property owner is recused from this proceeding, and they will be given notice that they're dismissed. MR. MIKE SILVERSTEIN: Okay.

MR. DONOVAN W. ANDERSON: I -- I just misspoke. I -- I -- I called the wrong party. It was relevant. I -- I was looking at my, um -- My document in front of me says the ANC. I know that the Board briefing says something else.

But if the Board -- if the Board wants us to revote, then I will -- I will make a motion, although Mr. Minora's not here -- I will make a motion that the -- the Board dismiss the abutting property owner because they have failed to show up at the status hearing.

MR. MIKE SILVERSTEIN: I'll second.

MR. DONOVAN W. ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein seconded the motion. Those in favor, say "aye."

MR. DONOVAN W. ANDERSON: Those opposed?

- the matter now passed 5-0-0. Thank you very
much.
