ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE IN SAFEKEEPING

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Brookland Restaurant, LLC, t/a Cardinal's Nest, is in safekeeping and failed to renew its License No. ABRA-075391, a Retailer's Class CT license. Specifically, the Licensee failed to renew its license by September 30, 2010, the deadline for all Retailer's Class CT licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date.

ABRA records also show that since 2009 no payments or activities have been made for this license.

On January 27, 2012, ABRA's Licensing Division provided a written notice to the Licensee and the Licensee indicated that a transfer application would be filed, which ABRA has not received.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 6th day of June, 2012, that Brookland Restaurant, LLC's License No. ABRA-075391 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee.
