ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE


The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Irma L. Bailey, t/a Carmen & Peaches Variety Store, has failed to renew her License No. ABRA-011494, a Retailer's Class B license. Specifically, you failed to renew your license by September 30, 2008, the deadline for all Retailer's Class B licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date. In addition, ABRA's Licensing Division was unable to establish either verbal or written communication with the Licensee.

On November 12, 2008, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against Irma L. Bailey, t/a Carmen & Peaches Variety Store, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew her Retailer's Class B License.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-501 you are therefore **ORDERED** by the Board on this 5th day of October 2011, that Irma L. Bailey's license No. ABRA-011494 is **CANCELLED**.




