**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING
LICENSE**

Best Wings, Inc., t/a Champions, (Applicant) filed a Motion to Reinstate its ABC License on December 1, 2010. The Board will grant the Applicant's request subject to the conditions discussed below.


The Board recounts the history that has led to the present Order. On September 27, 2007, the Applicant submitted a Renewal Application to the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA). On October 7, 2009, the Applicant paid a licensing fee of \$1,300.00, a late fee of \$250.00, and \$260.00 for an entertainment endorsement. On August 30, 2010, the Applicant's renewal package was returned by the United States Postal Service to ABRA because the Applicant was out of business. Subsequently, the Board issued Board Order No. 2010-521 ordering the Applicant to cease and desist selling, serving, and permitting the consumption of alcoholic beverages on its property. *See Board Order No. 2010-521*. The Board then issued Board Order No. 2010-555, which cancelled the Applicant's license. *See Board Order No. 2010-555*. ABRA mailed the Order to the Applicant and no returned mail was received by ABRA. As of December 8, 2010, no request for safekeeping, renewal package, or license fee payment has been delivered to ABRA by the Applicant.

ORDER

The Board does hereby, this 8th day of December 2010, **VACATE** Board Order No. 2010-521 and Board Order No. 2010-555, which cancelled Best Wings, Inc., t/a Champions' license. The Board will **REINSTATE** the license so long as the Applicant complies with the following condition:


- (1) The Applicant must make the following payments to ABRA, totaling \$4,576.00:
 - a. a \$2,080.00 licensing fee for the period covering October 1, 2010 to September 30, 2011;
 - b. a \$2,080.00 late fee; and
 - c. a \$416.00 entertainment endorsement fee.
- (2) Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant.


